1. Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the Silver RAF R.7700 Mini Wonder Chopper. This appliance is designed to simplify your food preparation tasks with its efficient and powerful performance. Please read this manual carefully before using the appliance to ensure safe operation and optimal performance. Keep this manual for future reference.

Important Safety Instructions

- · Read all instructions before use.
- Do not immerse the motor unit in water or other liquids.
- Keep hands and utensils away from moving blades during operation to prevent injury.
- Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet before assembling, disassembling, or cleaning.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons with reduced physical, sensory, or mental
 capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or
 instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- · Avoid contact with moving parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- · Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Always ensure the lid is securely locked in place before operating the chopper.
- Blades are sharp. Handle with extreme care.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Silver RAF R.7700 Mini Wonder Chopper is a versatile kitchen appliance designed for various food preparation tasks. It features a powerful motor and durable stainless steel blades.




Figure 1: Assembled Silver RAF R.7700 Mini Wonder Chopper with food in the bowl.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to correctly assemble your Mini Wonder Chopper before use.

- 1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for storage or future transport.
- 2. **Clean:** Before first use, wash the chopping bowl, blade assembly, and lid in warm soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry all parts. The motor unit should only be wiped with a damp cloth.
- 3. Place Bowl: Place the chopping bowl onto a stable, flat surface.
- 4. **Insert Blade:** Carefully place the blade assembly onto the central shaft inside the chopping bowl. Ensure it sits securely. **Caution: Blades are extremely sharp. Handle with care.**
- 5. **Add Ingredients:** Place your desired ingredients into the chopping bowl. Do not exceed the "MAX" fill line indicated on the bowl.
- 6. Secure Lid: Place the lid onto the chopping bowl, ensuring it is properly aligned and securely seated.
- 7. **Attach Motor Unit:** Position the motor unit onto the lid, aligning the drive shaft with the blade assembly. Gently twist or press down until it locks into place.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled, your chopper is ready for use. Always ensure the appliance is on a stable surface and plugged into a suitable power outlet.

- 1. Plug In: Connect the power cord to a standard electrical outlet.
- Process Food: Press and hold the power button on the motor unit to start chopping. The appliance will operate as long as the button is pressed. For coarse chopping, use short pulses. For finer results, hold the button longer.
- 3. **Monitor:** Observe the consistency of the food through the transparent bowl.
- 4. **Stop:** Release the power button to stop the operation.
- 5. Unplug: Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet before disassembling or removing food.
- 6. Disassemble: Carefully remove the motor unit, then the lid, and finally the blade assembly.
- 7. **Remove Food:** Use a spatula to remove processed food from the chopping bowl.

Tips for Best Results:

- Cut large ingredients into smaller, uniform pieces (approx. 2-3 cm) before placing them in the bowl.
- Do not overload the bowl. Process in batches if necessary.
- For ingredients like herbs or garlic, add a small amount of liquid (water or oil) to help with processing.
- Avoid processing extremely hard ingredients like coffee beans or ice cubes, as this may damage the blades or motor.
- Allow the motor to cool down between prolonged uses to prevent overheating.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

 thoroughly and dry immediately. Caution: Blades are extremely sharp. Handle with care during
 cleaning.
- 4. **Dishwasher Safety:** Refer to the product packaging or manufacturer's website for specific dishwasher safety information for individual components. Generally, hand washing is recommended for blades to preserve sharpness.
- 5. **Storage:** Store the assembled or disassembled chopper in a dry, safe place, out of reach of children.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Silver RAF R.7700 Mini Wonder Chopper, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in. Motor unit not correctly assembled on the lid. Lid not securely locked. Power outage.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Reassemble the motor unit, ensuring it clicks into place. Ensure the lid is properly aligned and locked. Check your household's power supply.
Motor runs, but blades do not turn.	Blade assembly not correctly seated. Food jammed around the blades. Overloaded bowl.	Unplug, disassemble, and re-seat the blade assembly. Unplug, disassemble, clear any obstructions, and reassemble. Reduce the amount of food in the bowl and process in smaller batches.
Chopper stops during operation.	Overheating protection activated. Overloaded bowl.	Unplug the appliance and let it cool down for at least 30 minutes before restarting. Reduce the amount of food and process in smaller batches.
Food is not chopped evenly.	Ingredients are too large or unevenly sized. Too much food in the bowl.	Cut ingredients into smaller, uniform pieces. Process in smaller batches. Use pulse action for better control.
