INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Retroid Pocket 5 Retro Handheld Game Console. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

The Retroid Pocket 5 is a portable Android gaming handheld featuring a 5.5-inch touchscreen, Snapdragon 865 Processor, Adreno 650 GPU, WiFi 6, and Bluetooth 5.1, designed for an immersive gaming experience.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

Upon unboxing your Retroid Pocket 5, verify that all components are present:

- Retroid Pocket 5 Handheld Game Console
- USB-C Charging Cable
- User Manual (this document)

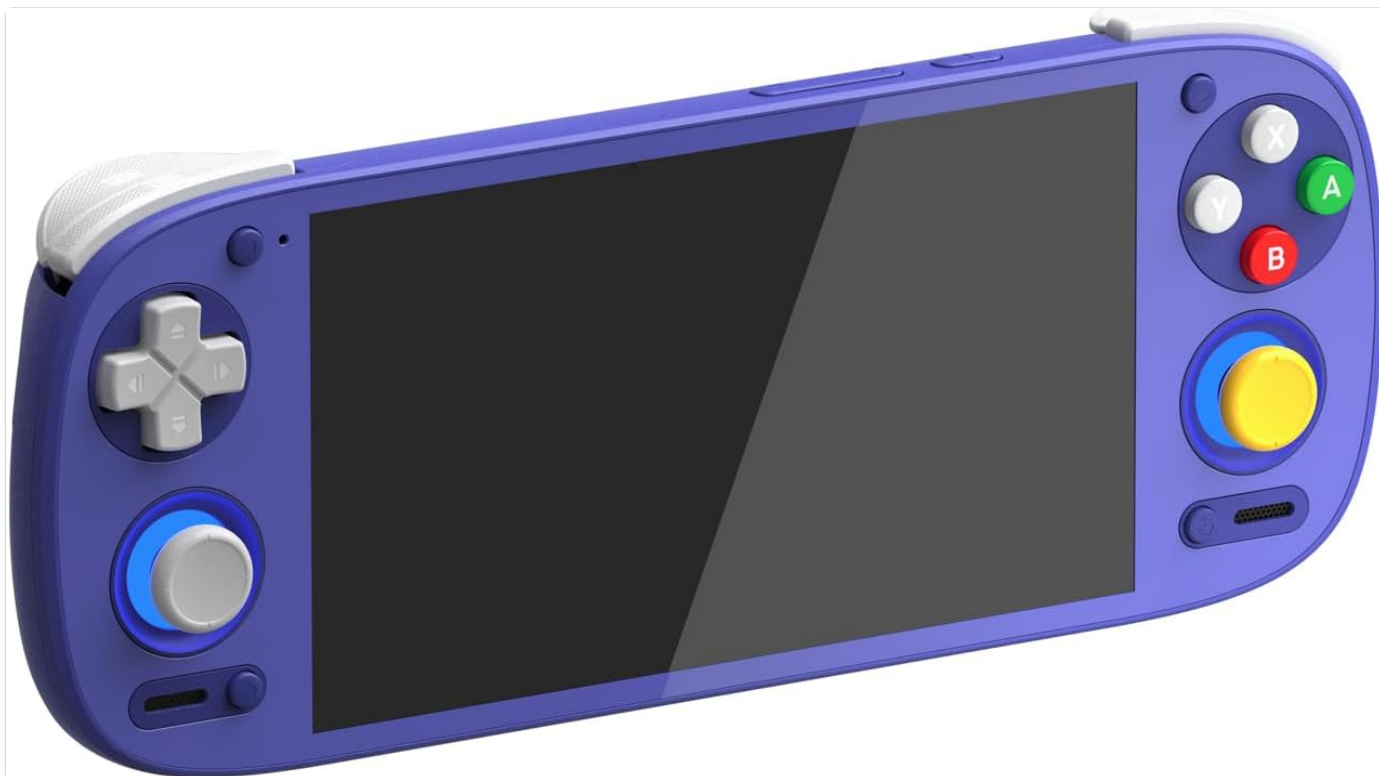


Image: The Retroid Pocket 5 handheld console, showing its compact design and controls.

SETUP GUIDE

1. Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the Retroid Pocket 5. Connect the supplied USB-C charging cable to the console's USB-C port and the other end to a compatible USB power adapter (not included).

- A full charge typically takes approximately 2-3 hours.
- The charging indicator light will change color or turn off when charging is complete.

2. Powering On/Off

To power on, press and hold the power button located on the top right side of the device until the screen illuminates. To power off, press and hold the power button, then select "Power off" from the on-screen options.

3. Initial Android Setup

Upon first boot, you will be guided through the standard Android setup process. This includes:

- Selecting your language.
- Connecting to a Wi-Fi network (recommended for updates and app downloads).
- Logging in with your Google account (optional, but recommended for Google Play Store access).

4. Inserting a microSD Card (Optional)

The Retroid Pocket 5 supports expandable storage via a microSD card. Locate the microSD card slot on the device, insert the card gently until it clicks into place. Ensure the device is powered off before inserting or removing the card.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Navigation and Controls

The Retroid Pocket 5 combines a responsive 5.5-inch touchscreen with physical gaming controls. You can navigate the Android interface using touch gestures or the D-pad and analog sticks.

- **D-pad:** Directional input for menus and games.
- **Analog Sticks:** Precise 3D movement in games.
- **ABXY Buttons:** Action buttons for gameplay.
- **Shoulder Buttons (L1/L2, R1/R2):** Additional action buttons, typically for triggers or modifiers.
- **Start/Select Buttons:** Standard game control functions.
- **Home Button:** Returns to the Android home screen.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust audio output.

2. Installing Games and Emulators

The Retroid Pocket 5 runs on Android OS, allowing access to the Google Play Store and sideloading applications. No games are preloaded on the device.

- **Google Play Store:** Download Android games and emulator applications directly.
- **Sideloading:** Install APK files from trusted sources for emulators or games not available on the Play Store. Ensure "Install unknown apps" is enabled in Android settings for the source application (e.g., browser or file manager).
- **ROMs:** Transfer game ROM files to your device's internal storage or microSD card. Organize them in clearly named folders for easy access by emulators.

3. Connecting to Wi-Fi and Bluetooth

Access Android settings to manage Wi-Fi and Bluetooth connections.

- **Wi-Fi:** Connect to wireless networks for internet access, updates, and online gaming.
- **Bluetooth:** Pair with external controllers, headphones, or other Bluetooth accessories.

4. Cloud Gaming Services

The Retroid Pocket 5 supports various cloud gaming services. Download the respective applications from the Google Play Store and log in with your service credentials.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning the Device

Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the console. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or aerosol sprays.

2. Software Updates

Regularly check for system updates in the Android settings to ensure optimal performance, security, and access to new features. Connect to Wi-Fi before performing updates.

3. Battery Care

To prolong battery life:

- Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Do not expose the device to extreme temperatures.
- Use only the supplied USB-C cable for charging.

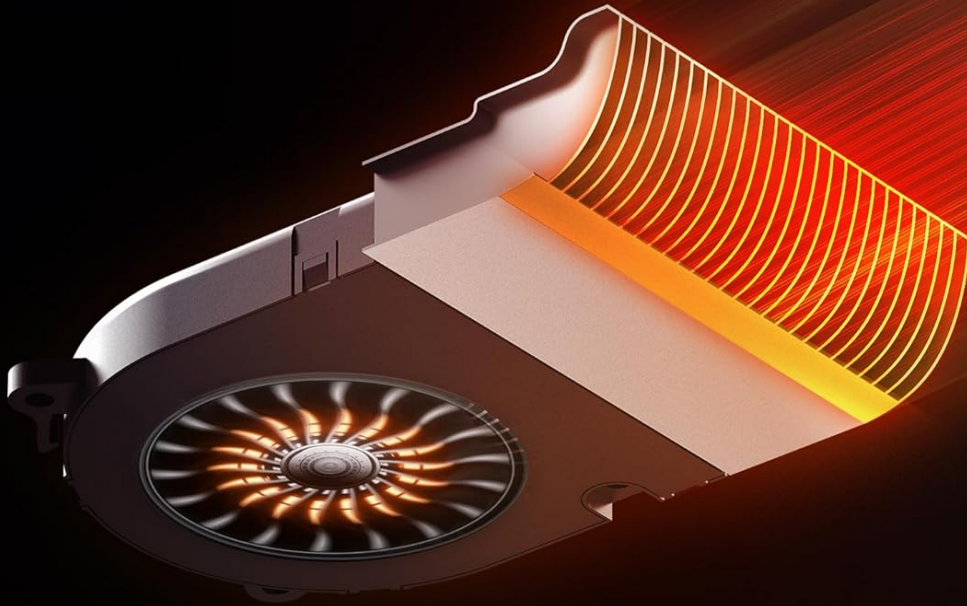


Image: Diagram illustrating the active cooling system within the Retroid Pocket 5, designed for optimal heat management.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device does not power on.	Low battery; device frozen.	Charge the device for at least 30 minutes. Perform a hard reset by holding the power button for 10-15 seconds.
Screen is unresponsive.	Software glitch; screen protector interference.	Restart the device. Ensure the screen is clean. If a screen protector is installed, check for proper application.
Games run slowly or crash.	Insufficient system resources; outdated emulator/game; overheating.	Close background applications. Update the game or emulator. Ensure adequate ventilation around the device. Reduce in-game graphics settings.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi.	Incorrect password; router issue; device Wi-Fi disabled.	Verify Wi-Fi password. Restart your router. Ensure Wi-Fi is enabled in device settings.

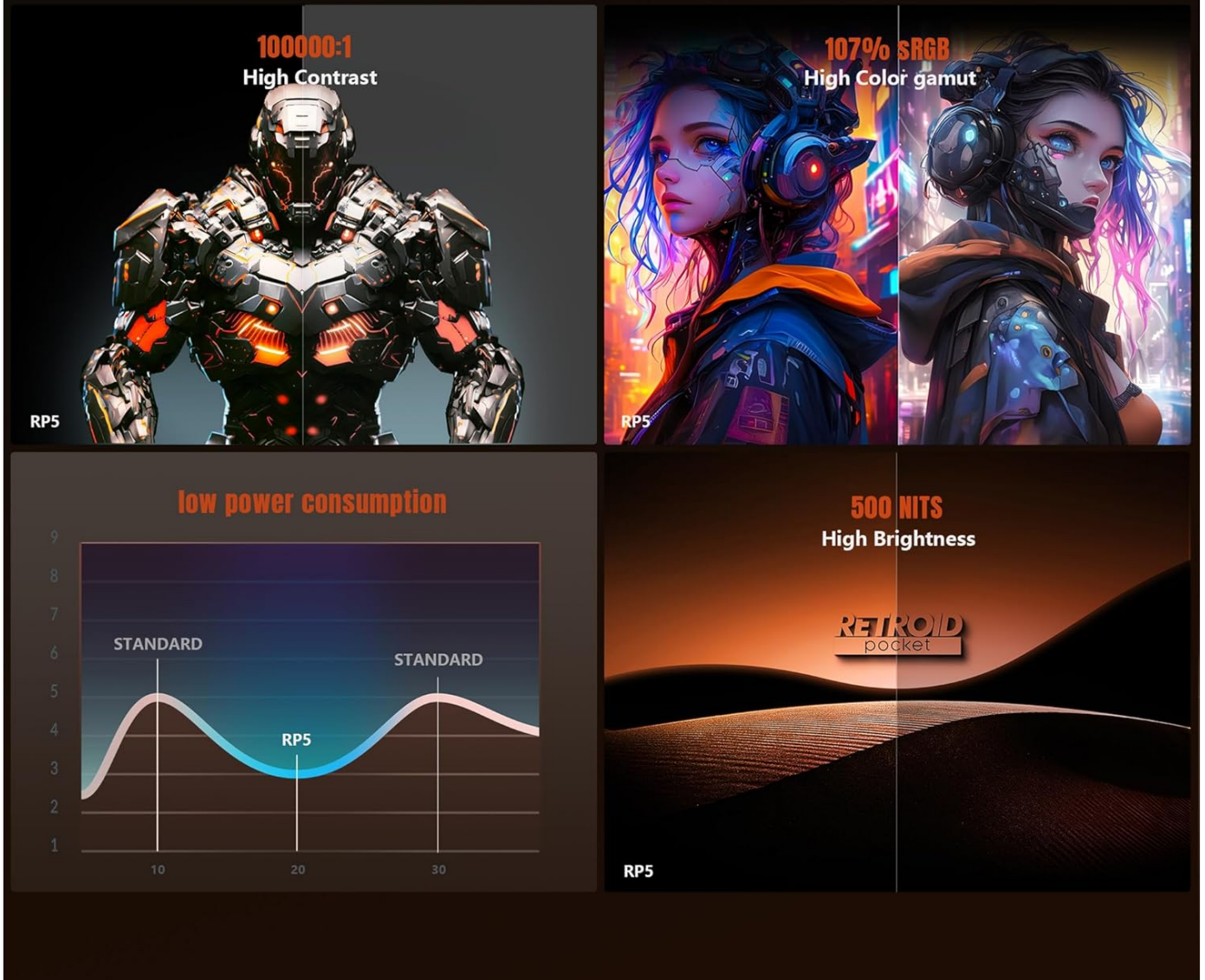

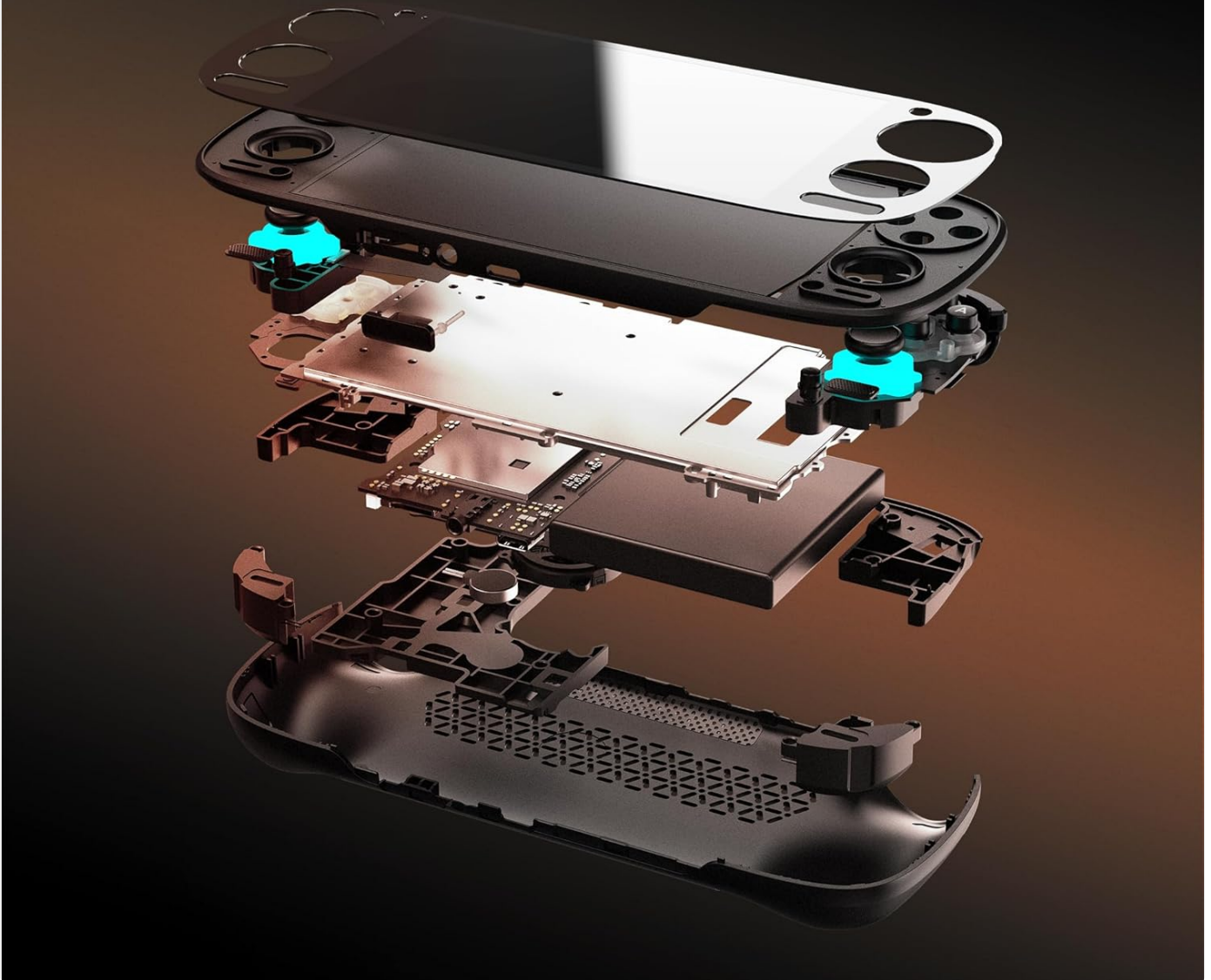


Image: Size comparison of the Retroid Pocket 5 (RP5) with the previous model, RP4, showing dimensions and weight.
