SETUP

1. Charging Your Headphones

Before first use, fully charge your HTC Neckband Headphones. Connect the provided USB-C cable to the charging port on the neckband and the other end to a compatible USB power source. A full charge from 0% to 100% typically takes approximately 1.5 hours.

2. Selecting the Right Eartips

For optimal sound quality and comfort, choose the eartips that best fit your ears. The headphones come with three different sizes (S/M/L). Experiment with each size to find the most secure and comfortable fit.

3. Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Ensure your headphones are charged and powered on.

- 3. Search for available Bluetooth devices. The headphones will appear as "HTC HS01".
- 4. Select "HTC HS01" to pair. Once connected, you will hear an audio prompt, and the indicator light will confirm the connection.

OPERATING YOUR HEADPHONES

Button Functions

The headphones feature intuitive controls located on the neckband. Refer to the diagram below for a detailed overview of each button's function:

- Power On/Off: Press and hold the Power button for 3 seconds.
- Play/Pause: Press the Play/Pause button once.
- Volume Up: Press the '+' button.
- Volume Down: Press the '-' button.
- Next Song: Press and hold the '+' button for 2 seconds.
- Previous Song: Press and hold the '-' button for 2 seconds.
- Answer/End Call: Press the Play/Pause button once.
- Reject Call: Press and hold the Play/Pause button for 3 seconds.
- Activate Voice Assistant: Press the Play/Pause button twice.

Game Mode (40ms Ultra-Low Latency)

For an enhanced gaming experience, activate the Game Mode. This mode reduces audio latency to 40ms, providing synchronized sound for competitive gaming.

• To switch to Game Mode: Press and hold the Game Mode button for 2 seconds.

Hall Magnetic Feature (Auto Pause/Play)

The earbuds are equipped with a magnetic sensor for convenient control of your music playback.

- **Auto Pause:** When you bring the backs of the two earplugs together (they will magnetically connect), music playback will automatically pause to conserve power.
- Auto Play: Separate the earplugs and press the Play button to quickly resume music playback.




Image: A close-up of the magnetic earbuds, showing how they connect to pause music automatically.

MAINTENANCE

IPX5 Waterproof Design

The HTC Neckband Headphones are designed with an IPX5 waterproof rating, making them resistant to sweat and light splashes. This feature makes them suitable for sports and workouts.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the headphones with a soft, dry cloth after use, especially after workouts, to remove sweat and dirt.
- Storage: Store the headphones in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Caution: While IPX5 rated, these headphones are not designed for submersion in water. Avoid exposing



TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your HTC Neckband Headphones, please refer to the following common solutions:

- No Power: Ensure the headphones are fully charged. Connect them to a power source using the USB-C cable.
- Cannot Pair: Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your device and the headphones are in pairing mode.

 Try turning both devices off and on again. Ensure the headphones are not already connected to another device.
- No Sound/Low Volume: Check the volume levels on both your headphones and the connected device. Ensure the headphones are properly seated in your ears and that the correct eartip size is used for a

good seal.

- Intermittent Connection: Ensure your device is within the Bluetooth range (up to 32.8 ft/10 meters) and there are no significant obstructions between the headphones and your device. Avoid strong electromagnetic interference.
- Magnetic Pause Not Working: Ensure the earplugs are fully brought together for the magnetic sensor to activate. If they are not aligning correctly, check for any debris.


