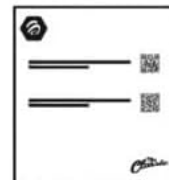

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **BT-350 Voice Remote:** Includes voice control capabilities, LED backlit buttons for visibility in low-light conditions, full air mouse functionality, and extended battery life with AA batteries.
- **Enhanced Connectivity:** Equipped with dual antennas and 6th Gen Wireless AX for improved Wi-Fi range and performance, alongside a Gigabit LAN port for ultra-stable wired network connections.
- **BuzzTV 5 OS with PVR+:** Provides a seamless operating system experience with advanced features such as

program recording (PVR+) and TimeShift for live television, benefiting from years of OS innovation for optimal performance.

4. INITIAL SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your BuzzTV Classic Anniversary Edition media device:

1. **Connect to TV:** Connect one end of the provided HDMI cable to the HDMI port on the BuzzTV device and the other end to an available HDMI input on your television.
2. **Connect Power:** Plug the USB Type-C power supply into the "C-PWR" port on the BuzzTV device and then plug the power adapter into a wall outlet. The device should power on automatically.
3. **Insert Remote Batteries:** Open the battery compartment on the back of the BT-350 voice remote and insert the two AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity.
4. **Network Connection:**
 - **Wi-Fi:** On your TV screen, navigate to the network settings and select your Wi-Fi network. Enter the password if prompted.
 - **Wired (Ethernet):** For a more stable connection, connect an Ethernet cable from your router to the Gigabit

LAN port on the BuzzTV device.

5. **Initial Configuration:** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, including language selection, time zone, and Google account login (optional).

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once set up, you can begin using your BuzzTV device to access various entertainment options:

5.1 Navigating the Interface

Use the directional pad and OK button on your BT-350 remote to navigate through menus and select applications. The Home button will always return you to the main screen.

5.2 Using Applications

The BuzzTV Classic Anniversary Edition runs on BuzzTV 5 OS, which is based on Android 11. You can download and install various streaming applications from the app store. Simply select an app icon from the home screen to launch it.

5.3 Power On/Off

Press the Power button on the BT-350 remote to turn the device on or put it into standby mode. To fully power off the device, disconnect the power supply.

6. BT-350 VOICE REMOTE

The BT-350 Voice Remote is designed for intuitive control of your BuzzTV device. It features:

- **Voice Control:** Press the microphone button to activate voice commands for searching content, launching apps, and more.

- **LED Backlit Buttons:** Buttons illuminate for easy use in dark environments.
- **Air Mouse Functionality:** Activate the air mouse to control an on-screen cursor by moving the remote in the air.
- **Dedicated Buttons:** Quick access to common functions like Home, Back, Volume, Channel, Playback controls, and numerical input.

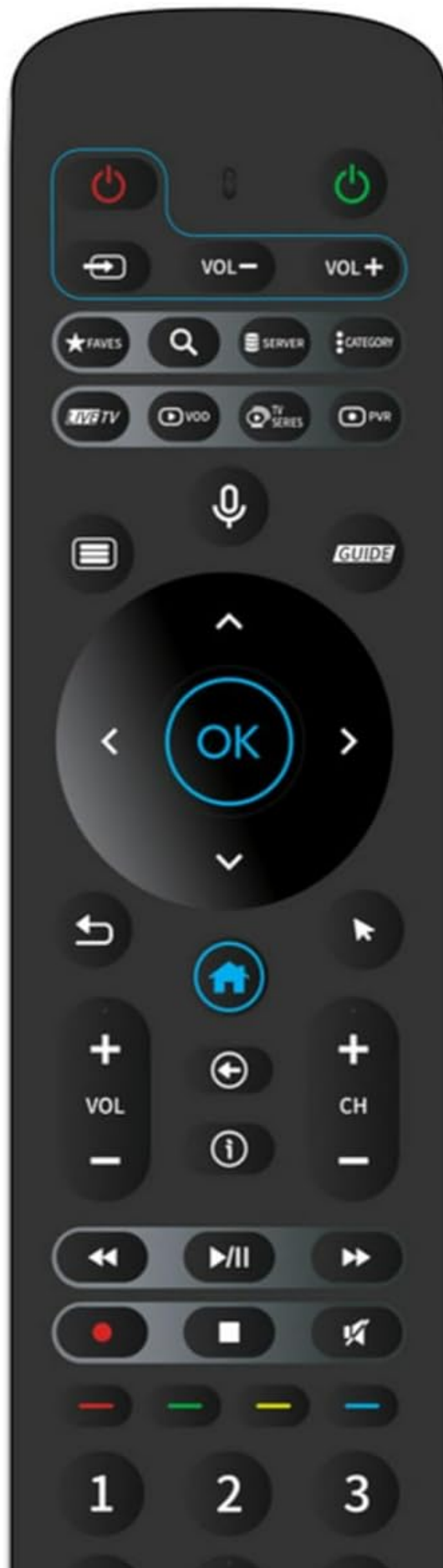




Image: A close-up view of the BT-350 voice remote control, highlighting its various buttons including power, volume, channel, navigation, voice control, and numerical keypad.

7. CONNECTIVITY

The BuzzTV Classic Anniversary Edition offers robust connectivity options:

- **Wi-Fi 6 (6th Gen Wireless AX):** Provides faster speeds, lower latency, and improved performance in congested network environments. Dual antennas enhance range and signal stability.
- **Gigabit LAN:** A wired Ethernet port for ultra-stable and high-speed internet connections, ideal for 4K streaming and large file transfers.
- **USB 3.0 Port:** For connecting external storage devices or other USB peripherals.
- **USB Type-C Port:** Primarily for power input.
- **HDMI:** For connecting to your television or display.
- **Optical Audio Output:** For connecting to external audio systems with optical input.

8. BuzzTV 5 OS WITH PVR+

The device runs on BuzzTV 5 OS, an optimized operating system based on Android 11, offering a user-friendly interface and advanced functionalities:

- **Program Recording (PVR+):** Allows you to record live television programs to external storage (USB drive, not included).
- **TimeShift:** Pause, rewind, and fast-forward live TV, giving you control over your viewing experience.
- **App Compatibility:** Access a wide range of Android applications for streaming, gaming, and productivity.

9. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your BuzzTV device, consider the following maintenance tips:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the device. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the device is placed in a well-ventilated area to prevent overheating. Do not block ventilation openings.
- **Software Updates:** Periodically check for and install system updates to ensure you have the latest features and security patches. This can usually be found in the device's settings menu.
- **Power Cycle:** If the device becomes unresponsive, disconnect the power supply for a few seconds and then reconnect it to perform a power cycle.

10. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your BuzzTV Classic Anniversary Edition, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power/Device not turning on	Power cable not connected properly; Power outlet issue	Ensure the USB Type-C power cable is securely connected to the device and the power adapter is plugged into a working wall outlet. Try a different outlet.
No signal on TV screen	Incorrect HDMI input selected; Loose HDMI cable	Verify your TV is set to the correct HDMI input. Check that the HDMI cable is securely connected to both the device and the TV. Try a different HDMI port or cable.
Remote not responding	Dead batteries; Remote not paired	Replace the AA batteries in the BT-350 remote. If the issue persists, refer to the device's on-screen settings for remote pairing instructions.
Wi-Fi connection issues	Incorrect password; Router issues; Signal interference	Double-check the Wi-Fi password. Restart your Wi-Fi router. Move the device closer to the router or use a wired Ethernet connection.
Applications freezing or crashing	Insufficient memory; App specific bug; Outdated software	Close background applications. Clear the cache of the problematic app. Ensure the device's software is up to date. Restart the device.



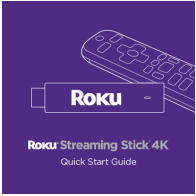

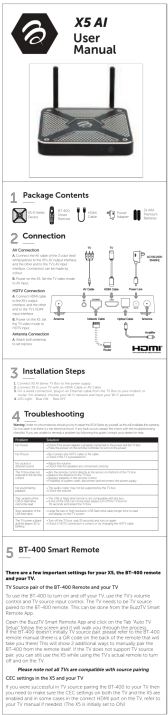
