1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read and follow all safety instructions before using your Maypug P7 Projector to prevent injury or damage to the device.

- Do not block ventilation openings. Ensure adequate airflow around the projector.
- Do not expose the projector to rain or moisture to reduce the risk of fire or electric shock.
- Avoid looking directly into the projector lens when the lamp is on, as this may cause eye damage.
- Use only attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- Unplug the projector during lightning storms or when unused for long periods.
- Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components and ports of your Maypug P7 Projector.

3.1. Ports and Connections

Support Multi-Device Connection

- **USB Port:** For connecting USB storage devices.
- **HDMI Port:** For connecting external video sources like TV sticks, gaming consoles, or laptops.
- **AUX IN (3.5mm Audio Jack):** For connecting external audio devices or headphones.
- **Power Input:** For connecting the power cable.

4. SETUP

4.1. Power Connection

1. Connect the power cable to the projector's power input.
2. Plug the other end of the power cable into a wall outlet.
3. Press the power button on the projector or remote control to turn it on.

4.2. Focus and Keystone Adjustment

The Maypug P7 features automatic vertical keystone correction and electric focus for a clear image from various angles.

- **Automatic Keystone:** The projector will automatically adjust vertical distortion ($\pm 30^\circ$).
- **Manual Keystone:** For further adjustments, navigate to the settings menu to manually correct keystone up to $\pm 50^\circ$.
- **Electric Focus:** Use the remote control to fine-tune the image sharpness.

4.3. Network Connection (WiFi & Bluetooth)

Connect your projector to a wireless network and Bluetooth devices.

1. WiFi Connection:

- Go to the "Settings" menu on the Lilac OS interface.
- Select "WiFi" and choose your desired network.
- Enter the password if prompted. The projector supports dual-band WiFi 6.

2. Bluetooth Connection:

- Go to the "Settings" menu.
- Select "Bluetooth" and turn it on.
- Select your Bluetooth device (e.g., external speakers, headphones) from the list to pair. The projector supports Bluetooth 5.4.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Navigating Lilac OS and Built-in Apps

The Maypug P7 runs on Lilac OS, providing a user-friendly interface with pre-installed streaming applications.

- Use the Bluetooth remote control to navigate the interface.
- Access pre-installed apps like Netflix, Prime Video, and YouTube directly.
- Download additional applications from Google Play and the TV Store.

5.2. Wireless Projection

Mirror content from your mobile devices wirelessly.

- **Miracast (Android):** For Android devices, select Miracast from the apps menu and follow the on-screen instructions to connect.
- **AumiCast (Android/iOS):** For both Android and iOS devices, select AumiCast and follow the pairing instructions.

5.3. Connecting External Devices

Connect devices via HDMI or USB for expanded content options.

- **HDMI:** Connect TV sticks, gaming consoles, Blu-ray players, or laptops to the HDMI port. The projector supports 4K inputs and 120Hz refresh rates for gaming.
- **USB:** Insert a USB drive into the USB port to play media files directly.

5.4. Audio Settings

The projector includes built-in 5W stereo speakers. For external audio, use Bluetooth or the AUX IN port.

- Adjust volume using the remote control.
- Connect Bluetooth speakers/headphones as described in Section 4.3.
- Connect wired headphones or external speakers via the 3.5mm AUX IN port.

5.5. Zoom Function

Adjust the projected image size without moving the projector.

- Use the remote control to access the zoom function.
- The projector supports 50-100% digital zoom.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1. Cleaning

- Wipe the exterior of the projector with a soft, dry cloth.
- For the lens, use a lens cleaning cloth and specialized lens cleaning solution. Do not use abrasive cleaners.

6.2. Dust-Proof Sealed Optical Engine

The Maypug P7 features a fully sealed optical engine designed to prevent dust ingress, ensuring consistent performance and extending the lifespan of internal components. This reduces the need for frequent internal cleaning.

6.3. Storage

- Store the projector in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- If storing for an extended period, cover the projector to protect it from dust.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No image displayed	Power cable loose; Input source incorrect; Lens cap on.	Check power connection; Select correct input source (HDMI/USB); Remove lens cap.
Image is blurry	Focus not adjusted; Projector too far/close to screen.	Use electric focus via remote; Adjust projector distance.
Image is distorted (trapezoid shape)	Keystone not adjusted.	Allow auto keystone to correct; Adjust manual keystone in settings.
No sound	Volume too low; External audio device not connected/paired; Mute enabled.	Increase volume; Check Bluetooth/AUX connection; Disable mute.
WiFi/Bluetooth connection issues	Out of range; Incorrect password; Interference.	Move closer to router/device; Re-enter password; Reduce interference.
