## INITIAL SETUP

### 1. Charging the Tablet

Before first use, fully charge your tablet. Connect the provided charger to the Type-C port (4) on the tablet and plug it into a power outlet. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status.

### 2. Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power Button (7) until the redbat logo appears on the screen.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power Button (7) until a power-off menu appears. Select "Power off" from the options.
- **To Restart:** From the power-off menu, select "Restart".

### 3. Initial Configuration

Upon first power-on, the tablet will guide you through the initial setup process. Follow the on-screen prompts to:

- Select your language.
- Connect to a Wi-Fi network.
- Set up your Google account (optional, but recommended for app downloads).
- Set date and time.

## OPERATING YOUR TABLET

### Basic Navigation

The redbeat B1 Tablet features an intuitive Android interface with large icons for ease of use.

- **Tap:** Touch an icon or option to select it.
- **Swipe:** Drag your finger across the screen to scroll through pages or lists.
- **Pinch:** Use two fingers to zoom in or out on images or web pages.
- **Long Press:** Press and hold an icon for more options or to move it.

### Connecting to Wi-Fi

1. Go to **Settings**.
2. Tap on **Network & internet**.
3. Tap on **Wi-Fi** and turn it on.
4. Select your desired Wi-Fi network from the list.
5. Enter the password if prompted and tap**Connect**.

### Installing Applications

The tablet comes with a variety of pre-installed educational and entertainment applications. You can download more applications from the Google Play Store (requires a Google account and Wi-Fi connection).

### Eye Protection Features

The redbeat B1 Tablet is equipped with eye protection HD touch display technology to minimize visual fatigue during prolonged use. It features low blue light technology and optimized brightness and contrast settings to ensure comfortable viewing in various environments.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the tablet in a cool, dry place.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the tablet regularly.
- **Protective Case:** The included durable case provides excellent protection against drops and collisions. Ensure the tablet is always used within its case. The case also functions as a convenient stand.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your redbat B1 Tablet, refer to the table below for common problems and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tablet does not turn on.	Low battery or system crash.	Charge the tablet for at least 30 minutes. If still unresponsive, press and hold the Power button for 10-15 seconds to force a restart.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi.	Incorrect password, out of range, or router issue.	Double-check the Wi-Fi password. Move closer to the router. Restart your Wi-Fi router.
Apps are slow or crashing.	Too many apps running, low storage, or app bug.	Close unnecessary apps. Clear app cache. Free up storage space. Restart the tablet. Update the app or tablet software.
Screen is unresponsive.	Temporary software glitch.	Force restart the tablet by holding the Power button for 10-15 seconds.
Battery drains quickly.	High screen brightness, many background apps, or old battery.	Reduce screen brightness. Close background apps. Disable Wi-Fi/Bluetooth when not in use.
