Your comprehensive guide to assembly, operation, and maintenance.

## 1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Read all instructions before operating this ride-on toy. Failure to follow these safety instructions may result in serious injury or death.

- **Adult Supervision Required:** This product is intended for children aged 3-5 years and must always be operated under direct adult supervision.
- **Weight Limit:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 66 pounds (30 kg).
- **Safety Belt:** Always ensure the child is securely fastened with the adjustable safety belt before operation.
- **Operating Environment:** Use only on flat, level surfaces. Avoid slopes, stairs, public roads, or areas with traffic. Keep away from water, pools, and other hazards.
- **Protective Gear:** Children should wear appropriate protective gear, such as a helmet, when operating the vehicle.
- **Braking:** The vehicle features a soft-start system for smooth acceleration and an emergency brake function on the parental remote control.
- **Battery Safety:** Only use the provided charger and battery. Do not modify the electrical system.
- **ASTM F963 CPSIA Certified:** This product meets safety standards.

## 2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

### 3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps carefully for proper assembly. Adult assembly is required.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect for any damage.
2. **Wheel Installation:** Attach the wheels to the axles. Ensure all washers and pins are correctly installed to secure the wheels. Refer to the diagram for correct placement.
3. **Battery Connection:** Locate the battery compartment (often under the seat or hood). Connect the battery terminals as indicated in the manual. Ensure a secure connection.
4. **Seat and Windshield:** Install the seat and windshield according to the provided diagrams, securing them with the appropriate screws.
5. **Steering Wheel:** Attach the steering wheel, ensuring all electrical connections (if any) are made before securing it in place.
6. **Accessory Installation:** Install the simulated megaphone and any other accessories as per the instructions.
7. **Initial Charge:** Before first use, fully charge the battery for the recommended duration (typically 8-12 hours).

## 4. CHARGING THE BATTERY

Proper battery charging ensures optimal performance and longevity.

- **First Use:** Charge the battery for 8-12 hours before the first use. Do not overcharge.
- **Regular Charging:** After each use, charge the battery for 8-12 hours. Do not charge for more than 20 hours.
- **Charger Connection:** Plug the charger into the charging port on the vehicle, then plug the charger into a standard wall outlet.
- **Indicator Lights:** Observe the charger's indicator light (if present) to determine charging status.
- **Storage:** If storing the vehicle for an extended period, charge the battery fully every 3 months to maintain its health.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## 5.1 Vehicle Controls

Familiarize yourself with the vehicle's controls before operation.

- **Power Button:** Turns the vehicle on/off.
- **Forward/Reverse Switch:** Selects driving direction.
- **Foot Pedal:** Press to accelerate. Release to brake.
- **Steering Wheel:** Turn left or right to steer the vehicle.
- **Light Switch:** Activates the flashing police lights.
- **Siren/Horn Buttons:** Activates siren sounds or horn.
- **Megaphone Input:** Connect the simulated megaphone for voice amplification.

## 5.2 Parental Remote Control (2.4GHz)

The remote control allows parents to safely guide the vehicle.

- **Pairing:** Follow the instructions in the remote control manual to pair it with the vehicle.
- **Directional Buttons:** Control forward, reverse, left, and right steering.
- **Speed Selection:** Choose between 3 speed options (low, medium, high).
- **Emergency Brake Button:** Press to immediately stop the vehicle. Press again to release.

### 5.3 Bluetooth Connectivity

Connect a mobile device to play music or stories through the vehicle's speakers.

1. Turn on the vehicle's power.
2. Activate Bluetooth on your mobile device.
3. Search for available devices and select "Hikiddo" or the device name displayed on the vehicle's media panel.
4. Once connected, you can play audio from your device.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your Hikiddo ride-on car.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the vehicle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. Avoid spraying water directly onto electrical components.
- **Battery Care:** Follow charging instructions carefully. Do not allow the battery to fully discharge. Disconnect the battery if storing for long periods.
- **Tire Inspection:** Regularly check tires for wear and tear. Ensure they are free from debris.
- **Electrical Connections:** Periodically check all electrical connections for tightness and corrosion.
- **Storage:** Store the vehicle in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight and moisture.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not move.	Battery low or not connected; Power switch off; Loose wiring; Overload protection activated.	Charge battery; Turn power on; Check all connections; Reduce load/wait for reset.
Vehicle runs slowly.	Low battery; Overloaded; Operating on rough terrain.	Charge battery; Reduce weight; Use on flat surfaces.
Remote control not working.	Remote batteries low; Not paired; Interference.	Replace remote batteries; Re-pair remote; Move to an area with less interference.
Lights or sounds not working.	Loose wiring; Damaged component.	Check connections; Contact customer support if component is damaged.
