1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

- Waterproof Design: Equipped with a quiet 6500 RPM motor and a waterproof construction, allowing for discreet wet or dry use, including in the shower.
- **Travel-Ready:** Cordless, sleek, and USB-C rechargeable, offering adjustable lengths, a built-in guard, travel lock, LED spotlight, and a 90-minute runtime for convenient use anywhere.

3. SETUP

3.1 Charging the Trimmer

Before first use, fully charge your MERIDIAN Slimmer Trimmer. The device is equipped with a USB-C charging port for convenience.

- Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the trimmer and a compatible USB power source (e.g., laptop, power bank, USB-C charger, car charger).
- A full charge provides approximately 90 minutes of runtime.
- Battery indicator lights: Green light indicates 30-100% charge, Red light indicates 0-30% charge.




Figure 3: Trimmer displaying battery indicator lights and charging information.

3.2 Attaching Guide Combs

The trimmer comes with two guide combs to achieve different hair lengths:

- 3-6mm Comb: For a shorter trim.
- 9-12mm Comb: For a longer trim.

To attach a comb, align it with the trimmer head and gently push until it clicks into place. Ensure it is securely fastened before use. To remove, gently pull the comb away from the trimmer head.




Figure 4: Guide combs for adjusting trimming length.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Powering On/Off and LED Spotlight

- Press the power button once to turn the trimmer on.
- Press the power button a second time to activate the built-in LED spotlight for enhanced visibility in dimly lit areas.
- Press the power button a third time to turn the trimmer and LED spotlight off.

4.2 Wet and Dry Use

The MERIDIAN Slimmer Trimmer is 100% waterproof, allowing for comfortable wet or dry grooming. You can use it


in the shower for easy cleanup. Ensure the charging port is dry before charging.

4.3 Trimming Tips

- For optimal results, ensure the trimmer is fully charged.
- Place the flat side of the blade gently against your skin.
- Trim in the opposite direction of hair growth for the smoothest results.
- Use the adjustable guide combs for desired hair lengths.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Trimmer

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and hygiene.

- After each use, remove the blade head by gently snapping it off.
- Rinse the blade head under running water to remove hair and debris.
- Use the provided cleaning brush to clear any stubborn hair from the blades and inside the trimmer body.
- Ensure all parts are dry before reattaching the blade head and storing the trimmer.

5.2 Blade Replacement

The ceramic blades are designed for durability but may require replacement over time to maintain optimal sharpness and prevent irritation. Replacement blades can be purchased separately.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- Trimmer Not Turning On: Ensure the device is fully charged. Check the charging cable and power source.
- **Reduced Trimming Performance:** Clean the blade head thoroughly to remove any trapped hair. If performance does not improve, consider replacing the blade.
- **Skin Irritation:** Ensure the blade is clean and sharp. Use the appropriate guide comb for your desired length. Trim gently and in the opposite direction of hair growth.
