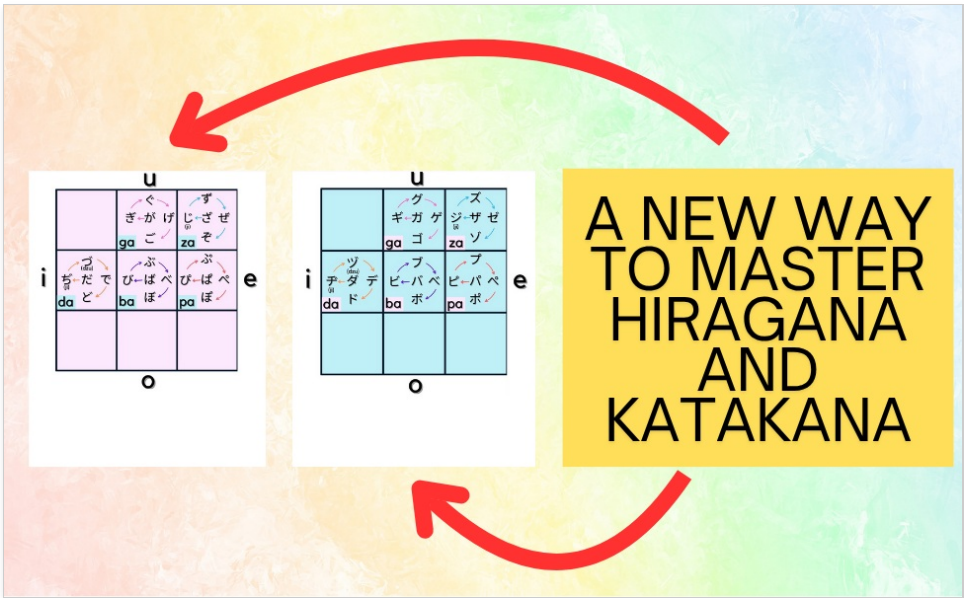


Figure 2: Visual aids for Hiragana and Katakana mastery. These charts present a structured approach to learning the Japanese syllabaries, aiding in rapid memorization.

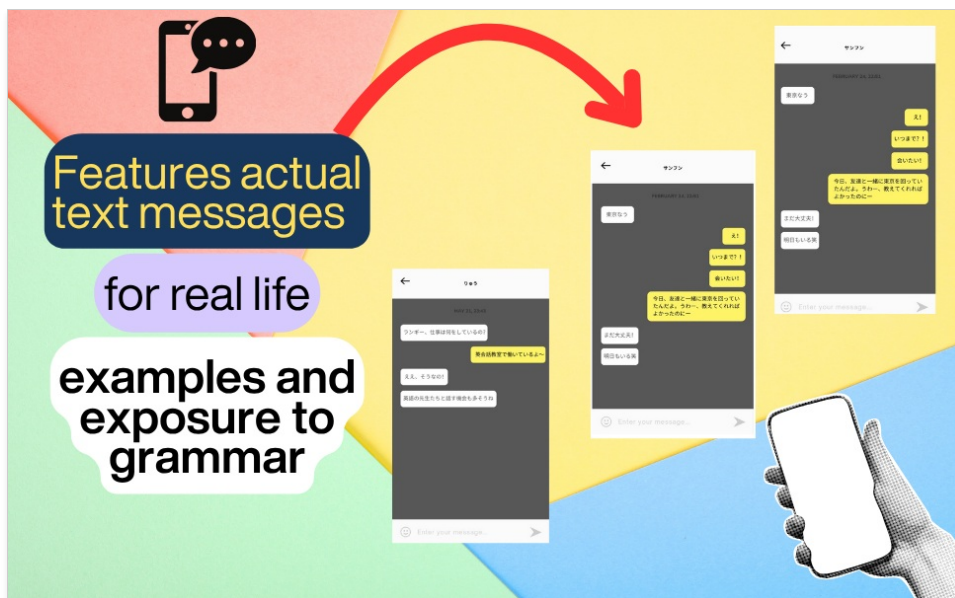


Figure 3: Real-life text message examples. These images illustrate practical applications of Japanese grammar in authentic conversational contexts, enhancing understanding and retention.

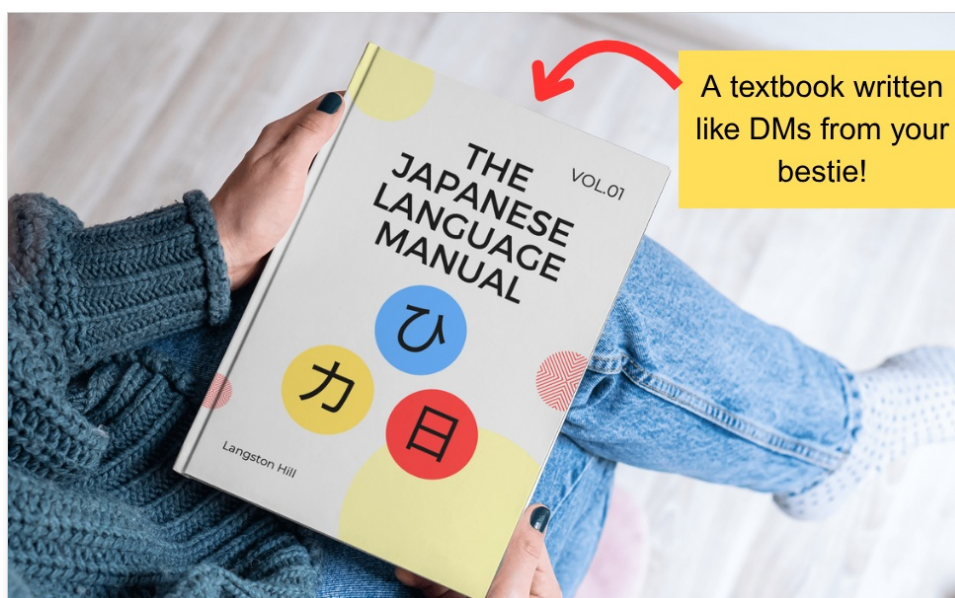


Figure 4: The manual's conversational learning style. This image highlights the book's accessible and engaging method of teaching Japanese, designed to feel like a personal guide.
