SETUP

1. Battery and Charger (Not Included)

The ARRMA Granite 223S BLX requires a compatible 2S or 3S LiPo battery and charger, which are not included with the truck. Ensure you use IC5 compatible batteries. Refer to the image below for maximum battery tray dimensions and recommended battery types.







2. Transmitter Setup

The Spektrum SLT3 2.4GHz Transmitter is included. Ensure it has 4 AA batteries installed (included with product). Familiarize yourself with the transmitter's controls, including steering, throttle, and trim adjustments, before operating the vehicle.

3. Body Installation

The truck features an aggressively styled body with a clipless body retention system for easy and secure attachment. Align the body with the chassis and press down firmly until it clicks into place. To remove, simply press the release tabs.

OPERATING THE MONSTER TRUCK

1. Powering On

After installing the battery and securing the body, turn on the transmitter first, then the vehicle's power switch. The Spektrum SLT 80A 2-in-1 Waterproof ESC & Receiver will initialize. Wait for the system to connect before attempting to drive.

The Granite 223S BLX is 2S and 3S ready, offering versatile speed options from beginner to pro-level. The Spektrum DSC (Dynamic Stability Control) and throttle limiting features assist in maintaining control, especially during high-speed maneuvers or on challenging terrains. Its heavy-duty transmission and all-terrain suspension are designed for aggressive bashing and off-road performance.

MAINTENANCE

Inspect all moving parts, including the drivetrain, suspension components, and steering linkages, for any signs of wear or damage. Ensure all screws are tightened and lubricate moving parts as recommended in the full product manual.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ARRMA Granite 223S BLX, consider the following general troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Check battery charge, ensure all connections are secure, and verify the power switch is on for both the truck and transmitter.
- **Loss of Control:** Re-bind the transmitter and receiver. Check for interference or low battery in the transmitter.
- **Reduced Performance:** Inspect for debris in moving parts, check for damaged gears or bearings, and ensure the motor and ESC are not overheating.
- **Unusual Noises:** This often indicates a worn or damaged gear. Inspect the drivetrain for any broken or stripped teeth.


Image: Diagram illustrating the key dimensions of the ARRMA Granite 4X4 3S BLX Monster Truck.


