INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Merax Twin Over Twin Bunk Bed with 2 Drawers. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new bunk bed. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

This bunk bed is designed for versatility and space-saving, featuring two integrated storage drawers and the ability to convert into two individual twin platform beds. It is constructed from solid pine wood and MDF for durability and stability.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Maximum Weight Capacity:** The upper and lower beds each have a weight capacity of 400 LBS. Do not exceed this limit.
- **Mattress Requirements:** Recommended mattress thickness for the upper bed is 6 inches. For the bottom bed, 8-10 inches is recommended. Ensure mattresses fit snugly to prevent entrapment.
- **Guardrails:** Always use the guardrails on the upper bunk. Ensure they are properly installed and secured.
- **Ladder Safety:** Use the ladder for entry and exit from the upper bunk. Do not jump on the bed.
- **Age Restriction:** The upper bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary.
- **No Horseplay:** Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Partial assembly is required for this bunk bed. It will arrive in two separate boxes, which may not be delivered simultaneously. Please ensure you have received both packages before starting assembly.

Before You Begin:

- Clear a spacious area for assembly.
- Identify all parts and hardware using the included parts list (not provided in this manual, refer to your product packaging).
- Use appropriate tools as specified in your product's assembly guide.
- Do not fully tighten bolts until all components are loosely assembled.

Assembly Steps (General Guidance):

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. **Assemble Bed Frames:** Begin by assembling the headboards and footboards for both the upper and lower beds. Attach side rails.
3. **Install Slats:** Securely attach the wooden slats to both bed frames. Ensure even spacing and firm attachment for mattress support.
4. **Assemble Storage Drawers:** Construct the two storage drawers according to the instructions.
5. **Attach Ladder and Guardrails:** For the bunk bed configuration, attach the ladder and all safety guardrails to the upper bunk. Ensure they are firmly secured.
6. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, carefully tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten.






Image: Front view of the bunk bed frame, illustrating the wooden slat support system for both the upper and lower bunks, and the integrated storage drawers.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Bunk Bed Configuration:

- Ensure the ladder is securely attached before use.
- Only one person should climb the ladder at a time.
- Always use the guardrails on the upper bunk to prevent falls.
- Do not attach or hang items on any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed, such as hooks or ropes, as they could pose a strangulation hazard.

Using the Storage Drawers:

- The two drawers are located beneath the lower bunk. Pull the knobs to open them.
- These drawers are ideal for storing blankets, sheets, toys, and other small items.
- Avoid overloading the drawers to ensure smooth operation and prevent damage.

Converting to Two Individual Beds:

This bunk bed can be separated into two standalone twin platform beds. To convert:

1. Carefully remove the upper bunk from the lower bunk by detaching the connecting hardware.
2. Remove the ladder and guardrails.
3. Position the two beds as desired in your room. Ensure all parts are stable and secure.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning:

- Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or polishes that may damage the finish.
- Promptly clean up spills to prevent staining or damage to the wood.

Care:

- Regularly check all hardware (bolts, screws) and tighten them as needed to maintain stability and safety.
- Avoid dragging the bed when moving it; lift it to prevent damage to the frame or floor.
- Keep the bed away from direct sunlight and heat sources to prevent warping or fading of the wood.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Bed feels wobbly:** Ensure all bolts and screws are fully tightened. Check that the bed is on a level surface.
- **Drawers are difficult to open/close:** Check for obstructions in the drawer glides. Ensure the drawers are assembled correctly and not overloaded.
- **Squeaking noises:** Tighten all hardware. If squeaking persists, apply a small amount of lubricant (e.g., silicone spray) to metal-on-metal contact points, if any, or where wood components rub.
- **Missing parts:** If you find any parts missing upon unboxing, please contact Merax customer support immediately.




Image: Detailed dimensional drawing of the Merax Twin Over Twin Bunk Bed, providing precise measurements for all parts and the overall structure.
