1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the assembly, safe operation, and maintenance of your roomfitters Twin Over Twin Wood Bunk Bed with Roof and Window. 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety is paramount. Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Read All Instructions:** Ensure you understand all assembly steps and safety warnings before proceeding.
- **Adult Assembly Required:** This product requires adult assembly. Do not allow children to assist with assembly.
- **Supervision:** Children using the upper bunk should be supervised.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the recommended weight capacity for each bunk. (Specific weight capacity not provided, general warning).
- **Guardrails:** The upper bunk is equipped with full-length guardrails for safety. Ensure they are always securely in place.
- **Ladder Safety:** Always use the provided ladder for climbing to and from the upper bunk. Ensure the ladder is stable before use.
- **Mattress Size:** Use only mattresses of the specified size to prevent gaps that could pose an entrapment hazard.

- **No Horseplay:** Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check all bolts and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Retighten as necessary.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all parts and hardware are present. If any items are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

- Bed Frame Components (Headboards, Footboards, Side Rails, Slats)
- Roof and Window Panels
- Ladder
- Guardrails
- Hardware Pack (Bolts, Screws, Washers, Allen Wrench)
- Assembly Instructions Manual (this document)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly typically requires two adults. Clear a spacious area for assembly and keep all hardware out of reach of children.

- 1. Prepare the Area:** Unpack all components and lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Identify each part using the provided parts list.
- 2. Assemble the Lower Bunk Frame:** Attach the side rails to the headboard and footboard of the lower bunk using the specified bolts and an Allen wrench. Do not fully tighten bolts until the frame is complete.
- 3. Install Lower Bunk Slats:** Place the wooden slats across the lower bunk frame and secure them according to the instructions. Ensure even spacing.

4. **Assemble the Upper Bunk Frame:** Repeat the process for the upper bunk frame, attaching side rails to its headboard and footboard.
5. **Attach Upper Bunk to Lower Bunk:** Carefully lift the upper bunk frame and align it with the designated connection points on the lower bunk. Secure with the appropriate hardware. This step often requires two people.
6. **Install Upper Bunk Slats:** Secure the wooden slats for the upper bunk.
7. **Attach Guardrails:** Install the guardrails on all open sides of the upper bunk, ensuring they are firmly attached.
8. **Assemble and Attach Ladder:** Assemble the ladder components if necessary, then securely attach the ladder to the bunk bed frame in the designated position.
9. **Install Roof and Window Panels:** Attach the decorative roof and window panels to the upper bunk structure as indicated in the diagrams.
10. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place and aligned, systematically tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (USAGE)

This bunk bed is designed for sleeping and light recreational use within its structure. Follow these guidelines for safe operation:

- **Accessing Upper Bunk:** Always use the provided ladder to access the upper bunk. Do not climb on the guardrails or other parts of the bed.
- **Mattress Placement:** Ensure mattresses are properly seated within the bed frame and do not extend beyond the guardrails on the upper bunk.
- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute weight evenly on both bunks. Avoid concentrating weight in one small area.
- **Playhouse Feature:** The roof and window design is for imaginative play. Ensure children do not climb on the roof or hang from the window frames.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a damp cloth, then immediately dry with a clean, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that may damage the finish.
- **Hardware Checks:** Periodically (e.g., every 3 months) inspect all bolts, screws, and fasteners. Tighten any loose connections to maintain structural integrity.
- **Avoid Excessive Moisture:** Do not expose the bed to excessive moisture or humidity, as this can damage the wood.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Avoid prolonged direct sunlight exposure to prevent fading or discoloration of the wood finish.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|--------------------------------|---|---|
| Bed feels wobbly or unstable. | Loose hardware. | Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure all connections are secure. |
| Squeaking noises. | Loose connections or friction between wood parts. | Tighten all hardware. If squeaking persists, apply a small amount of paraffin wax or silicone spray to contact points between wood pieces (avoiding areas that bear weight directly). |
| Missing parts during assembly. | Packaging error or lost during unpacking. | Carefully re-check all packaging materials. If still missing, contact roomfitters customer support with your model number and a description of the missing part. |
| Ladder feels insecure. | Improper attachment or loose fasteners. | Ensure the ladder is correctly hooked or bolted to the bed frame as per assembly instructions. Tighten all ladder fasteners. |




Image 8.1: Technical drawing illustrating the precise dimensions of the bunk bed, including overall length, width, height, and internal measurements for each bunk.


