1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the HEAPETS P339 Air Purifier. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your air purifier and its genuine replacement filters. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, please observe the following safety precautions:

- Always unplug the air purifier before moving, cleaning, or performing any maintenance.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.
- Keep the power cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not use the air purifier in wet or damp environments.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the unit. Do not block air inlets or outlets.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The HEAPETS P339 Air Purifier is designed to provide clean air, especially in environments with pets. It features a 7-stage purification system to effectively filter out pet hair, dander, odors, particles, dust, smoke, and other allergens.

3.1 Key Features

- **Upgraded Air Inlet:** Designed for stronger suction to attract and capture airborne floating pet hair and particulates.
- **7-Stage Purification System:** Includes a static cotton pre-filter, H12 HEPA filter, Biological Enzyme filter, Activated Carbon filter, and Triple Metal filter.
- **Pet Odor Control:** Bio-enzyme, Activated Carbon, and Negative Ion technologies work together to address pet smells and odors.
- **H12 HEPA Filter:** Effectively filters out pet allergens and fine particles.
- **Dual Air Purification:** Incorporates a built-in negative ion generator and UV light for enhanced air cleaning, verified for zero ozone emission.

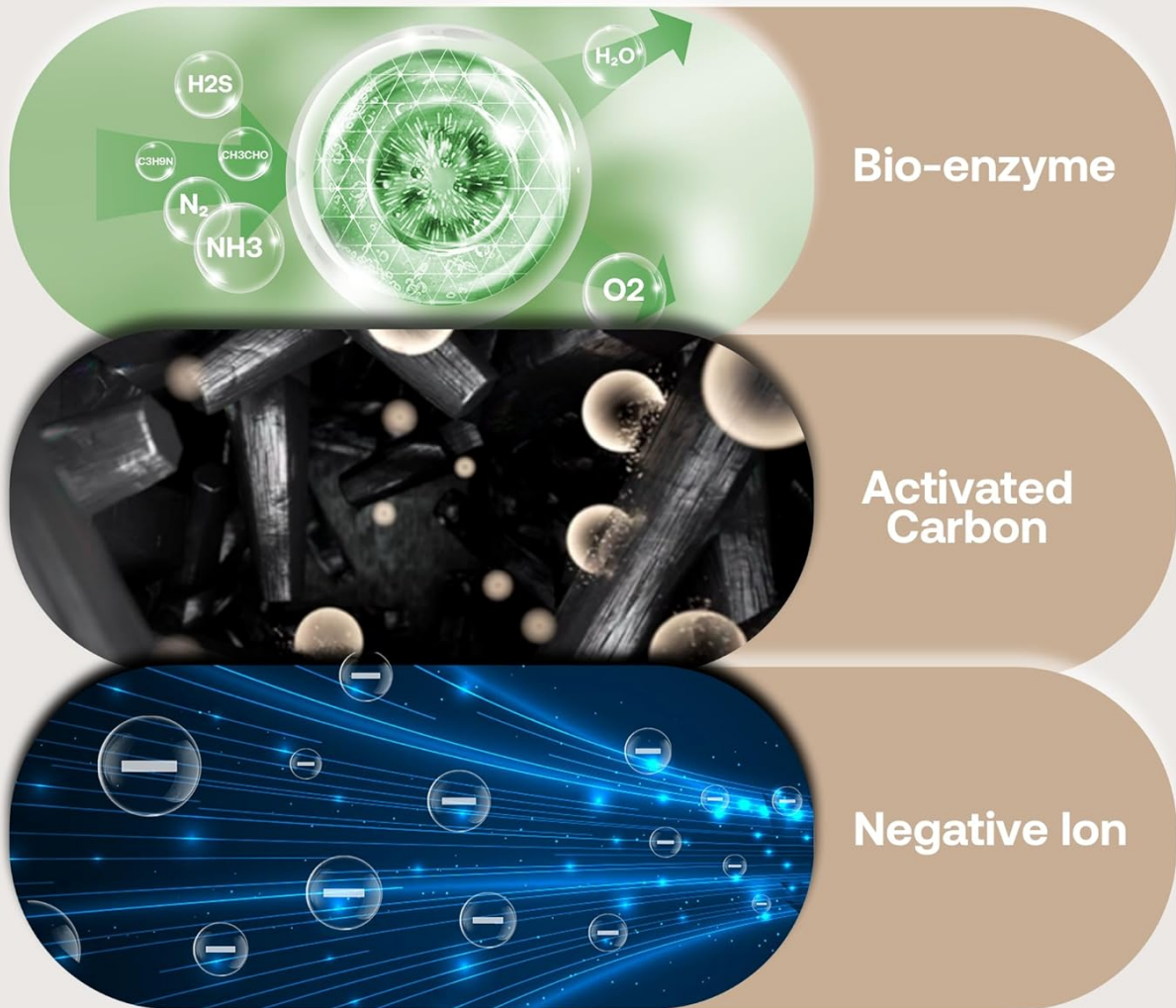


Figure 2: Pet odor removal process using Bio-enzyme, Activated Carbon, and Negative Ion filtration.

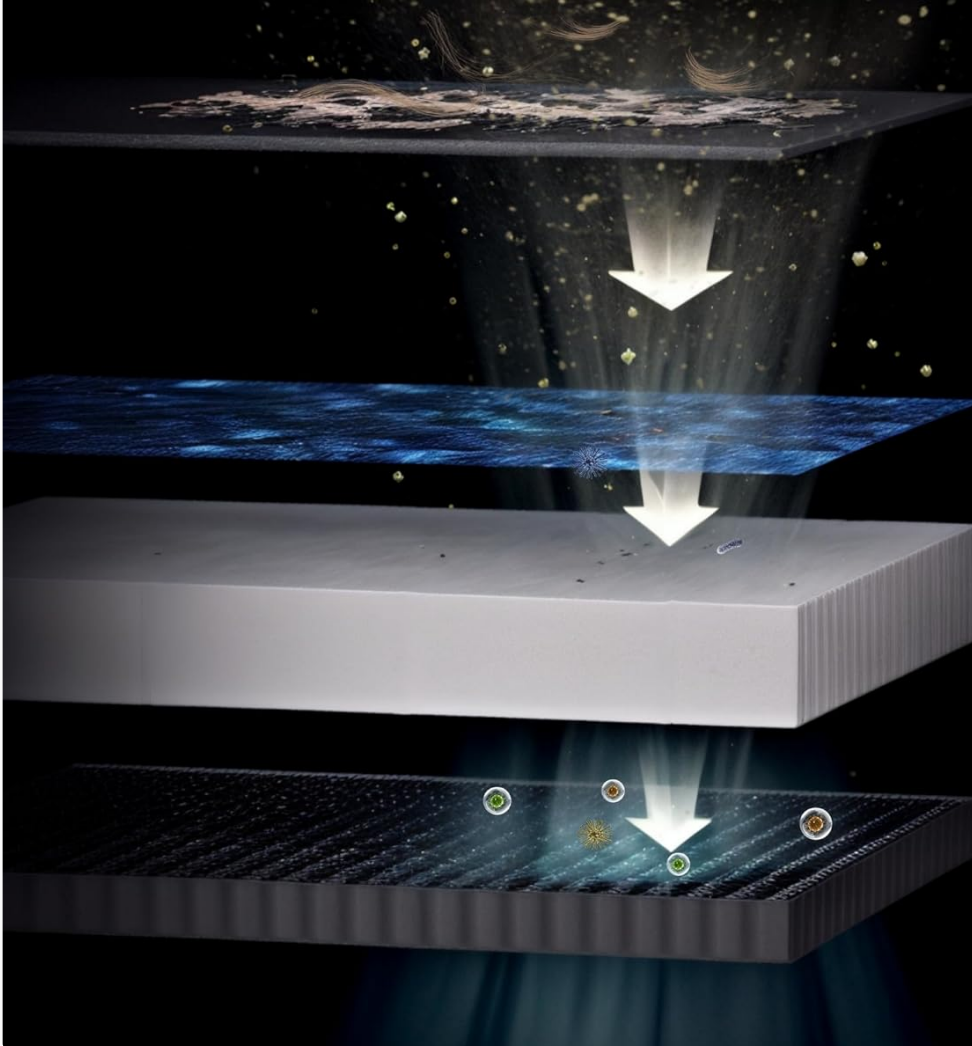


Figure 3: H12 HEPA filter layers for effective allergen filtration.

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your HEAPETS P339 Air Purifier for the first time:

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the air purifier from its packaging. Retain packaging materials for future storage or transport.
2. **Filter Installation:** Open the filter compartment cover. Remove all protective packaging from the pre-filters and the composite filter. Insert the filters into their designated slots, ensuring they are correctly oriented. Close the filter compartment cover securely.
3. **Placement:** Place the air purifier on a firm, level surface. Ensure there is at least 15-20 cm (6-8 inches) of space around all sides for optimal airflow. Avoid placing it directly against walls or furniture.
4. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once set up, operate your air purifier using the control panel:

- **Power On/Off:** Press the power button to turn the unit on or off.
- **Fan Speed:** Adjust the fan speed to your preference. Higher speeds provide faster air purification.
- **Mode Selection:** Select from available operating modes (e.g., Auto, Sleep, Manual) if applicable to your model. Refer to the control panel icons for specific functions.
- **Timer Function:** Use the timer to set the desired operating duration.
- **Filter Reset:** After replacing filters, press and hold the filter reset button (if available) to clear the filter replacement reminder.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your HEAPETS P339 Air Purifier.

6.1 Pre-Filter Maintenance

The static cotton pre-filters are designed to capture pet hair and larger particles. Check them regularly.

- If the pre-filter appears dirty, remove it from the unit.
- Clean the pre-filter by gently shaking off accumulated dust and pet hair. A vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment can also be used.
- **Do not wash the pre-filter.**
- Replace the pre-filter if it is heavily soiled or damaged. The replaceable pre-filter design helps extend the main composite filter's life up to 6 months.

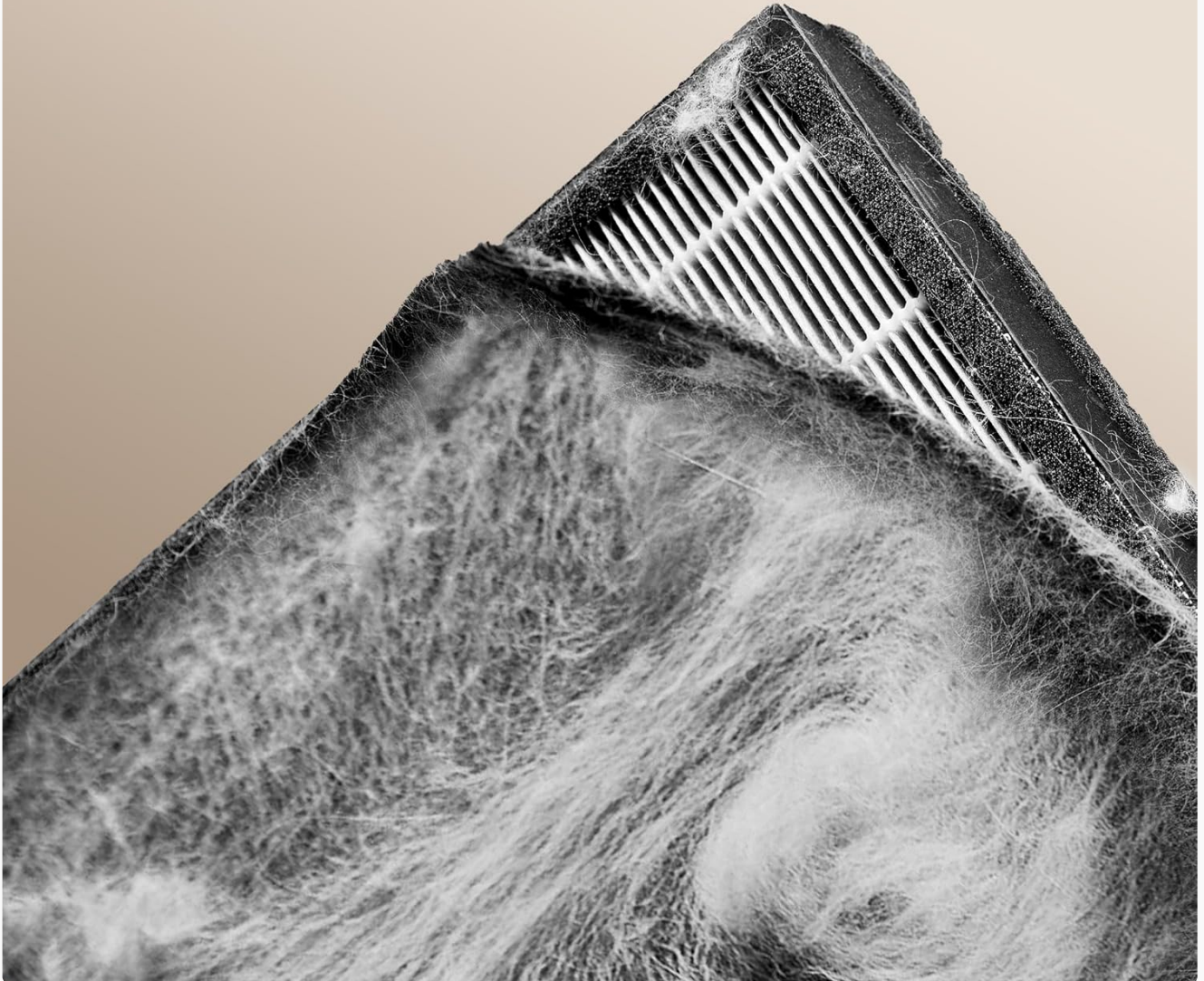


Figure 5: Pre-filter capturing pet hair.

6.2 Composite Filter Replacement

The composite filter (H12 HEPA, Biological Enzyme, Activated Carbon, Triple Metal) has an operational lifespan of approximately 2000 hours. A replacement reminder will appear on the unit after this period.

1. Unplug the air purifier from the power outlet.
2. Open the filter compartment cover.
3. Remove the old composite filter.
4. Insert a new genuine HEAPETS P339 composite filter (part number: MPHELW-P339).
5. Close the filter compartment cover.
6. Plug the air purifier back in and reset the filter reminder by following the instructions in Section 5.

The specific replacement time may vary depending on usage and environmental conditions.

Replaceable pre-filter extends the main filter's life up to 6 months (Regular air purifiers have a max filter life of 3 months).

6.3 Exterior Cleaning

Wipe the exterior of the air purifier with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your HEAPETS P339 Air Purifier, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet malfunction; power button not pressed.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Press the power button firmly.
Reduced airflow.	Clogged pre-filter; main filter needs replacement; air inlets/outlets blocked.	Clean or replace the pre-filter. Check if the composite filter needs replacement. Ensure no obstructions around the unit.
Unusual noise.	Foreign object inside; unit not on a level surface; fan obstruction.	Unplug the unit and check for foreign objects. Place on a stable, level surface.
Odor persists.	Filters are saturated; source of odor is still present.	Replace the composite filter. Ensure the room is adequately ventilated and the odor source is addressed.
