- Data Transfer (Optional):** If upgrading from an old device, follow the instructions to transfer your data using Samsung Smart Switch or Google's data transfer tools.




Figure 1: Front cover of the guide, illustrating the Samsung Galaxy S25.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

- **Device Not Responding:** If your phone freezes, perform a force restart by pressing and holding the Volume Down button and the Power button simultaneously for about 7-10 seconds until the device restarts.
- **Battery Draining Quickly:** Review the "Battery and Device Maintenance" section. Check battery usage in *Settings > Battery and device care > Battery* to identify apps consuming excessive power.
- **Connectivity Problems (Wi-Fi/Bluetooth):**
 - Toggle Wi-Fi or Bluetooth off and on.
 - Restart your phone.
 - Forget the network/device and reconnect.
 - Reset network settings: *Settings > General management > Reset > Reset network settings*
- **App Crashing:** Clear the app's cache and data (*Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage > Clear cache/Clear data*). If the issue persists, uninstall and reinstall the app.
- **Storage Full:** Delete unnecessary files, photos, and videos. Uninstall unused apps. Consider moving media to

cloud storage or an external drive.
