1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Cecotec Proclean 5110 Microwave with Grill. This appliance is designed to provide efficient and versatile cooking options for your home. Please read this manual carefully before using the appliance to ensure safe and optimal performance. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, injury, or exposure to excessive microwave energy.

- Do not attempt to operate this oven with the door open as this can result in harmful exposure to microwave energy.
- Do not place any object between the oven front face and the door or allow soil or cleaner residue to accumulate on sealing surfaces.
- Do not operate the oven if it is damaged. It is particularly important that the oven door closes properly and that there is no damage to the: (1) door (bent), (2) hinges and latches (broken or loosened), (3) door seals and sealing surfaces.
- The oven should not be adjusted or repaired by anyone except properly qualified service personnel.
- Ensure the appliance is placed on a flat, stable surface, away from heat sources and water.
- Do not use corrosive chemicals or vapors in this appliance.
- Always supervise children when the appliance is in use. The child safety lock feature is recommended.

- Liquids or other foods must not be heated in sealed containers since they are liable to explode.
- Only use utensils suitable for microwave ovens.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components and control panel of your Cecotec Proclean 5110 microwave.

Components:

- **Oven Cavity:** Interior space for cooking.
- **Glass Turntable:** Rotates food for even cooking.
- **Turtable Ring:** Supports the glass turntable.
- **Door Assembly:** Includes the door, hinges, and latch system.
- **Door Handle:** For opening and closing the oven door.
- **Control Panel:** Digital display, function buttons, and rotary knob.
- **Interior Lamp:** Illuminates the oven cavity during operation.

- **Grill Element:** Located at the top of the oven cavity for grilling functions.

Control Panel Functions:

- **Digital Display:** Shows time, power level, and cooking status.
- **Power Level Buttons:** Adjust microwave power (6 levels).
- **Grill Button:** Activates the grill function.
- **Defrost Button:** Selects defrost mode.
- **Timer/Clock Button:** Sets cooking time or current time.
- **Auto Cooking Programs:** Pre-set programs for various foods.
- **Rotary Knob:** Used to set time, weight, or select auto programs.
- **Start/Pause Button:** Initiates or pauses cooking.

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your microwave oven for the first time.

Unpacking:

1. Remove all packaging materials from inside and outside the oven.
2. Check the oven for any damage, such as dents or a misaligned door. Do not operate the oven if it is damaged.
3. Place the glass turntable and turntable ring inside the oven cavity.

Placement:

- Place the oven on a flat, stable surface that can support its weight and the heaviest food likely to be cooked in it.
- Ensure adequate ventilation. Leave a minimum of 20 cm (8 inches) of space above the oven, 10 cm (4 inches) at the rear, and 5 cm (2 inches) on each side.
- Do not block air vents. Blocking them can damage the oven and lead to poor cooking results.
- Keep the oven away from radio and TV to avoid interference.

Power Connection:

- Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage matches the specifications of the appliance.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section details how to use the various functions of your microwave oven.

5.1 Microwave Cooking (700W, 6 Power Levels)

The microwave offers 6 power levels for various cooking needs.

1. Place food in a microwave-safe container on the turntable.
2. Close the oven door securely.
3. Press the 'Microwave' button repeatedly to select the desired power level (P100, P80, P60, P40, P20, P0). P100 is full power (700W).
4. Use the rotary knob to set the cooking time (up to 60 minutes).
5. Press the 'Start' button to begin cooking.

5.2 Grill Function (800W)

The 800W grill function is ideal for browning and crisping food.

1. Place food on the grill rack (if provided) or a heat-resistant dish.
2. Close the oven door.
3. Press the 'Grill' button.
4. Use the rotary knob to set the grilling time.
5. Press the 'Start' button.

5.3 Defrost Mode

The defrost mode allows for uniform thawing of frozen foods.

1. Place frozen food in the oven.
2. Press the 'Defrost' button.
3. Use the rotary knob to set the defrost time or weight (refer to the display for options).
4. Press the 'Start' button.

5.4 Timer Function

Set cooking times up to 60 minutes.

1. Press the 'Timer/Clock' button.
2. Rotate the knob to set the desired time.
3. Press 'Start' to begin the countdown.

5.5 Automatic Cooking Programs

The microwave features 8 pre-set automatic cooking programs for convenience.

1. Place the food in the oven.
2. Press the 'Auto Cooking' button (or rotate the knob to select the program, depending on the model's interface).
3. Select the desired program number (e.g., for popcorn, pizza, vegetables).
4. Press 'Start'. The oven will automatically set the cooking time and power level.

5.6 End-of-Cooking Signal and Interior Lamp

The oven will emit an audible signal when cooking is complete. The interior lamp allows you to monitor food without opening the door.

5.7 Child Safety Lock

To prevent accidental operation by children, activate the child safety lock.

1. To activate: Press and hold the 'Stop/Cancel' button for 3 seconds. A lock indicator will appear on the

display.

2. To deactivate: Press and hold the 'Stop/Cancel' button again for 3 seconds. The lock indicator will disappear.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning helps maintain the performance and longevity of your microwave oven.

General Cleaning:

- Always unplug the oven before cleaning.
- Wipe the interior and exterior surfaces with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Clean the door seals and sealing surfaces regularly to ensure proper door closure.
- The glass turntable and turntable ring can be washed in warm soapy water or in a dishwasher.
- For stubborn stains inside the oven, place a bowl of water with lemon slices inside and microwave on high for 5-10 minutes. The steam will loosen the grime, making it easier to wipe away.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your microwave, refer to the following table for common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not start	Power cord not plugged in; Door not closed properly; Child safety lock activated.	Ensure plug is securely in outlet; Close door firmly; Deactivate child safety lock.
Food not heating	Incorrect power level selected; Cooking time too short; Utensils not microwave-safe.	Adjust power level and cooking time; Use microwave-safe dishes.
Turntable not rotating	Turntable or ring not correctly placed; Obstruction under turntable.	Re-position turntable and ring; Remove any obstructions.
Unusual noise during operation	Food container touching oven walls; Turntable not centered.	Adjust food container position; Re-center turntable.
Display shows error code	Internal malfunction.	Unplug the oven for a few minutes, then plug it back in. If the error persists, contact customer support.
