INTRODUCTION

The FeatherSnap Smart Birdfeeder is designed to enhance your birdwatching experience by providing automated bird detection, AI identification, and remote viewing capabilities. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your birdfeeder to ensure optimal performance and enjoyment.

SAFETY INFORMATION

For the safety of both the birds and your property, please observe the following guidelines:

- Place the feeder in a moderately open area, ideally about 10 feet away from trees or shrubs to protect from predators.
- Keep it within 3 feet of a window to prevent window collisions.
- Always follow local regulations regarding feeding wildlife.
- Ensure the feeder is securely mounted to prevent it from falling or being dislodged by wind or animals.
- Do not attempt to modify the feeder or its components, as this may void the warranty and pose safety risks.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unpacking your FeatherSnap Smart Birdfeeder, please ensure all the following components are present:

- Bird Feeder Unit
- Camera Module
- Solar Panel (integrated into the roof)
- Mounting Hardware (e.g., stake, tree mount accessories)
- User Manual (this document)

SETUP GUIDE

1. **Charge the Camera:** Before initial use, fully charge the camera's built-in 5200mAh rechargeable battery using the provided USB cable.
2. **Insert the Camera Module:** Carefully insert the camera module into its designated slot on the birdfeeder. Ensure it clicks securely into place. If the camera feels tight, apply firm, steady pressure.

3. **Download the App:** Download the "FeatherSnap" app from your smartphone's app store (iOS or Android).
4. **Connect to Wi-Fi:**
 - Ensure your Wi-Fi network is 2.4GHz.
 - Check the distance between the feeder and your Wi-Fi router. While the antenna is strong, excessive distance or multiple thick walls can degrade signal strength.
 - Restart your Wi-Fi router and the birdfeeder camera.
5. **Mount the Feeder:** Choose a suitable location for your birdfeeder, considering the safety information provided. The feeder can be mounted using a stake or attached to a tree. Ensure the solar panel on the roof receives ample direct sunlight for continuous charging.

6. **Fill with Seed:** Open the top of the feeder and fill the two compartments with your preferred birdseed. The feeder has a 2L large capacity, reducing the frequency of refills.

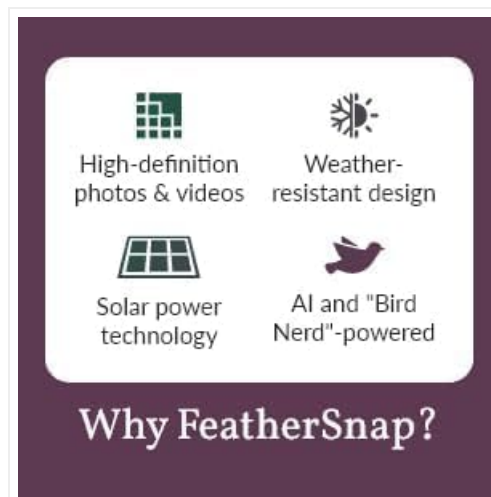

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once set up, your FeatherSnap Smart Birdfeeder will begin monitoring for bird activity.

- **Bird Arrival Notifications:** The feeder automatically captures visiting birds and records videos when movement is detected. You will receive instant notifications on your phone with high-resolution snapshots.
- **AI Bird Identification:** With a paid subscription (\$6.99/month or \$59.99 annually), the advanced AI can recognize a wide array of bird species, providing detailed information about identified birds.

- **High-Quality Observation:** The 120° wide-angle lens and 1080p resolution camera captures clear images and videos both day and night. The built-in 3X magnification allows for close-up details of bird feathers.

- **Solar Power:** The integrated 3W solar panel continuously charges the 5200mAh battery, minimizing the need for manual charging.

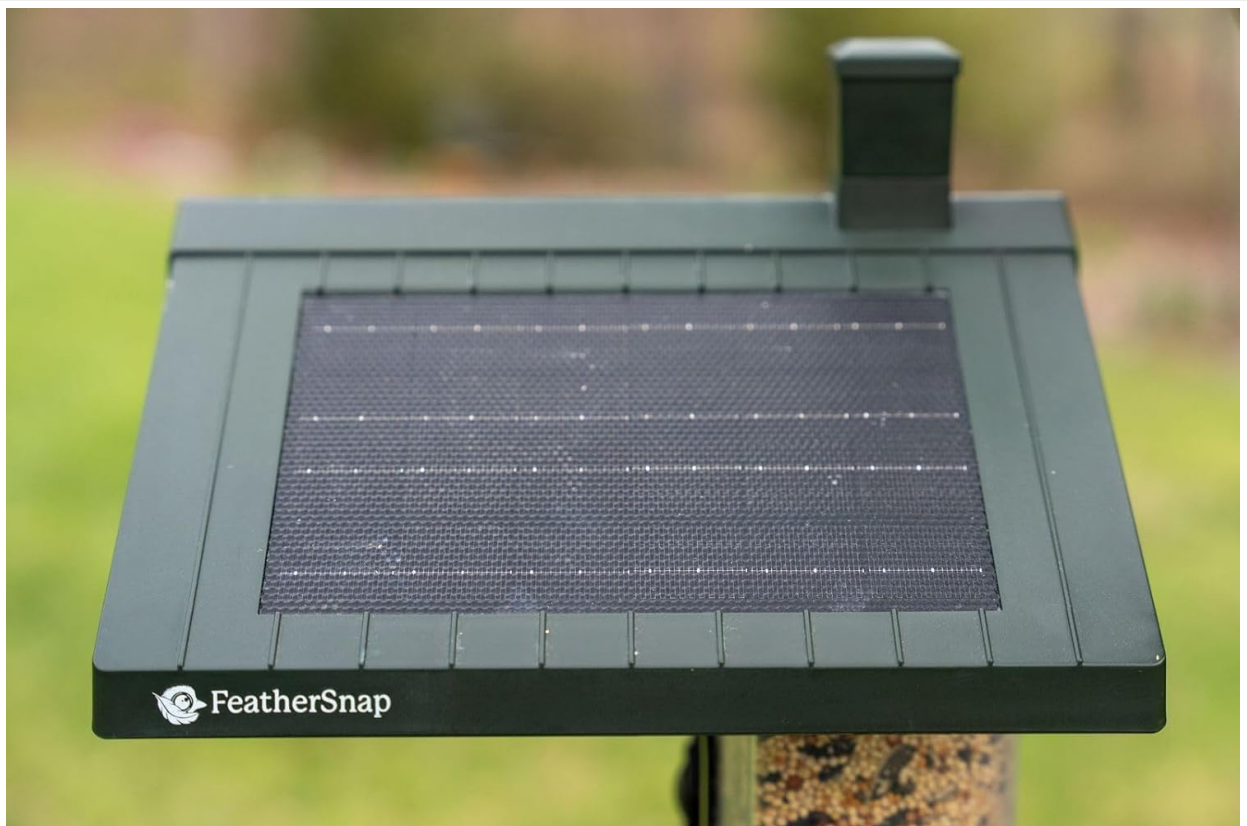

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your birdfeeder.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically clean the feeder, especially the seed trays, to prevent mold and bacterial growth from wet seeds. Ensure proper drainage if water accumulates.
- **Solar Panel:** Keep the solar panel clean and free of debris (leaves, dust) to maximize charging efficiency.
- **Refilling:** Monitor seed levels and refill as needed. The 2L capacity typically lasts for a month, depending on bird activity.
- **Camera Removal:** When removing the camera for maintenance or charging, apply firm, steady pressure to pull it out. It is designed to fit snugly to ensure weather resistance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your FeatherSnap Smart Birdfeeder, refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Notifications/Poor Connectivity:**
 - Ensure your Wi-Fi network is 2.4GHz.
 - Check the distance between the feeder and your Wi-Fi router. While the antenna is strong, excessive distance or multiple thick walls can degrade signal strength.
 - Restart your Wi-Fi router and the birdfeeder camera.
- **Camera Not Functioning/Firmware Update Issues:**
 - Ensure the camera battery is fully charged.
 - If a firmware update is stuck, try restarting the camera and the app. Ensure a stable Wi-Fi connection during the update process.
 - If issues persist, contact FeatherSnap customer support for assistance.
- **Difficulty Removing Camera:** The camera module is designed for a tight fit to ensure weatherproofing. Apply firm, steady pressure to pull it out. Avoid twisting or excessive force.
