


Image: A detailed view of the earbud's metal back shell, showcasing the CNC precision machining and overall craftsmanship.

SETUP

1. Selecting Ear Cushions

The headphones come with large, medium, and small soundproof silicone ear caps. Choose the size that provides the most comfortable and secure fit for your ears. A proper fit is crucial for optimal sound quality and passive noise cancellation.

2. Connecting to Your Device

- 1. Locate the USB-C port on your compatible device (e.g., smartphone, tablet, laptop).
- 2. Insert the USB-C plug of the headphones firmly into the device's USB-C port.
- 3. Your device should automatically recognize the headphones. No additional drivers are typically required.

Note: These headphones are designed for devices with a Type-C interface, especially those without a 3.5mm audio jack. Compatibility may vary with some devices; ensure your device supports audio output via its USB-C port.




Image: A person wearing the BACKWIN B800-T USB-C Wired Headphones, demonstrating proper ear placement and fit.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Inline Remote Control Functions

The inline remote control allows you to manage audio playback and calls without needing to access your device directly.

Volume Up (+) Button: Press to increase the audio volume.

Volume Down (-) Button: Press to decrease the audio volume.

Multi-function Button (Center Button):

For Calls:

- One Click: Answer an incoming call or end an active call.
- Long Press: Reject an incoming call.

For Music:

- One Click: Play or Pause music.
- Click Twice: Skip to the next track.
- Click Three Times: Go back to the previous track.

Microphone: The built-in microphone allows for hands-free communication during calls.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Gently wipe the earbuds and cable with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Ear Cushions: Remove and clean the silicone ear cushions regularly with mild soap and water. Ensure they are completely dry before reattaching.
- Storage: Store the headphones in a clean, dry place when not in use. Avoid extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- Cable Care: Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the cable to prevent damage.
- Water Exposure: These headphones are not waterproof. Avoid exposure to water or excessive moisture.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound or low volume	 Headphones not properly connected. Device volume too low or muted. Incorrect audio output selected on device. Ear cushions not properly seated. 	 Ensure the USB-C plug is fully inserted. Increase volume on both the inline control and your device. Check your device's audio settings to ensure the USB-C output is selected. Adjust ear cushions for a snug fit.
Microphone not working	 Microphone muted on device. Incorrect microphone input selected. Compatibility issue with device. 	 Check your device's microphone settings. Ensure the USB-C headphones are selected as the input device. Test with another compatible device if possible.
Sound distortion or poor quality	 Loose connection. Damaged cable or plug. Audio source quality.	 Reconnect the USB-C plug. Inspect the cable and plug for visible damage. Try a different audio source or file.
