SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Surtime 52" Ceiling Fan features a pre-assembled design for straightforward installation. It is designed for flush mounting directly to ceilings without the need for downrods. For detailed step-by-step instructions, please refer to the comprehensive instruction manual included in your package.

Key Installation Points:

- Ensure the electrical box is securely mounted and capable of supporting the fan's weight.
- Connect wiring according to the provided diagrams in the manual.
- Attach the fan blades securely. The blades are double-sided, offering a white finish on one side and a wood-grain finish on the other, allowing you to choose your preferred style.
- Install the integrated LED light kit.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Surtime ceiling fan can be controlled via the included remote control or a dedicated mobile application. Both methods offer comprehensive control over fan and lighting functions.

Fan Operation

- Fan Speeds: The fan offers 6 adjustable speeds.
 - Levels 1-2: Low Comfortable Wind (e.g., for sleeping)
 - Levels 3-4: Medium Natural Wind

- o Levels 5-6: High Cooling Wind
- Reversible DC Motor: The fan features a reversible motor for year-round comfort.
 - Summer Mode (Forward Rotation): Creates a downward airflow, providing a cooling breeze.
 - Winter Mode (Reverse Rotation): Creates an upward airflow, circulating warm air trapped near the ceiling.

To activate the reverse function, press the R/F key on the remote or app. The fan will stop completely and then automatically reverse direction after 5-8 seconds.

• Timer Function: Set the fan to turn off automatically after 2 hours using the timer function.

Lighting Operation

- LED Dimmable Light: The integrated LED light is dimmable, allowing you to adjust brightness from 20% to 100%.
- 3 Color Temperatures: Choose from three white light color temperatures: 6000K (Cool White), 4000K (Natural White), and 3000K (Warm White).
- **RGB Lighting:** The fan features vibrant RGB lighting for ambient effects. To activate RGB modes, first press the On/Off button to turn on the main light, then press the RGB button to cycle through color effects. This prevents accidental mode conflicts.
- Light Memory Function: The fan remembers your last light setting when turned off and on again.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your ceiling fan.

- Cleaning: To avoid damage to the finish, clean the fan with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Blade Cleaning: Periodically wipe the fan blades to remove dust buildup, which can affect airflow and balance.
- Tightness Check: Check all screws and connections on the fan and mounting hardware periodically to ensure they are secure.
- Light Source: The integrated LED light source is designed for long life and typically does not require replacement.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Surtime ceiling fan, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

Problem	Possible Cause(s)	Solution
Fan does not start	No power to the fan; Loose wire connections; Remote control battery low or not paired.	Check circuit breaker. Ensure all wiring connections are secure. Replace remote battery or re-pair the remote/app with the fan (refer to manual for pairing instructions).
Fan makes excessive noise	Loose fan blades or mounting screws; Fan not properly balanced.	Tighten all screws on the fan blades and mounting bracket. Ensure blades are clean and free of debris. Refer to the manual for blade balancing instructions if necessary.
Light does not work	Loose wire connection to light kit; LED driver issue; Remote control issue.	Check connections to the light kit. Ensure the remote control is functioning and paired. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Difficulty syncing remote/app	Interference; Incorrect pairing procedure.	Ensure no other devices are interfering. Follow the pairing instructions in the manual precisely. It is recommended to sync after all fans are installed if you have multiple units.
Fan base rotates when turning on/off	Possible installation anomaly.	While unusual, if the fan functions correctly otherwise, this may not indicate a fault. Re-check mounting security. If concerned, contact customer support.
Fan speed control is inconsistent	Remote/app signal issue; Specific control logic.	Ensure clear line of sight for remote. Some models may require turning the fan off and then directly to the desired speed. Refer to the manual for specific control logic.

Surtime provides a **2-year warranty** for this ceiling fan. Additionally, a **30-day replacement guarantee** is offered for any defects or damages upon arrival.
