# **Instruction Manual**

ANGROX VOICE REMOTE CONTROL FOR PHILIPS GOOGLE SMART TVS

Model: URMT26CND002

#### 1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Angrox Voice Remote Control. This remote is specifically designed as a replacement for Philips Google Smart TVs, offering enhanced functionality including voice control and dedicated shortcut buttons for popular streaming services. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper setup and operation.

# 2. Setup

# 2.1 Battery Installation

The remote requires two (2) AAA batteries (not included). Ensure correct polarity when inserting the batteries.

- 1. Remove the battery cover on the back of the remote by sliding it downwards.
- 2. Insert two AAA batteries, matching the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals as indicated inside the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace the battery cover by sliding it back into place until it clicks securely.

### 2.2 Pairing with Your TV

Before using the remote, it must be paired with your Philips Google Smart TV. This remote supports both infrared and Bluetooth technology for optimal performance.

- 1. Ensure your Philips Google Smart TV is powered on.
- 2. Hold down the "VOL-" button and the "Mic" (Google Assistant) button simultaneously for 5 seconds.
- 3. The remote will initiate the pairing process. All pairing transactions occur in the background, and no further setup is typically required once the pairing is successful.

### 2.3 Compatible TV Models

# 3. Operating Instructions

#### 3.1 Button Functions Overview

Familiarize yourself with the various buttons and their functions on your Angrox remote control:

- Power: Press to turn TV on or off. Hold for 1 second for Quick Start Standby, or longer for Low Power Standby.
- Guide: Access live TV service providers (availability may vary by region).
- Home: Access apps, Live TV, input devices, settings, and the Google Play Store.
- Options: Quick access to settings (settings vary based on active screen).
- Cursor (Up/Down/Left/Right) & OK: Navigate menus and confirm selections.
- Back: Return to the previous screen.
- Google Assistant Button: Press and hold to activate the remote's microphone for voice search.
- Dashboard: Access the Google TV dashboard for settings, notifications, and kids mode.
- Input: Select input source for connected devices.
- Mute: Mute or unmute the TV audio.
- VOL +/-: Adjust the volume level.
- **CH** +/-: Select the next or previous channel.
- Color Buttons: Provide direct access to user-specified net apps.

#### 3.2 Voice Search Function

The integrated voice function allows for easier and more intuitive interaction with your smart TV. Simply press and hold the Google Assistant button and speak your command or query.

- Press and hold the Google Assistant button (microphone icon).
- Speak clearly into the remote's microphone.
- · Release the button when finished speaking.

Examples of voice commands include: "What's the weather today?", "Turn down the volume", "Open YouTube", or searching for specific content.

### 3.3 Shortcut Buttons

The remote features four dedicated shortcut buttons for quick access to popular streaming channels:

- Netflix
- YouTube
- Google Play
- Tubi

Pressing these buttons will directly launch the respective application on your TV, provided they are installed and configured.

#### 4. Maintenance

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your remote control, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Wipe the remote with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- Battery Replacement: Replace batteries when the remote's response becomes sluggish or it stops functioning. Always replace both batteries at the same time with new ones.
- Storage: Store the remote in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Avoid Drops: Protect the remote from physical impact, as drops can damage internal components.

### 5. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your remote control, please refer to the following common solutions:

#### · Remote Not Responding:

- Check if the batteries are inserted correctly with the right polarity.
- Replace old batteries with new AAA batteries.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR receiver.

#### Voice Function Not Working:

- Ensure the remote is properly paired with your TV via Bluetooth. Refer to Section 2.2.
- Make sure you are pressing and holding the Google Assistant button while speaking.
- Check your TV's settings to ensure voice control is enabled.

#### • Buttons Unresponsive or Sticky:

- Clean the remote surface, especially around the buttons, to remove any dirt or debris.
- If buttons remain unresponsive after cleaning and battery replacement, the remote may require replacement.

#### · Short Remote Distance:

- The remote supports infrared and Bluetooth. Ensure no physical obstructions are blocking the signal.
- The remote is designed for optimal performance within 10 meters (approximately 33 feet) and is available up to 12 meters (approximately 39 feet).
