INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Generic 6 Qt Programmable Slow Cooker Digital Display. This appliance is designed to simplify your cooking process with its large capacity and versatile preset functions. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating your new slow cooker to ensure safe and efficient use.

This slow cooker features a 6-quart capacity, suitable for serving up to 7 people, and includes 5 preset cooking functions: Meat, Poultry, Stew, Soup, and Chili. It also offers a programmable digital countdown timer and an automatic 'Keep Warm' function.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, always follow these basic safety precautions.

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs. The exterior of the slow cooker becomes hot during operation.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse the cord, plug, or heating base in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.

- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- Avoid sudden temperature changes, such as adding refrigerated foods into a heated pot.
- The ceramic pot and glass lid are fragile. Handle with care.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your slow cooker:

- **Heating Base:** The main unit containing the heating element and control panel.
- **Removable Ceramic Pot:** The inner cooking vessel where food is placed.
- **Tempered Glass Lid:** Allows you to monitor cooking progress.
- **Lid Rest:** A stainless steel accessory designed to hold the lid while serving.
- **Control Panel:** Digital display with touch-activated buttons for settings.
- **Cool-Touch Handles:** For safe portability of the heating base.

SETUP GUIDE

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and any promotional labels from the slow cooker.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the removable ceramic pot and tempered glass lid in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the exterior of the heating base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the heating base in water.
3. **Placement:** Place the heating base on a dry, level, heat-resistant surface, away from the edge of the counter. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the appliance.
4. **Assemble:** Place the clean ceramic pot into the heating base. Position the tempered glass lid on top of the ceramic pot.
5. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a standard 110V AC electrical outlet. The digital display will illuminate.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Control Panel Overview

The slow cooker features a touch-activated digital display. The display illuminates when touched or when the unit is powered on. Key buttons include:

- **Power Button (U):** Turns the appliance on or off.
- **Mode Button:** Cycles through the 5 preset cooking functions (Meat, Poultry, Stew, Soup, Chili) and the manual 'High', 'Low', and 'Warm' settings.
- **'+' and '-' Buttons:** Adjust cooking time or temperature settings.

Cooking Process

1. **Prepare Food:** Place your ingredients into the removable ceramic pot. Do not overfill; ensure the lid can close properly.
2. **Secure Lid:** Place the tempered glass lid onto the ceramic pot.
3. **Power On:** Press the Power button (U) to turn on the slow cooker. The display will light up.
4. **Select Function:** Press the 'Mode' button repeatedly to cycle through the desired cooking function

(Meat, Poultry, Stew, Soup, Chili) or select 'High' or 'Low' for manual cooking.

5. **Set Time:** Once a function or temperature is selected, use the '+' and '-' buttons to set the desired cooking time. The digital countdown timer can be set from 30 minutes up to 24 hours.
6. **Start Cooking:** The slow cooker will automatically begin cooking after the time is set. The display will show the remaining cooking time.
7. **Keep Warm:** Once the set cooking time has elapsed, the slow cooker will automatically switch to the 'Keep Warm' function. This function maintains food at a safe serving temperature without further cooking.
8. **Serving:** Use the cool-touch handles to carefully transport the slow cooker if needed. The stainless-steel lid rest can be used to hold the lid while serving.
9. **Power Off:** After serving, press the Power button (U) to turn off the appliance and unplug it from the wall outlet.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your slow cooker.

1. **Unplug and Cool:** Always unplug the slow cooker from the electrical outlet and allow it to cool

completely before cleaning.

- Dishwasher Safe Parts:** The removable ceramic pot and tempered glass lid are dishwasher safe for convenient cleaning.
- Hand Washing:** For hand washing, use warm, soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge or cloth. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
- Heating Base:** Wipe the exterior of the heating base with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads. Never immerse the heating base in water or any other liquid.
- Stubborn Residue:** If food sticks to the ceramic pot, fill it with warm, soapy water and let it soak for a few hours before cleaning. Do not use metal utensils or harsh chemicals that could damage the non-stick surface.
- Storage:** Store the slow cooker in a dry place. Ensure all parts are clean and dry before storing.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

If you experience issues with your slow cooker, please consult the following table before contacting customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Slow cooker does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet malfunction; unit not powered on.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Press the Power button (U). Test the outlet with another appliance.
Food is not cooking properly.	Incorrect temperature setting; insufficient cooking time; lid not sealed properly.	Verify the correct cooking function (High/Low/Preset) and time are selected. Ensure the lid is seated firmly on the ceramic pot. Avoid lifting the lid frequently during cooking.
Display is not responding to touch.	Moisture or debris on the control panel; temporary electronic glitch.	Ensure the control panel is clean and dry. Unplug the unit for 5 minutes, then plug it back in and try again.
Food is burning on the bottom.	Too little liquid; cooking on too high a setting for too long.	Ensure adequate liquid is used for the recipe. Consider using a 'Low' setting for longer cooking times or reducing the cooking duration.
