SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Scheppach Excavator Thumb Attachment is designed for straightforward installation on your Scheppach Mini-Excavator EXC815. Ensure the excavator is turned off and secured before beginning installation.

1. **Preparation:** Position the mini-excavator on a flat, stable surface. Ensure the bucket is empty and in a safe position.
2. **Attachment Alignment:** Align the mounting points of the excavator thumb with the corresponding attachment points on the excavator arm, near the bucket.
3. **Secure Fasteners:** Insert the provided pins or bolts through the aligned holes. Secure them with the appropriate clips or nuts. Ensure all fasteners are tightened securely to prevent movement during operation.
4. **Functionality Check:** Once installed, slowly articulate the excavator arm and bucket to ensure the thumb attachment moves freely and does not interfere with the excavator's normal operation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The excavator thumb works in conjunction with the excavator's bucket to create a clamping mechanism. This allows for secure handling of various materials.

1. **Positioning:** Maneuver the excavator so that the material to be gripped is between the bucket and the thumb attachment.
2. **Gripping:** Slowly close the bucket and the thumb around the material. Apply sufficient pressure to secure the material without damaging it or overloading the excavator.
3. **Lifting and Transporting:** Once the material is securely gripped, carefully lift and transport it to the desired location. Maintain a stable and balanced position during transport.
4. **Releasing:** At the destination, open the bucket and thumb to release the material.

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

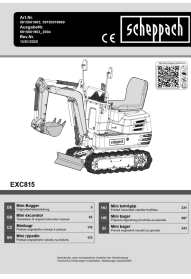
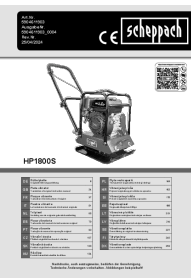
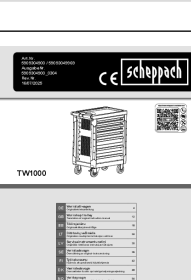
