1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your Aheaplus Closet System. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new closet organizer. Please read it thoroughly before beginning assembly or use.

The Aheaplus Closet System is designed to provide a versatile and spacious storage solution for various items, including clothing, accessories, and household goods. Its robust construction ensures durability and stability.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow these safety guidelines to prevent injury or damage to the product:

- **Adult Assembly Required:** This product requires assembly by two adults.
- **Anti-Tip Kit:** Always secure the closet system to the wall using the provided anti-tip kits to prevent tipping, especially in households with children or pets.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 2000 lbs for the entire system, and 100 lbs per hanging rod. Overloading can cause structural failure.
- **Stable Surface:** Assemble and place the closet system on a flat, level, and stable surface.
- **Careful Handling:** Handle all components with care during assembly to avoid scratches or damage.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation if storing items that require air circulation.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your Aheaplus Closet System is delivered in 3 separate packages. Please verify all components are present before beginning assembly. Refer to the parts list included in your physical manual for detailed identification.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is recommended for two people. All parts are clearly labeled. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the included physical assembly manual.

4.1. Pre-Assembly Checklist

- Unpack all components and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.
- Identify all parts using the parts list in your manual.
- Ensure all hardware and tools are present. A larger screwdriver than the one provided may be helpful for comfort.

4.2. Assembly Configurations

The Aheaplus Closet System offers flexible installation options and can be configured in various ways to suit your space. It can be set up as a multi-function unit or as 3 separate closet organizers.

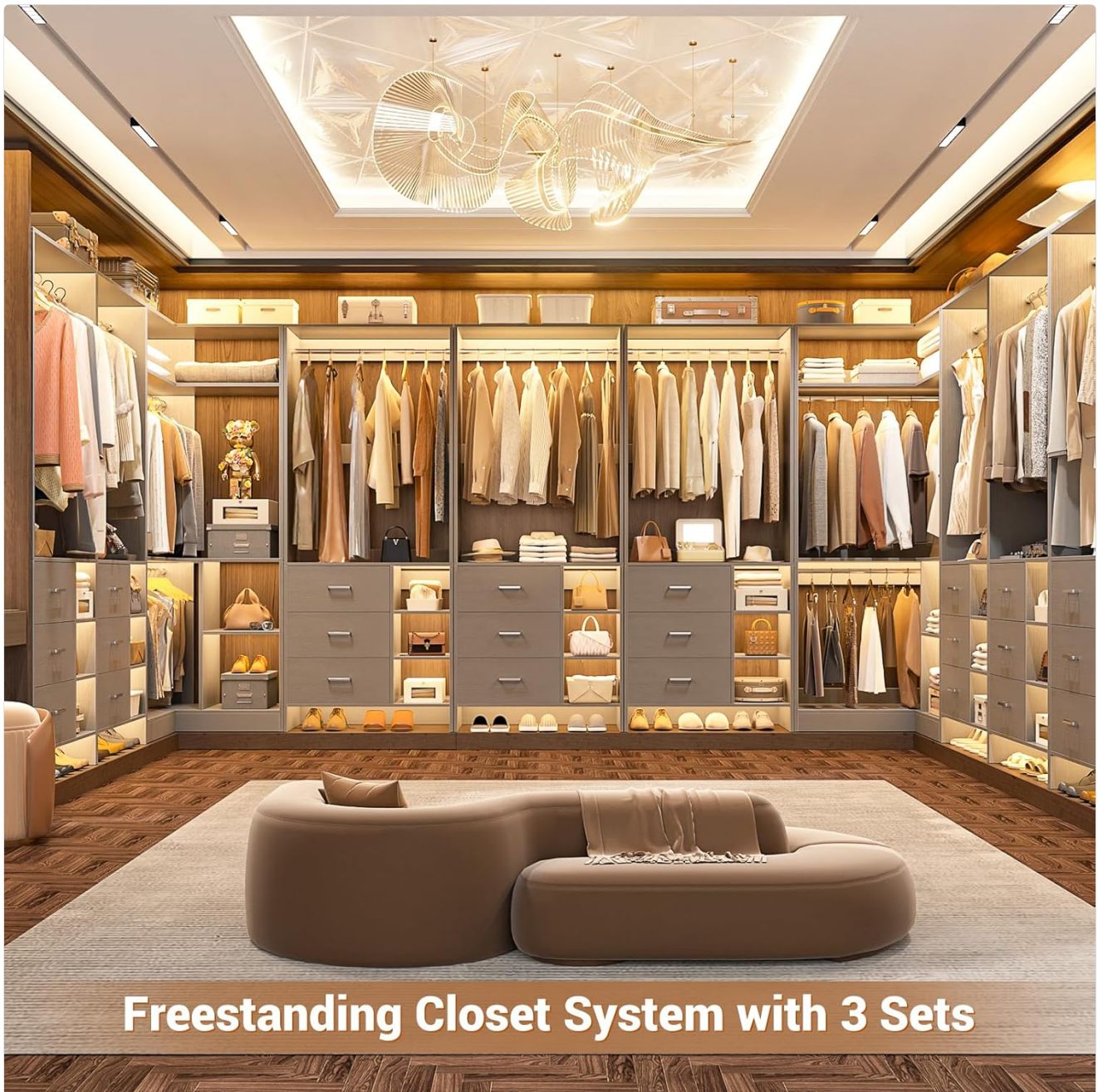


Three Different Combinations

4.3. Important Assembly Notes

- Pilot holes are pre-drilled for ease of assembly.
- Be careful not to overtighten screws, especially cam locks and wood screws, as this can damage the fiberboard material. Hand-tightening is recommended.
- Utilize the anti-tip accessories to ensure safety and stability.

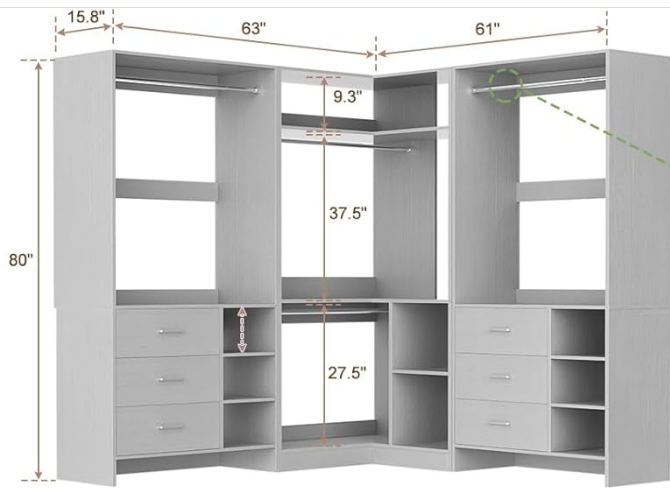
Image: The Aheplus Closet System showcasing its storage capabilities with hanging clothes, folded items, and accessories in drawers and on shelves.

5.1. Versatile Placement

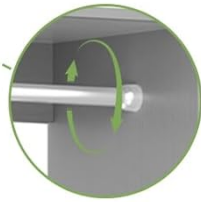

Image: The Aheaplus Closet System integrated into a bedroom as a walk-in wardrobe, demonstrating its aesthetic and functional appeal.



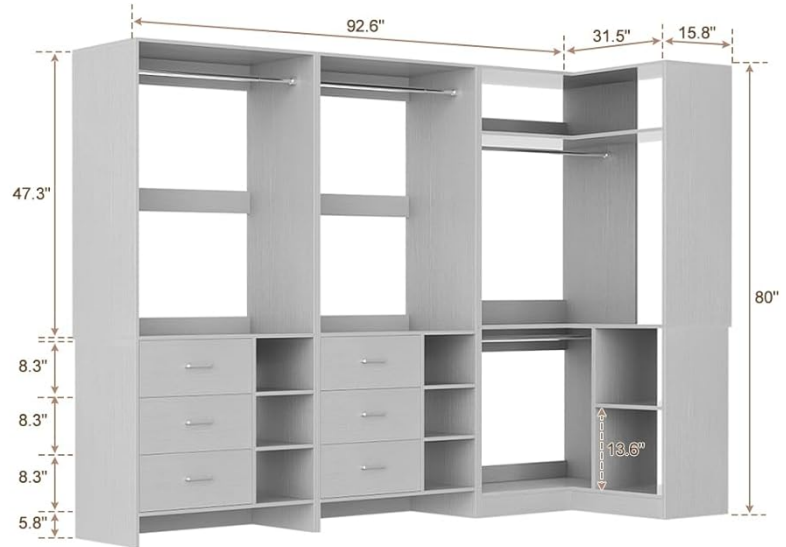

5.2. Maximizing Storage

- Utilize the full top storage row for less frequently used items or seasonal storage.
- The corner tower provides accessible shelving for folded clothes, bags, or decorative items.
- The bottom space beneath hanging rods is ideal for shoe storage.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the life of your Aheaplus Closet System:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Dusting:** Regularly dust all surfaces to prevent buildup.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.

- **Avoid Moisture:** Protect the system from excessive moisture and direct sunlight to prevent warping or discoloration.
- **Drawer Care:** The bottoms of the drawers are 1/8" thick. Avoid storing excessively heavy items in the drawers to prevent damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Aheaplus Closet System, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
System feels wobbly after assembly.	Screws are loose; anti-tip kit not installed or improperly installed.	Ensure all screws are tightened. Install the anti-tip kit securely to the wall as per instructions.
Drawers do not slide smoothly.	Drawer slides are misaligned or obstructed.	Check that drawer slides are correctly installed and aligned. Remove any obstructions.
Parts are missing or damaged upon delivery.	Shipping error or manufacturing defect.	Contact Aheaplus customer support immediately with your purchase details.
Difficulty with assembly.	Instructions unclear or parts misidentified.	Review the assembly manual carefully. Ensure parts are correctly oriented. Contact customer support if issues persist.
