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1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- **Two-Person Assembly:** It is highly recommended that at least two people assemble this unit to ensure safety and proper construction.
- **Avoid Overloading:** Do not overload the cabinet or drawers. Distribute weight evenly to maintain stability.
- **Pinch Points and Sharp Edges:** Be cautious of pinch points and sharp edges during installation and daily use, especially with moving parts like sliding doors and drawers.
- **Anti-Tipping Device:** This armoire includes an anti-tipping device. It is crucial to secure the wardrobe to the wall using this device to prevent accidental tipping, which can cause serious injury. Follow the specific instructions for wall mounting.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep children and pets away from the assembly area. Do not allow children to climb on or play with the armoire.
- **Proper Tools:** Use only the tools specified in the assembly instructions.

Safety with Anti-tipping Design

The anti-tipping device secures the wardrobe to the wall ensuring biggest safety and stability.

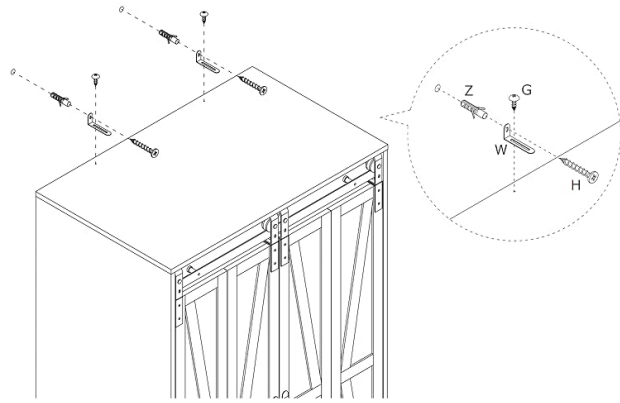
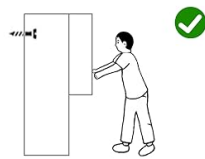
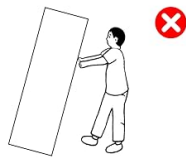


Figure 1: Anti-Tipping Device Installation. This diagram illustrates the correct method for securing the armoire to the wall using the provided anti-tipping hardware, ensuring stability and preventing accidental falls.

2. PARTS LIST

3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly requires patience and careful attention to detail. It is strongly recommended to have at least two people for assembly. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the separate assembly manual included with your product.

General Assembly Tips:

- **Clear Workspace:** Ensure you have a spacious, clean, and level area for assembly.
- **Identify Parts:** Lay out all parts and hardware. Compare them with the parts list in your manual to ensure everything is accounted for.
- **Hand-Tighten First:** Initially hand-tighten screws and fasteners. Fully tighten them only after all components are correctly aligned.
- **Do Not Overtighten:** Overtightening screws can damage the wood material.
- **Wall Anchoring:** Always install the anti-tipping device as instructed in the safety section and your assembly manual.

4. OPERATION

Sliding Barn Doors:

The armoire features two folding sliding barn doors. To open, gently push the doors from the middle towards each side. To close, pull them back to the center until they meet. Ensure the doors slide smoothly along the top rail.

Drawers:

The armoire includes two spacious drawers. Pull the metal handles to open the drawers. Push them gently to close. Avoid forcing the drawers, and ensure they are properly aligned on their glides for smooth operation.

Storage Capacity:

- **Hanging Rod:** Use the integrated hanging rod for clothes such as shirts, dresses, and jackets.
- **Bottom Shelf:** The space below the hanging rod can be used for folded items, storage bins, or hats.
- **Drawers:** Ideal for storing private items, accessories, toys, cosmetics, or linens.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Clean spills immediately with a dry cloth to prevent staining or water damage.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Retighten if necessary, but do not overtighten.
- **Door and Drawer Glides:** If doors or drawers become stiff, a small amount of silicone lubricant can be applied to the glides (avoid oil-based lubricants on wood).
- **Avoid Direct Sunlight:** Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can cause fading or warping.
- **Humidity Control:** Maintain a stable humidity level in the room to prevent wood from expanding or contracting excessively.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wobbly or Unstable Armoire	• Screws are not fully tightened. • Uneven floor surface. • Anti-tipping device not installed or improperly installed.	• Check and tighten all screws. • Place shims under the base to level the unit. • Ensure the anti-tipping device is securely anchored to the wall.
Drawers do not slide smoothly or get stuck	• Drawer glides are misaligned. • Obstruction in the drawer track. • Drawers are overloaded.	• Recheck assembly steps for drawer glides. Ensure they are installed correctly and parallel. • Remove any items obstructing the glides. • Reduce the weight in the drawers.
Sliding doors are difficult to move	• Door rollers or track are dirty. • Doors are misaligned on the track.	• Clean the door track and rollers. • Carefully lift and reseal the doors on the track, ensuring proper alignment.
Missing or Damaged Parts	• Packaging error or shipping damage.	• Do not proceed with assembly. Contact Maupvit customer support immediately for replacement parts.
