4. SETUP

To begin using your BodyMed Foot Massager, follow these simple steps:

1. Place the massager on a flat, stable surface. For optimal stability and to minimize noise, place it on a rug or carpet.
2. Connect the power adapter cable to the designated port on the side of the massager unit.
3. Plug the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.

5.2 Using the Remote Control

The remote control allows for convenient adjustment of settings without needing to bend down. It typically includes buttons for Power, Program selection, Time adjustment, Speed adjustment, and Heat function. The remote magnetically locks to the top of the massager for easy storage.

5.3 Recommended Usage Positions

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Care and Cleaning

- Always unplug the massager from the power outlet before cleaning.
- Wipe the surface of the massager with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the unit in water.
- The removable pad can be cleaned separately. Refer to its specific care instructions.

6.2 Storage

Store the massager in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure the power cord is not tightly wrapped around the unit to prevent damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your BodyMed Foot Massager, please consider the following:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power adapter is securely plugged into both the massager and a working electrical outlet. Check if the outlet is functional.
- **Remote Not Responding:** Verify that the remote control batteries are correctly installed and not depleted. Try operating the unit directly using its control panel.

- **Weak Vibration:** Adjust the speed setting to a higher level. Ensure your feet are properly positioned on the footpads.
- **Unusual Noise:** Ensure the massager is placed on a stable, level surface. If the noise persists, discontinue use and contact customer support.




