1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper installation, use, and maintenance of your Chicco MyFit Harness + Booster Car Seat. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the car seat and keep it in a safe place for future reference. This 2-in-1 car seat is designed to adapt as your child grows, converting from a 5-point harness car seat for toddlers to a belt-positioning booster for older children.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your child's safety is paramount. Always adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- **Read All Instructions:** Before installation or use, carefully read and understand all instructions provided in this manual and on the car seat labels.
- **Proper Installation:** Ensure the car seat is correctly installed in your vehicle using either the LATCH system or the vehicle's seat belt, as appropriate for your child's weight and the car seat mode. Refer to the "Setup & Installation" section for detailed steps.
- **Child Weight and Height Limits:** Always use the car seat within the specified weight and height limits for each mode (harness or booster).
- **Harness Adjustment:** In harness mode, ensure the 5-point harness is snug and positioned correctly

on your child. The chest clip should be at armpit level.

- **Vehicle Seat Belt Fit:** In booster mode, ensure the vehicle's lap and shoulder belt fit properly across your child's hips and shoulder.
- **Impact Protection:** The car seat features a deep rigid shell, EPS energy-absorbing foam, and a steel-reinforced frame for enhanced impact protection.
- **Never Leave Unattended:** Do not leave your child unattended in the car seat.
- **After an Accident:** A car seat that has been involved in a moderate to severe crash should be replaced, even if there is no visible damage.

3. COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the various parts of your Chicco MyFit car seat:

- **Headrest:** Adjustable to 9 positions for growing children.
- **5-Point Harness System:** For use in harness mode.
- **Chest Clip:** Secures shoulder straps.
- **Buckle:** Secures the harness.
- **LATCH Connectors:** For secure installation in vehicles equipped with LATCH.
- **LockSure Belt-Tightening System:** For secure installation using vehicle seat belts.
- **ReclineSure Leveling System:** Provides 4 recline positions for proper vehicle fit.
- **RideRight Bubble Levels:** Indicators for correct recline angle.
- **ErgoBoost Seat:** Contoured seat with dual-density foam padding.
- **CupFolders:** Two dishwasher-safe, fold-away cup holders.
- **Shoulder Belt Guides:** For proper positioning of the vehicle seat belt in booster mode.

4. SETUP & INSTALLATION

Proper installation is critical for safety. Follow these steps carefully:

4.1 Preparing the Car Seat

1. **Adjust Headrest:** Press the headrest adjustment lever (often located at the top of the seat back) and slide the headrest to the appropriate height for your child.
2. **Select Recline Position:** Use the ReclineSure leveling system to choose one of the 4 recline positions. Ensure the RideRight bubble levels indicate a proper angle for your vehicle.

4.2 Installation in Harness Mode (for toddlers)

For children within the harness weight and height limits:

- **LATCH Installation:**

- a. Locate your vehicle's lower anchor bars.
- b. Attach the car seat's LATCH connectors to the vehicle's lower anchor bars.
- c. Press down firmly on the car seat and pull the LATCH strap to tighten until the car seat does not move more than 1 inch side-to-side or front-to-back at the belt path.
- d. Attach the top tether strap to the vehicle's top tether anchor and tighten.

- **Vehicle Seat Belt Installation:**

- a. Route the vehicle's lap and shoulder belt through the designated belt path on the car seat.
- b. Buckle the vehicle seat belt.
- c. Engage the LockSure belt-tightening system by lifting the lever and feeding the belt through, then closing the lever to secure.
- d. Press down firmly on the car seat and pull the vehicle seat belt to tighten until the car seat does not move more than 1 inch side-to-side or front-to-back at the belt path.

- e. Attach the top tether strap to the vehicle's top tether anchor and tighten.

4.3 Converting to Booster Mode (for older children)

When your child outgrows the harness limits, convert the car seat to belt-positioning booster mode:

1. **Remove Harness:** Follow the instructions in your full product manual to safely remove and store the 5-point harness system. The car seat has integrated storage compartments for the harness straps.
2. **Position Car Seat:** Place the car seat on the vehicle seat.
3. **Secure Child:** Seat your child in the booster. Route the vehicle's lap and shoulder belt through the designated shoulder belt guide and under the armrests. Ensure the lap belt lies low across the hips and the shoulder belt rests across the center of the shoulder and chest.

5. OPERATION

5.1 Securing Your Child in Harness Mode

1. Place your child in the car seat.
2. Bring the shoulder straps over your child's shoulders and buckle the harness.
3. Connect the chest clip at armpit level.
4. Pull the harness adjustment strap to tighten the harness until it is snug against your child's body. Ensure you cannot pinch any excess webbing at the shoulder.

5.2 Using CupFolders

The car seat includes two removable and dishwasher-safe CupFolders. These can be folded away to save space when not in use.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance ensure the longevity and safety of your car seat.

- **Fabric Covers:** The fabric covers can be removed for cleaning. Refer to the care labels on the fabric for specific washing instructions. Typically, machine wash cold on delicate cycle and hang to dry. Do not use bleach.
- **Harness Straps:** Wipe harness straps with a damp cloth. Do not machine wash or immerse harness straps in water, as this can weaken the webbing.
- **Plastic and Metal Parts:** Wipe plastic and metal parts with a soft, damp cloth and mild soap. Air dry thoroughly.
- **CupFolders:** The CupFolders are dishwasher-safe.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the car seat for any signs of damage, wear, or missing parts. Contact customer support if you notice any issues.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your car seat, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car seat moves more than 1 inch after installation.	Loose LATCH strap or vehicle seat belt.	Re-install the car seat, ensuring the LATCH strap or vehicle seat belt is pulled as tightly as possible while pressing down on the car seat. Check RideRight bubble levels.
Harness straps are difficult to tighten or loosen.	Harness webbing may be twisted or caught.	Check for twists in the harness straps. Ensure the harness is routed correctly through the seat back.
Chest clip does not stay latched.	Debris in the latch mechanism or damaged clip.	Inspect the chest clip for obstructions. If damaged, contact customer support for a replacement.
Headrest adjustment is stiff.	Mechanism may be obstructed or dirty.	Ensure no fabric or debris is blocking the adjustment mechanism. Apply gentle pressure while adjusting.







