# Wanbo T2 Ultra Projector User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

The Wanbo T2 Ultra is a compact and versatile projector designed for home entertainment. It features Android TV 11.0, offering access to a wide range of streaming applications. With 500 ANSI lumens brightness and native 1080P Full HD resolution, it delivers clear and vibrant images. Advanced features like auto-focus, automatic keystone correction, and integrated HiFi speakers enhance the user experience. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, and maintenance of your Wanbo T2 Ultra projector.

### 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

#### 3.1 Projector Unit

## 3.2 Ports and Connections

- **HDMI (ARC) Port:** Connect to external devices such as laptops, gaming consoles, or TV boxes. Supports Audio Return Channel.
- **USB Port:** Connect USB storage devices for media playback.
- **Audio Port (3.5mm):** Connect external headphones or speakers.
- **Power Input:** Connect the power cable to supply power to the projector.

## 4. SETUP

### 4.1 Power Connection

1. Connect the power cable to the Power Input port on the projector.
2. Plug the other end of the power cable into a power outlet.
3. Press the power button on the projector or remote control to turn on the device.

### 4.2 Initial Setup

Upon first use, follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup, including language selection and Wi-Fi connection.

#### 4.2.1 Wi-Fi Connection

1. Navigate to **Settings** from the home screen.
2. Select **Network & Internet**.
3. Turn on Wi-Fi and select your desired network from the list.
4. Enter the Wi-Fi password using the on-screen keyboard and confirm.

#### 4.3 Focus & Keystone Correction

The Wanbo T2 Ultra features automatic focus and keystone correction for optimal image clarity and shape.

##### 4.3.1 Automatic Adjustment

- The projector automatically adjusts focus and keystone when powered on or moved.
- Obstacle avoidance and automatic screen adjustment features ensure the image fits perfectly on your projection surface.

## 4.3.2 Manual Adjustment (if needed)

1. Go to **Settings > Image Correction**.
2. Select **Manual Keystone Correction** to adjust the four corners of the image.
3. Select **Focus > Manual Focus** to fine-tune the image sharpness using the F+ and F- buttons on the remote.

## 4.4 Screen Adjustment

The projector supports digital zoom to adjust the screen size without moving the unit.

1. Go to **Settings > Image Correction**.
2. Select **Screen Zoom and Position**.
3. Use the directional buttons to adjust the position and the volume buttons to adjust the zoom (50% to 100%).

## 4.5 Projection Modes

The projector can be used in various orientations:

- **Front Projection:** Projector placed in front of the screen.

- **Rear Projection:** Projector placed behind a translucent screen.
- **Ceiling Projection:** Projector mounted upside down on the ceiling. The integrated stand allows for easy adjustment for ceiling or wall projection.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1 Remote Control Functions

- **Power Button:** Turns the projector on/off.
- **Voice Search:** Activates Google Assistant for voice commands.

- **One-Touch Focus:** Initiates automatic focus adjustment.
- **Directional Keys (Up/Down/Left/Right):** Navigate menus and selections.
- **OK Button:** Confirms selections.
- **Back Button:** Returns to the previous screen.
- **Home Button:** Returns to the home screen.
- **Volume +/-:** Adjusts the volume level.
- **Focus +/- (F+/F-):** Manually adjusts focus.
- **Mute Button:** Mutes/unmutes audio.
- **Input Signal Switch:** Changes input source.
- **App Settings:** Accesses application settings.
- **Projection Settings:** Accesses projection-related settings.
- **Direct App Buttons:** Dedicated buttons for Netflix, YouTube, Prime Video, and Disney+.

## 5.2 App Management (Android TV 11.0)

The Wanbo T2 Ultra runs on Android TV 11.0, providing access to the Google Play Store.

- **Accessing Apps:** From the home screen, you can directly launch pre-installed apps or navigate to the Google Play Store to download more.
- **Streaming Services:** Enjoy popular services like Netflix, Prime Video, YouTube, Disney+, Hulu, U-NEXT, and more. The projector supports Google Widevine DRM L1 for high-quality content playback.
- **Google Assistant:** Press the Voice Search button on the remote to use voice commands for searching content, controlling playback, and more.

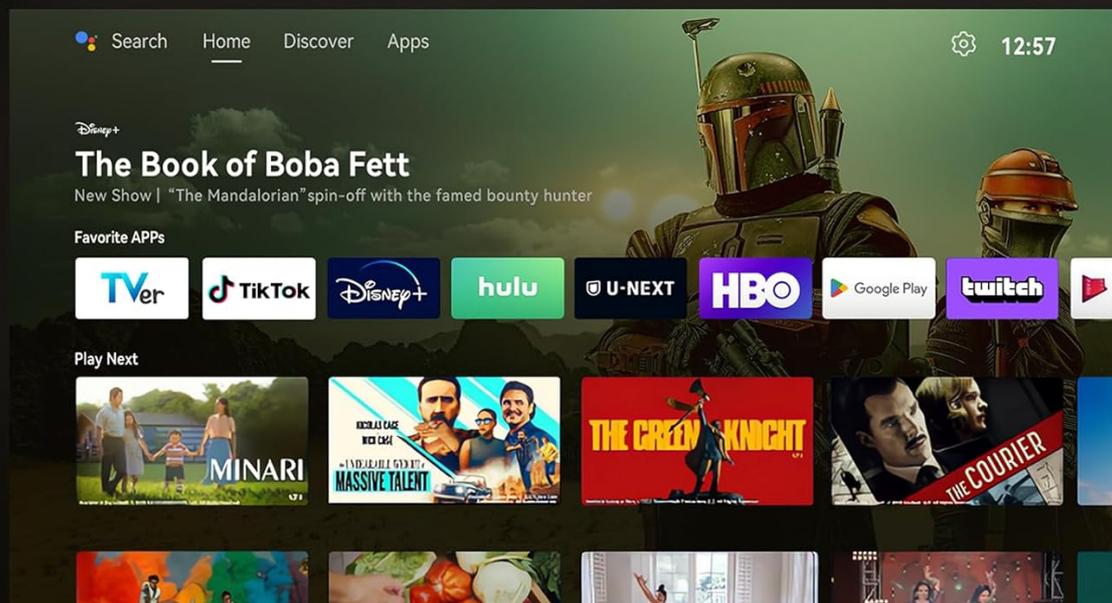

## 5.3 Connectivity

The Wanbo T2 Ultra offers multiple connectivity options for various devices.

### 5.3.1 HDMI Connection

1. Connect an HDMI cable from your external device (e.g., laptop, game console) to the HDMI port on the projector.
2. The projector will automatically detect the HDMI input. If not, navigate to **Signal Source** and select the corresponding HDMI input.

### 5.3.2 USB Connection

1. Insert a USB storage device into the USB port on the projector.
2. A notification will appear on the screen. Select to open the file manager and browse your media.

### 5.3.3 Bluetooth Connection

1. Go to **Settings > Bluetooth & Accessories**.
2. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled.
3. Select **Add Device** and choose your Bluetooth device (e.g., headphones, speakers) from the list to pair.

### 5.3.4 Wireless Screen Mirroring (Chromecast/AirPlay)

The projector has built-in Chromecast for seamless screen mirroring from iOS and Android devices.

- Ensure your mobile device and projector are connected to the same Wi-Fi network.
- On your mobile device, open a compatible app (e.g., YouTube, Netflix) and tap the Cast icon to select the projector.

### 5.4 Audio Settings

The projector features dual 5W HiFi speakers (10W total) with an independent DSP amplifier for rich sound. You can also

connect external audio devices.

### 5.4.1 Adjusting Sound Modes

1. Go to **Settings > Display & Sound > Sound Effects**.
2. Choose from various sound modes like Standard, Movie, Music, News, or Sports to optimize audio for your content.

### 5.4.2 Bluetooth Speaker Mode

You can use the projector as a standalone Bluetooth speaker.

1. From the home screen, select **Bluetooth Music**.
2. On your mobile device, enable Bluetooth and connect to the projector (device name: ISINBOX\_AC311 or similar).

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

### 6.1 Cleaning

- **Lens:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth or lens cleaning paper to gently wipe the lens. Avoid abrasive materials or excessive pressure.
- **Exterior:** Wipe the projector's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or solvents.
- **Vents:** Regularly clean the ventilation grilles to prevent dust buildup, which can affect performance and lifespan. Use a soft brush or compressed air.

### 6.2 Storage

- Store the projector in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- If storing for an extended period, place the projector in its original packaging or a protective case to prevent dust accumulation and damage.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your Wanbo T2 Ultra projector, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No image/Power off	Power cable disconnected; Projector off	Check power connections; Press power button
Blurry image	Out of focus; Incorrect keystone	Use auto-focus or manual focus; Adjust keystone correction
No sound	Volume too low; Muted; Incorrect audio output	Increase volume; Unmute; Check audio settings
Wi-Fi/Bluetooth connection issues	Incorrect password; Device out of range; Interference	Verify password; Move closer to router/device; Reduce interference
Remote control not working	Low battery; Obstruction; Not paired	Replace batteries; Remove obstructions; Re-pair remote
