1. INTRODUCTION

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your pressure washer before operation.

1. **Main Unit:** Contains the motor and trigger mechanism.

2. **Battery Pack:** Rechargeable 20Ah Lithium-Ion battery.

5. SETUP

Follow these steps to prepare your pressure washer for use.

1. **Charge the Battery:**
 - Insert the battery into the charger.
 - Plug the charger into a suitable power outlet.
 - Allow the battery to fully charge before first use (indicator light will change).
2. **Attach the Battery:**
 - Once charged, slide the battery pack firmly into the base of the pressure washer handle until it clicks into place.
3. **Connect the Water Hose:**
 - Attach the water filter to one end of the water inlet hose.
 - Submerge the filtered end of the hose into a bucket of clean water, or connect it to a garden tap using an appropriate adapter (not included).
 - Connect the other end of the water hose to the water inlet connector on the pressure washer unit. Ensure a secure fit.
4. **Select and Attach Nozzle:**
 - Choose the desired spray nozzle (e.g., red for a concentrated jet, white for a wider fan spray).
 - Push the nozzle firmly onto the end of the spray lance until it locks.
 - If using the detergent foam bottle, fill it with appropriate cleaning solution and attach it in place of a standard nozzle.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled and connected to a water source, your pressure washer is ready for operation.

1. **Prime the Pump:**
 - Before turning on, hold the trigger down for a few seconds to allow water to flow through the system and expel any air. This helps prevent damage to the pump.
2. **Start the Unit:**
 - Press the power button or pull the trigger to start the motor. The unit will begin to spray water.
3. **Adjust Spray Pattern:**
 - Different nozzles provide different spray patterns and pressures. Select the appropriate nozzle for your cleaning task.
 - The red nozzle typically provides a concentrated, high-pressure stream for tough dirt.

- The white nozzle typically provides a wider, fan-shaped spray for general cleaning or rinsing.

4. Using Detergent:

- Attach the detergent foam bottle filled with a suitable pressure washer detergent.
- The unit will mix the detergent with water and apply it as foam.
- After applying detergent, remove the foam bottle and rinse the surface with clean water using a standard nozzle.

5. Stopping Operation:

- Release the trigger to stop the water flow.
- For extended breaks or when finished, remove the battery pack to prevent accidental startup.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your pressure washer.

- **Cleaning the Unit:** After each use, wipe down the exterior of the pressure washer with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals.
- **Flush the System:** After using detergent, or before storing, run clean water through the unit for a few minutes to flush out any remaining soap or debris.
- **Clean Water Filter:** Regularly inspect and clean the water inlet filter to prevent blockages and ensure proper water flow.
- **Nozzle Care:** Clean any clogged nozzles using a small pin or the provided nozzle cleaning tool (if included).
- **Battery Care:**
 - Store batteries in a cool, dry place.
 - Do not store fully discharged batteries for long periods. Charge them periodically.
 - Avoid exposing batteries to extreme heat or cold.
- **Storage:**
 - Drain all water from the unit and hose before storing to prevent freezing damage.
 - Store the pressure washer and accessories in the provided carrying case in a dry, frost-free environment.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|-----------------------------------|--|--|
| Unit does not start | Battery not charged or not properly inserted. | Ensure battery is fully charged and securely clicked into place. |
| No water pressure or low pressure | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Water source empty or hose kinked. ◦ Water inlet filter clogged. ◦ Nozzle clogged. ◦ Air in the pump. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Check water source and hose. ◦ Clean the water inlet filter. ◦ Clean the nozzle. ◦ Prime the pump by holding the trigger until a steady stream emerges. |

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|------------------------------|------------------------------------|--|
| Water leaks from connections | Loose connections or worn O-rings. | Tighten all connections. Inspect and replace O-rings if damaged. |
| Detergent not dispensing | Detergent bottle empty or clogged. | Refill detergent bottle. Clean the detergent nozzle/attachment. |
