1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Read this instruction manual carefully before attempting to assemble or operate this product. Failure to follow these instructions may result in fire, injury, or property damage.

- **CHOKING HAZARD:** Small parts. Not for children. Keep all small components and packaging materials away from children.
- Always use the fire pit on a flat, non-combustible surface.
- Do not use the fire pit indoors or under any overhead combustible surfaces.
- Keep children and pets away from the fire pit during use.
- Never leave a burning fire pit unattended.
- Use appropriate tools, such as the provided fire poker, to manage wood and embers safely.
- Ensure the fire is completely extinguished before leaving the fire pit unattended or covering it.
- Do not use gasoline, kerosene, or other flammable liquids to start or rekindle a fire.
- Wear protective gloves when handling hot components.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The OutVue 42 Inch Fire Pit is a versatile 3-in-1 outdoor appliance designed for bonfires, barbecues, and use as a round metal table. It features a durable construction with a high-temperature powder-coated finish for rust resistance.

Key Features:

- **3-in-1 Functionality:** Easily converts between a wood-burning fire pit, a BBQ grill with two cooking grates, and a 42-inch round table.
- **Adjustable Grills:** Includes two height-adjustable and 360° swivel cooking grates for flexible grilling options. These grates can be disassembled when not needed.
- **Enhanced Airflow:** The fire pit features a drilled design and screen meshes on the vents to promote airflow for a strong fire and prevent sparks from flying out.

- **Stable Design:** Equipped with four sturdy legs and sufficient weight to ensure stability on various outdoor surfaces.
- **Durable Construction:** Made from stainless steel with a powder-coated finish for longevity and resistance to outdoor elements.

Components Included:

- 1 x Fire Pit Base
- 1 x Lid (for table use)
- 1 x Fire Poker
- 2 x Cooking Grates
- All necessary assembly hardware

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the OutVue 42 Inch Fire Pit is designed to be straightforward and typically takes approximately 20 minutes. Follow the detailed instructions provided in the package.

Assembly Steps:

1. Unpack all components and verify against the parts list in your package.
2. Attach the legs to the fire pit base.**NOTE:** Do not fully tighten screws until all pieces are connected. This allows for minor adjustments to ensure proper alignment.
3. Secure the circular support ring to the legs.
4. Once all main structural components are loosely assembled, gradually tighten all screws until secure.
5. Insert the wood grate into the fire pit bowl.
6. If using for grilling, attach the cooking grate support post and then the two cooking grates. Ensure they swivel and adjust freely.
7. If using as a table, place the lid securely over the fire pit bowl.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. As a Fire Pit:

1. Ensure the fire pit is placed on a stable, non-combustible surface, away from any flammable materials or

structures.

2. Place dry, seasoned wood onto the wood grate inside the fire bowl. The fire pit can hold up to 30 lbs of wood.
3. Use appropriate fire starters to ignite the wood. Never use flammable liquids.
4. Use the provided fire poker to adjust logs and manage the fire safely.
5. Always monitor the fire. Do not leave it unattended.
6. To extinguish, allow the fire to burn down naturally or use sand/water to douse the embers. Ensure all embers are cold before covering or leaving.

4.2. As a BBQ Grill:

1. Follow steps for using as a fire pit to establish a good bed of coals.
2. Attach the cooking grate support post and position the two cooking grates over the fire.
3. Adjust the height of the grates as needed for optimal cooking temperature. The 360° swivel feature allows for easy access and heat management.
4. Place food directly on the grates or use foil pans.
5. After cooking, allow grates to cool before cleaning.

4.3. As a Round Metal Table:

1. Ensure the fire pit is completely cool and free of embers.
2. Remove any cooking grates if they were in use.
3. Place the provided lid securely over the fire pit bowl.
4. The fire pit now functions as a 42-inch round table, suitable for meals or beverages.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your OutVue Fire Pit.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, once the fire pit is completely cool, remove ash and debris. Use a stiff brush for the grates and a damp cloth for the exterior. Avoid abrasive cleaners that can damage the finish.
- **Rust Prevention:** The fire pit is coated with high-temperature powder for rust resistance. To further protect it, keep it dry when not in use. A rain-proof cover is recommended (check package contents for availability).
- **Storage:** Store the fire pit in a dry, covered area during prolonged periods of non-use or harsh weather conditions.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight. Inspect for any signs of wear or damage and address them promptly.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Difficulty during assembly (parts not aligning):** Ensure all screws are only hand-tightened during initial assembly. This allows for flexibility to align all components before fully tightening. If parts are still misaligned, loosen all screws, adjust the position of the components, and then retighten gradually.
- **Fire not burning strongly:** Ensure you are using dry, seasoned wood. The drilled design promotes airflow, but wet wood or insufficient kindling can hinder combustion. Clear any ash buildup from previous fires.
- **Rust appearing:** While powder-coated for rust resistance, prolonged exposure to moisture can lead to rust.

Ensure the fire pit is kept dry and covered when not in use. Light surface rust can often be removed with a wire brush and then treated with high-temperature paint.

- **Grates not swiveling/adjusting smoothly:** Check for any debris or buildup around the pivot points. Clean and apply a high-temperature lubricant if necessary. Ensure the grates are correctly installed on the support post.

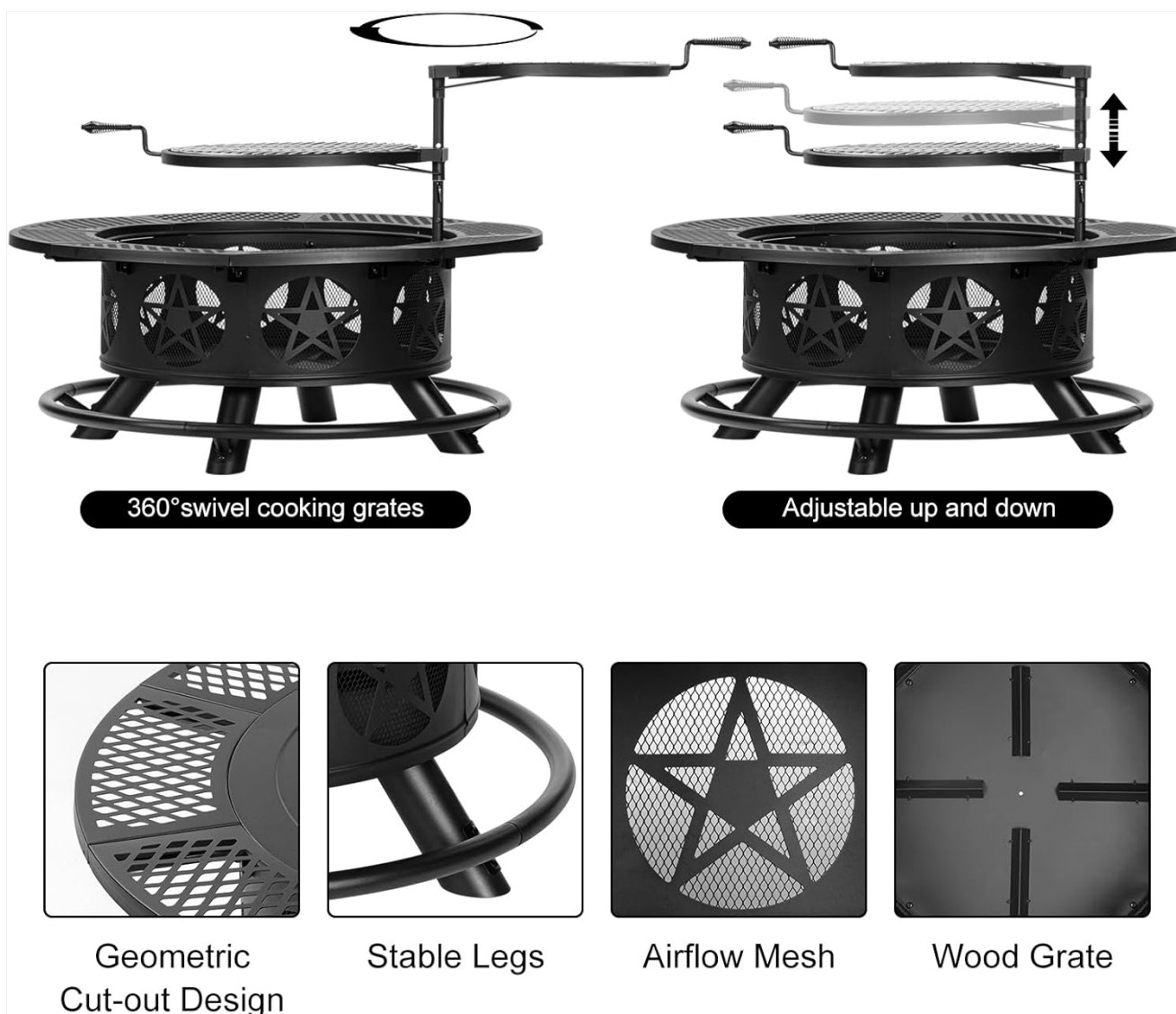


Image 7.1: Detailed product dimensions including grate sizes and overall height/width.
