1. WELCOME

Thank you for choosing the isinwheel U8 Ultra Electric Bike. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new electric bike. Please read it thoroughly before your first ride and keep it for future reference.

2. SAFETY GUIDELINES

Your safety is paramount. Always adhere to local traffic laws and wear appropriate safety gear, including a helmet. Regular maintenance is crucial for safe operation.

- Always wear a helmet and other protective gear.
- Familiarize yourself with local electric bike regulations.
- Perform a pre-ride safety check before each use.
- Do not ride under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Ensure all components are securely fastened before riding.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The isinwheel U8 Ultra is a robust electric bike designed for various terrains, featuring a powerful motor, long-range battery, and full suspension for a comfortable ride.

- **1500W Peak Brushless Motor:** Delivers up to 28 MPH top speed and 80Nm torque, capable of conquering 30% slopes.
- **48V 18Ah Integrated Battery:** IPX6 waterproof, offering 105+ miles range (PAS mode) with BMS 2.0 for enhanced safety and durability.
- **26"x4.0" All-Terrain Fat Tires:** Puncture-proof with 3X wear-resistant layers and drainage grooves, tested for 5000 miles.
- **Full Suspension System:** Enhances comfort and control over varied terrain.
- **Sealed Hydraulic Brakes:** Provides instant stopping power, corrosion-resistant, and low-maintenance.
- **4+1 Smart Riding Modes:** Pedal Assist System (PAS), Electric, Cruise, Walk, and Pedal modes for versatile riding.
- **Easy Step-Thru Design:** Lightweight 6061 aluminum frame for easy mounting and dismounting, suitable for riders of all ages and abilities.

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

The isinwheel U8 Ultra Electric Bike comes partially assembled. Follow these steps to complete the assembly process.

4.1. Unboxing and Initial Setup

Carefully remove the bike and all components from the packaging. Lay out all parts and tools provided.




Image: Rear wheel and motor assembly, highlighting the 1500W peak brushless motor and its capability on inclines.

4.2. Handlebar Installation

Attach the handlebar to the stem, ensuring it is centered and the bolts are tightened securely. Adjust the angle for comfortable riding.

4.3. Front Wheel and Fender Installation

Install the front wheel, ensuring the brake rotor is correctly aligned with the caliper. Attach the front fender and headlight.

4.4. Seat Post and Rear Reflector Installation

Insert the seat post into the frame and adjust the height. Attach the rear reflector to the seat post.

4.5. Pedal Installation

Identify the left (L) and right (R) pedals. Thread them into the crank arms and tighten securely. Remember that the left pedal has a reverse thread.

4.6. Rear Rack Installation

Securely attach the rear rack to the designated mounting points on the frame.

5. OPERATING YOUR ELECTRIC BIKE

Understand the various modes and functions to maximize your riding experience.

5.1. Power On/Off

To power on the bike, press and hold the power button on the display unit. To power off, press and hold the same button. The display will show battery level, speed, and assist mode.

5.2. Riding Modes

The U8 Ultra offers 4+1 smart riding modes:

- **Pedal Assist System (PAS):** Provides motor assistance as you pedal. Adjust assist levels using the '+' and '-' buttons on the display.
- **Electric Mode:** Use the throttle for full electric power without pedaling.
- **Cruise Mode:** Maintains a set speed without continuous throttle input.
- **Walk Mode:** Provides low-speed assistance for walking the bike.

- **Pedal Mode:** Ride the bike like a traditional bicycle without motor assistance.

5.3. Lighting System

The bike is equipped with a 2000lm headlight and a high-visibility taillight for enhanced safety, especially during low-light conditions.

6. BATTERY REMOVAL AND CHARGING

Proper battery handling and charging ensure longevity and safety.

6.1. Battery Removal

To remove the battery, use the provided key to unlock it from the frame. Carefully slide the battery out.

6.2. Charging Operation

Connect the charger to a power outlet, then connect the charging cable to the bike's charging port. The charger indicator light will show charging status. Ensure the charging port cover is closed when not charging.

7. MAINTENANCE GUIDE

Regular maintenance is essential for the performance and lifespan of your electric bike.

- **Tires:** Check tire pressure regularly and ensure tires are free from punctures or excessive wear.
- **Brakes:** Inspect brake pads and rotors for wear. Ensure hydraulic brakes are functioning correctly and provide instant stopping power.
- **Chain:** Keep the chain clean and lubricated for smooth gear changes and to prevent rust.
- **Battery:** Store the battery in a cool, dry place and charge it regularly, even if not in use, to maintain its health.
- **Fasteners:** Periodically check all bolts and screws for tightness.
- **Cleaning:** Clean the bike with a damp cloth. Avoid high-pressure washing directly on electrical components.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

This section addresses common problems you might encounter and their potential solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bike does not power on	Battery not charged or not properly seated.	Ensure battery is fully charged and securely locked into the frame. Check connections.
Motor not assisting	PAS level set to zero, or a sensor issue.	Increase PAS level on the display. Check for error codes on the display.
Brakes feel spongy	Air in hydraulic lines or worn brake pads.	Bleed the hydraulic brakes or replace brake pads. Consult a professional if unsure.
Unusual noises during riding	Loose components, dry chain, or brake rub.	Inspect all fasteners, lubricate the chain, and check brake caliper alignment.
