SETUP

- 1. Unboxing:** Carefully remove the air purifier and all accessories from the packaging. Ensure all components are present: air purifier unit, power adapter, and filter.
- 2. Filter Installation:**
 - Locate the filter compartment, typically at the back or bottom of the unit.
 - Open the cover and remove any protective plastic packaging from the HEPA filter.
 - Insert the filter into the compartment, ensuring it is seated correctly.
 - Close the filter compartment cover securely.
- 3. Power Connection:** Place the air purifier on a flat, stable surface. Connect the power adapter to the unit and then plug it into a standard electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Control Panel

The air purifier features a touch panel for intuitive control. The digital display shows current settings and air quality information.

- **Power Button:** Press to turn the unit On or Off.
- **Fan Speed Button:** Adjusts fan speed (low, medium, high).
- **Mode Button:** Cycles through different operating modes (e.g., Auto, Sleep).
- **Timer Button:** Sets operation duration (e.g., 2, 5, 8 hours).
- **Child Lock Button:** Activates/deactivates child lock to prevent accidental changes.

App Control (Eco-Butler App)

For enhanced control and monitoring, download the Eco-Butler App on your smartphone or tablet.

1. **Download App:** Search for "Eco-Butler" in your device's app store and install it.
2. **Account Registration:** Open the app and follow the prompts to create an account or log in.
3. **Device Pairing:**
 - Ensure your air purifier is powered on and your smartphone is connected to a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network.
 - In the Eco-Butler App, select "Add Device" and choose the SereneLife Air Purifier from the list.
 - Follow the in-app instructions to connect the air purifier to your Wi-Fi network. This may involve pressing a specific button on the unit to enter pairing mode.
4. **Remote Control:** Once paired, you can control fan speed, modes, set schedules, and monitor real-time air quality from anywhere.

Operating Modes

- **Auto Mode:** The purifier automatically adjusts fan speed based on the detected air quality (PM2.5 sensor).
- **Sleep Mode:** Operates at the lowest fan speed with minimal noise (approx. 20dB) and dims the display lights for undisturbed rest.

Air Quality Indicator

The unit's display and the Eco-Butler App use color codes to indicate current air quality:

- **Green:** Very Good Air Quality
- **Orange:** Moderate Air Quality
- **Red:** Bad Air Quality

MAINTENANCE

Filter Replacement

The air purifier is equipped with a filter replacement reminder. When the filter needs to be replaced, an indicator light will illuminate on the control panel or a notification will appear in the app. It is recommended to replace the filter approximately every 3 months, depending on usage and air quality.

1. Turn off and unplug the air purifier.

2. Open the filter compartment cover.
3. Remove the old filter and dispose of it properly.
4. Insert a new SereneLife HEPA filter, ensuring it is correctly oriented.
5. Close the filter compartment cover.
6. Plug in and power on the unit. Reset the filter life indicator if necessary (refer to app or manual for specific reset instructions).

Note: Only use genuine SereneLife replacement filters to ensure optimal performance and maintain warranty.

Cleaning the Unit

- Always unplug the unit before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior of the air purifier with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents.
- Periodically vacuum the air intake vents to remove accumulated dust.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on.	No power supply; power adapter not connected; power outlet faulty.	Ensure power adapter is securely plugged in. Check if the power outlet is working.
Airflow is weak or no air comes out.	Filter is clogged; filter not installed correctly; air intake/outlet blocked.	Check and replace the filter if necessary. Ensure filter is properly seated. Clear any obstructions from vents.
Unusual noise.	Filter not installed correctly; foreign object inside unit; unit on uneven surface.	Reinstall filter. Check for foreign objects (unplug first). Place unit on a stable, flat surface.
App cannot connect to the purifier.	Incorrect Wi-Fi password; purifier out of Wi-Fi range; Wi-Fi network is 5GHz.	Verify Wi-Fi password. Move purifier closer to router. Ensure your Wi-Fi network is 2.4GHz. Re-pair the device if needed.
Air quality reading seems inaccurate.	Sensor is dirty; unit placed near strong odor sources.	Clean the PM2.5 sensor (refer to specific instructions in the full manual if available). Relocate the unit away from direct sources of pollutants.
