## INTRODUCTION

The Infantino Fold & Go 2-in-1 Baby Carrier is designed for comfortable and convenient babywearing. This carrier supports two carry positions: facing-in (wide seat) and back carry. It is suitable for infants and toddlers weighing between 12 and 40 pounds. Its lightweight and compact design allows for easy storage and portability, folding neatly into its integrated waist belt.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

**WARNING: Failure to follow these instructions can result in serious injury or death.**

- Always ensure your baby is securely positioned in the carrier according to the instructions.
- Regularly check all buckles, straps, and adjustments to ensure they are fastened and secure before each use.
- Ensure your baby's airway is clear and unobstructed at all times. Monitor your baby for signs of distress.
- For facing-in carry, ensure the baby's legs are in an ergonomic 'M' position, with knees higher than the bottom.
- For back carry, the baby must be able to sit unassisted.
- Do not use the carrier if any part is damaged or missing.
- Avoid activities that could cause your baby to fall, such as bending over at the waist. Bend at the knees.
- Do not use the carrier while cooking, exercising, driving, or engaging in other hazardous activities.
- The carrier is designed for babies weighing 12-40 lbs (5.4-18 kg). Do not exceed the maximum weight limit.

## PRODUCT COMPONENTS

---

Familiarize yourself with the main parts of your Infantino Fold & Go 2-in-1 Baby Carrier:

- **Padded Shoulder Straps:** Adjustable for parent comfort.
- **Waist Belt:** Provides support and contains the integrated storage pouch.
- **Front Buckles:** Quick-access buckles for easy on and off.
- **Padded Leg Openings:** Ensures comfort for the baby.
- **Body Panel:** The main fabric section that supports the baby.

## SETUP AND ADJUSTMENT

---

Before placing your baby in the carrier, ensure all straps are adjusted to fit your body comfortably and securely.

1. **Unfold the Carrier:** If stored in the waist belt pouch, unzip the pouch and unfold the carrier body.
2. **Adjust Waist Belt:** Wrap the waist belt around your natural waist or hips. Fasten the buckle securely and pull the strap ends to tighten until snug but comfortable. The waist belt can adjust up to 60 inches.
3. **Adjust Shoulder Straps:** The shoulder straps are lightly padded and adjustable from 29 to 51 inches. Loosen them initially to allow for easier placement of the baby.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. Facing-In Carry (12-40 lbs)

This position is suitable for infants who can hold their head up unassisted, up to toddlers.

1. With the waist belt securely fastened, hold your baby against your chest.
2. Bring the carrier body panel up over your baby's back and bottom.
3. Slide your arms through the shoulder straps.

4. Reach behind your back and fasten the chest clip. Adjust its height for comfort.
5. Fasten the front buckles on each side of the carrier.
6. Tighten all straps (shoulder and side straps) until your baby is snug and high enough to kiss. Ensure your baby's legs are in an 'M' shape, with knees higher than their bottom.

### 2. Back Carry (Baby must sit unassisted, 12-40 lbs)

This position is ideal for older infants and toddlers who have strong head and neck control and can sit independently.

1. Start with the carrier in the facing-in position, with your baby securely fastened.
2. While holding your baby securely, carefully rotate the carrier and your baby to your back. This may require assistance from another adult.
3. Once the baby is on your back, ensure the shoulder straps are properly positioned and the chest clip is fastened across your chest.
4. Tighten all straps to ensure a snug and secure fit.

### 3. Folding for Storage

The carrier can be folded into its integrated waist belt pouch for compact storage.

1. Remove the baby from the carrier and unfasten all buckles.
2. Lay the carrier flat.
3. Fold the body panel and shoulder straps neatly towards the waist belt.
4. Zip the carrier into the waist belt pouch. It can then be worn on your waist or crossbody.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

Proper care will extend the life of your carrier.

- **Cleaning:** The carrier is machine washable. Use cold water on a gentle cycle with mild detergent.

- **Drying:** Air dry or tumble dry on low heat. Do not bleach or iron.
- **Storage:** Store in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Baby feels too low or loose	Straps are not tight enough.	Tighten shoulder and waist straps until baby is snug against your body and high enough to kiss.
Discomfort for parent	Straps are not adjusted correctly or unevenly.	Adjust shoulder straps and waist belt for even weight distribution. Ensure chest clip is at a comfortable height.
Difficulty fastening buckles	Straps may be twisted or misaligned.	Ensure straps are flat and untwisted. Practice fastening without the baby first.
Carrier does not fold compactly	Carrier not folded neatly or straps are protruding.	Ensure all fabric and straps are tucked into the waist belt pouch before zipping.
