Introduction

Important Safety Instructions

Setup

Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Verify all components listed in the "What's in the Box" section are present and undamaged.

Placement

Place the ice maker on a flat, stable, and level surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure

adequate ventilation around the unit, leaving at least 5 inches of space from walls or other appliances. The compact design allows it to fit seamlessly into various kitchen, bar, or office areas.

Initial Cleaning

Before first use, it is recommended to clean the interior of the ice maker. Refer to the "Maintenance" section for detailed cleaning instructions.

Operating Instructions

Adding Water

Open the lid and fill the water reservoir with clean, potable water up to the MAX fill line. Do not overfill.

Ice Making Process

Follow these simple steps to produce nugget ice:

1. **Step 1: Add Water.** Ensure the water reservoir is filled with clean water.
2. **Step 2: Press "ICE".** Plug in the unit and press the 'ICE' button on the control panel to start ice production.
3. **Step 3: Enjoy Nugget Ice.** The machine will begin producing ice, with the first batch ready in approximately 5 minutes.

Indicator Lights

- **ICE FULL:** This indicator light will illuminate when the ice basket is full. The machine will automatically pause ice production until the ice is removed.
- **ADD WATER:** This indicator light will illuminate when the water reservoir is low. Add water to the reservoir to resume ice production.

Maintenance

Automatic Self-Cleaning

The ice maker features a smart self-cleaning function for convenient maintenance:

1. Ensure the water reservoir is filled with clean water.
2. Press the "CLEAN" button on the control panel. The cleaning cycle will run automatically for approximately 15 minutes.
3. After the cleaning cycle is complete, drain the water from the unit using the drainage hose.

Manual Cleaning

For thorough cleaning, unplug the unit and empty any remaining water. Wipe down the interior surfaces, including the ice basket and water reservoir, with a soft cloth and a mild, food-safe detergent. Rinse thoroughly with clean water. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

Draining Water

The unit is equipped with a specially designed drainage hose to facilitate smooth water discharge. Ensure the hose is properly positioned over a sink or container to prevent leaks when draining the water reservoir.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your ice maker, please refer to the following table for common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No Ice Production	Water reservoir is empty or low.	Add clean water to the reservoir up to the MAX fill line.
No Ice Production	Ice basket is full.	Empty the ice basket. The machine will resume production automatically.
Ice Melts Quickly	High ambient temperature.	Place the ice maker in a cooler environment, away from direct sunlight or heat sources.
Unusual Noise	Unit is not level.	Ensure the ice maker is placed on a flat, stable, and level surface.
"ADD WATER" light on, but water is present.	Water sensor may be obstructed or dirty.	Clean the water sensor located in the reservoir. Ensure water level is above the sensor.
