1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Samsung Galaxy S25 5G smartphone. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper use and to maximize the device's capabilities.

The Samsung Galaxy S25 5G is an advanced smartphone featuring a 6.2-inch 120Hz AMOLED display, a powerful Snapdragon 8 Elite processor, and a versatile 50MP triple camera system. It operates on Android 15 with One UI 7.

2. SETUP

2.1. What's in the Box

- SIM Tray Ejector Pin

2.2. SIM Card Installation

1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your device.
2. Insert the SIM tray ejector pin into the small hole next to the tray and press gently until the tray pops out.
3. Place your Nano-SIM card(s) and/or eSIM (if applicable) into the tray with the gold contacts facing down. The device supports up to two SIMs at a time.
4. Carefully reinsert the tray into the phone.

2.3. Initial Power On and Setup

1. Press and hold the Power/Side key until the Samsung logo appears.
2. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, connect to a Wi-Fi network, and set up your Google account.
3. Transfer data from a previous device if desired, using Samsung Smart Switch or other methods.

3. OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

3.1. Display and Navigation

Your Galaxy S25 5G features a 6.2-inch Dynamic LTPO AMOLED 2X display with a 120Hz refresh rate, providing smooth visuals and vibrant colors. Navigate the device using touch gestures, including taps, swipes, and pinches.

3.2. Camera Usage

The device is equipped with a triple rear camera system and a front-facing selfie camera:

- **Main Camera:** 50 MP, f/1.8, with optical image stabilization (OIS).
- **Telephoto Camera:** 10 MP, f/2.4, with 3x optical zoom and OIS.
- **Ultrawide Camera:** 12 MP, f/2.2, for expansive shots.
- **Selfie Camera:** 12 MP.

Access various camera modes like Best Face, panorama, and record videos up to 8K resolution.

3.3. Battery Management

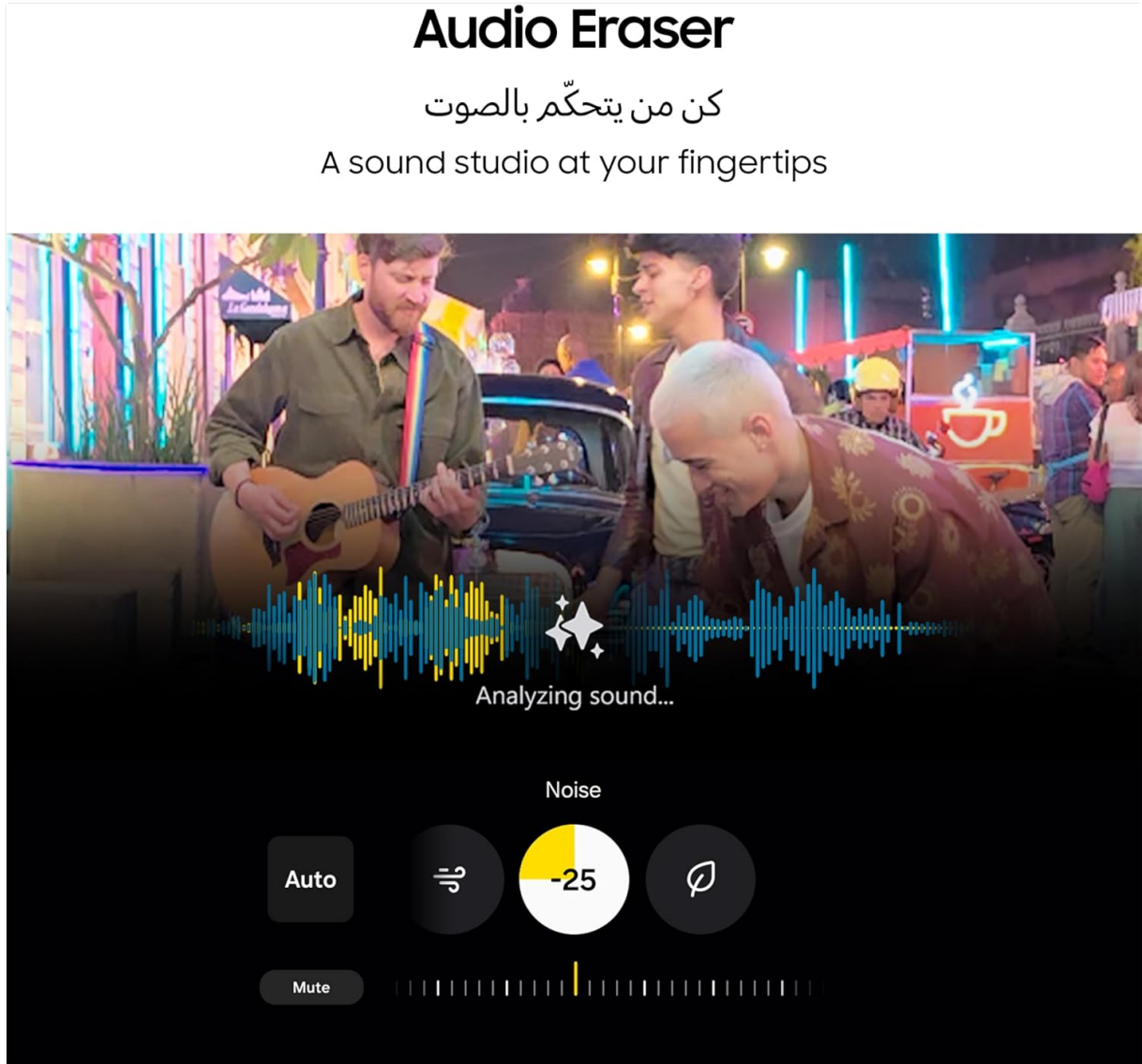
The Galaxy S25 5G is powered by a 4000 mAh battery. To optimize battery life:

- Adjust screen brightness.

- Enable power-saving modes.
- Close unused applications.

3.4. Software and Performance

The device runs on Android 15 with Samsung's One UI 7, offering a user-friendly interface and various customization options. The Qualcomm SM8750-AB Snapdragon 8 Elite processor ensures smooth performance for demanding applications and multitasking.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1. Cleaning Your Device

4.2. Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your device has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. Navigate to **Settings > Software update** to check for available updates.

4.3. Battery Care

To prolong battery lifespan, avoid exposing your device to extreme temperatures. It is recommended to keep the battery charge between 20% and 80% for optimal long-term health.

4.4. Storage Management

Your device comes with 256GB of internal storage. Regularly review and delete unnecessary files, apps, and media to maintain optimal performance. Cloud storage options are also available.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1. Common Issues

- **Device not turning on:** Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a charger and try again.
- **Network connectivity issues:** Check SIM card installation, restart the device, or contact your network provider.
- **Apps crashing or freezing:** Close and reopen the app. If the issue persists, clear the app's cache or reinstall it.

5.2. Factory Reset

A factory reset will erase all data from your device and restore it to its original settings. This can resolve persistent software issues. Before performing a factory reset, back up all important data. Navigate to **Settings > General management > Reset > Factory data reset**
