1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Samsung Galaxy S25 5G is a cutting-edge smartphone featuring Galaxy AI, a powerful Snapdragon 8 Elite processor, and an advanced 50 MP ProVisual Engine camera. Designed for durability with a light aluminum frame and Strengthened with Corning Gorilla Glass Victus 2 display glass, it offers robust protection and seamless performance for everyday tasks and advanced mobile experiences.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

- Samsung Galaxy S25 Smartphone
- USB-C Charge Cable
- Ejection Pin

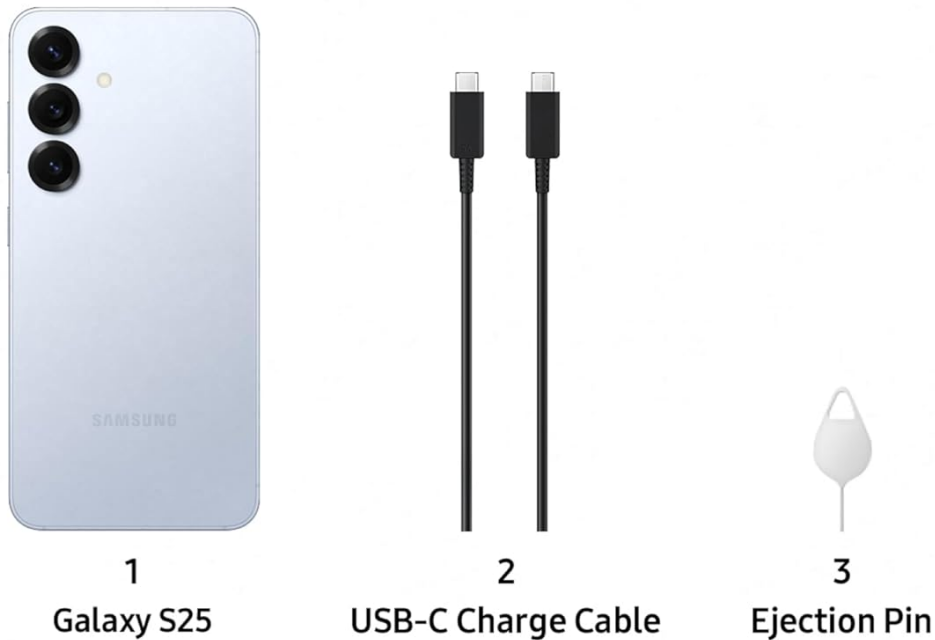


Figure 2.1: Included items in the product packaging.

3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1. Initial Power On and Setup

1. Press and hold the Power button (located on the right side of the device) until the Samsung logo appears.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, connect to Wi-Fi, and agree to the terms and conditions.
3. Sign in with your Google account or create a new one to access Google services and the Play Store.
4. Set up your preferred screen lock method (PIN, pattern, password, fingerprint, or face recognition).

3.2. Inserting the SIM Card

1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your device.
2. Insert the ejection pin into the small hole next to the tray and push gently until the tray pops out.
3. Place your Nano-SIM card(s) into the tray with the gold contacts facing down. Ensure it is correctly aligned.

4. Gently push the tray back into the slot until it clicks into place.

3.3. Charging the Device

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge your Galaxy S25. Connect the USB-C cable to the phone's charging port and the other end to a compatible power adapter (sold separately) or a computer's USB port.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Navigating the Interface

The Galaxy S25 runs on Android 15.0 with Samsung's One UI. Swipe up from the bottom to access the app drawer, swipe down from the top for quick settings and notifications. Use gestures or navigation buttons for Home, Back, and Recent Apps.

4.2. Utilizing Galaxy AI Features

The Galaxy S25 integrates advanced AI capabilities to enhance your daily interactions:

- **Gemini Live:** Engage in free-flowing conversations with Gemini Live to brainstorm ideas or prepare for presentations. You can attach images and receive real-time responses that adapt to your conversation style. Simply press and hold the side button to access Google Gemini.
- **Now Brief:** Receive personalized briefings throughout the day. Start your morning with a summary of the day ahead, including your Energy Score and schedule reminders.

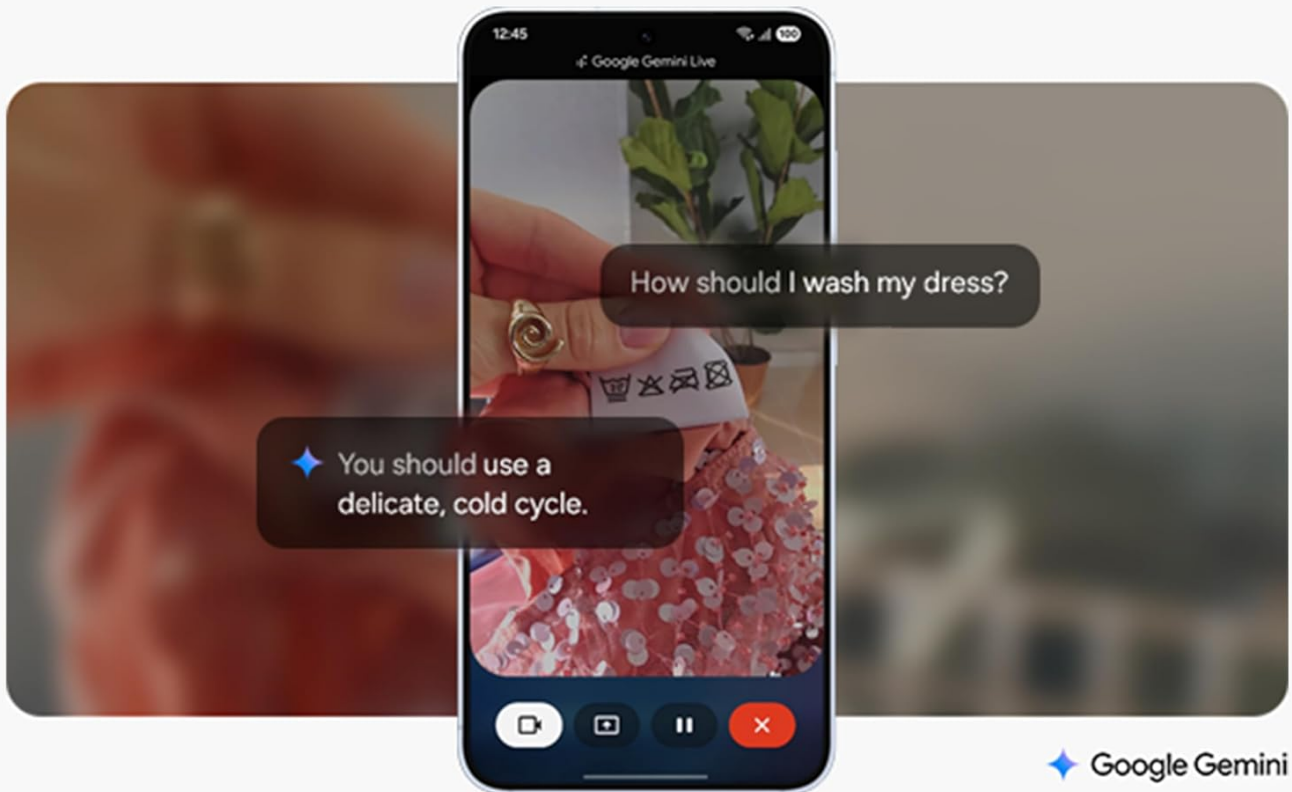


Figure 4.1: Gemini Live in action, providing real-time assistance.

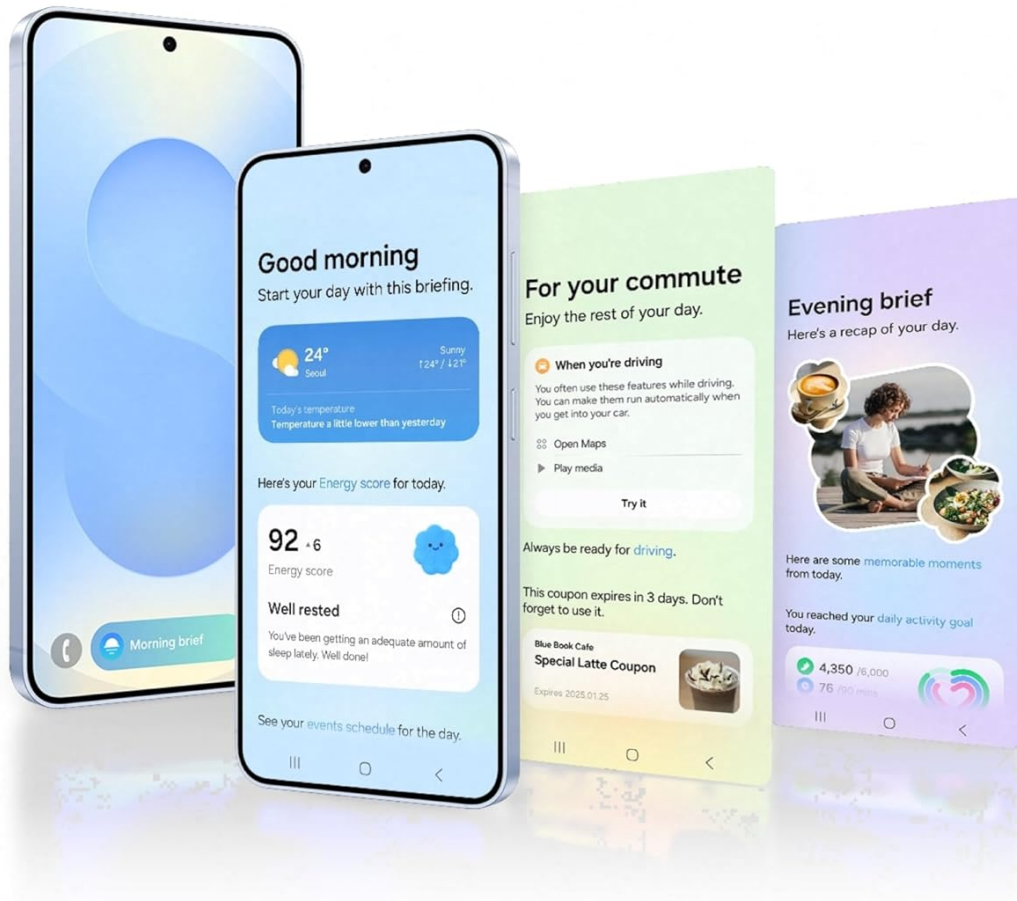


Figure 4.2: Examples of personalized briefings from Now Brief.

4.3. Camera and ProVisual Engine

The Galaxy S25 features an advanced ProVisual Engine, boosted by its powerful processor, for stunning photography and videography. It supports improved 10-bit HDR and offers precise noise removal for clear night footage.

- **Main Camera:** 50 MP Wide-angle with 2x Optical Quality Zoom
- **Ultra Wide Camera:** 12 MP
- **Telephoto Camera:** 10 MP with 3x Optical Zoom
- **Selfie Camera:** 12 MP

4.4. Audio Eraser

Transform your audio with the Audio Eraser feature, allowing you to remove unwanted noise from recordings, effectively turning your phone into a portable sound studio.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Samsung Galaxy S25, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install software updates to benefit from the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. Go to *Settings > Software update > Download and install*
- **Battery Care:** Avoid extreme temperatures. For optimal battery health, try to keep the charge between 20% and 80% and avoid leaving it plugged in for extended periods after reaching 100%.
- **Storage Management:** Periodically clear unnecessary files and apps to free up storage space and maintain device speed.
- **Water and Dust Resistance:** The Galaxy S25 is built with a degree of water and dust resistance. However, this is not permanent and may decrease over time. Avoid intentional submersion and exposure to high-

pressure water.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

If you encounter issues with your Galaxy S25, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Device Freezes or is Unresponsive:** Press and hold the Power button and Volume Down button simultaneously for about 7-10 seconds to force restart the device.
- **Battery Drains Quickly:** Check background app usage (*Settings > Battery and device care > Battery*), reduce screen brightness, disable unused features like Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, GPS when not needed.
- **Apps Crashing:** Clear the app's cache (*Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage > Clear cache*) or reinstall the app. Ensure your device software is up to date.
- **Network Connectivity Issues:** Toggle Airplane mode on and off. Reset network settings (*Settings > General management > Reset > Reset network settings*). Ensure your SIM card is properly inserted.
- **Fingerprint Sensor Not Working:** Ensure your finger is clean and dry. Re-register your fingerprints in *Settings > Security and privacy > Biometrics > Fingerprints*

For more complex issues, consider performing a factory data reset (back up your data first) or contacting customer support.
