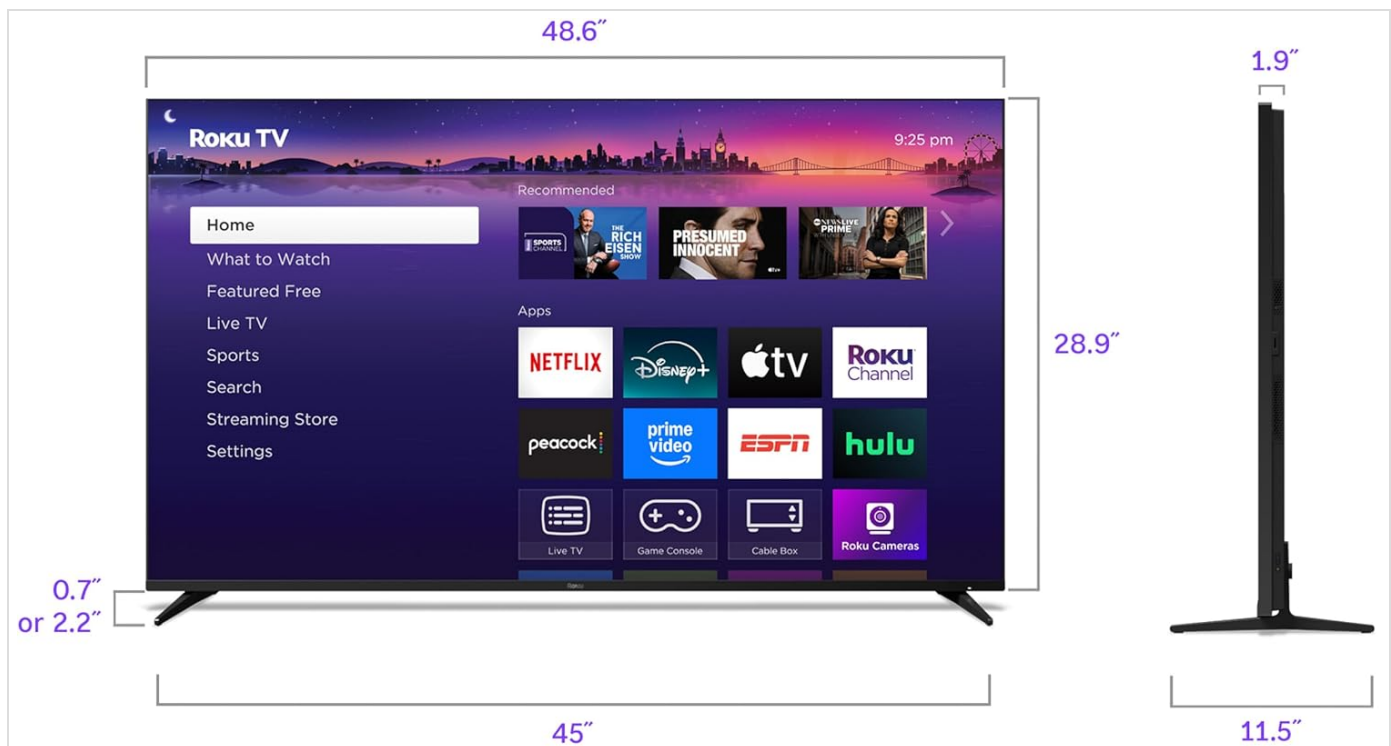

SETUP

Attaching the TV Stands

1. Carefully place the TV face down on a soft, clean surface to prevent screen damage.
2. Align each stand with the corresponding screw holes on the bottom of the TV.
3. Secure the stands using the provided screws. Ensure they are tightened firmly but do not overtighten.
4. The tool-less stands offer two height options for flexible placement on an entertainment center.

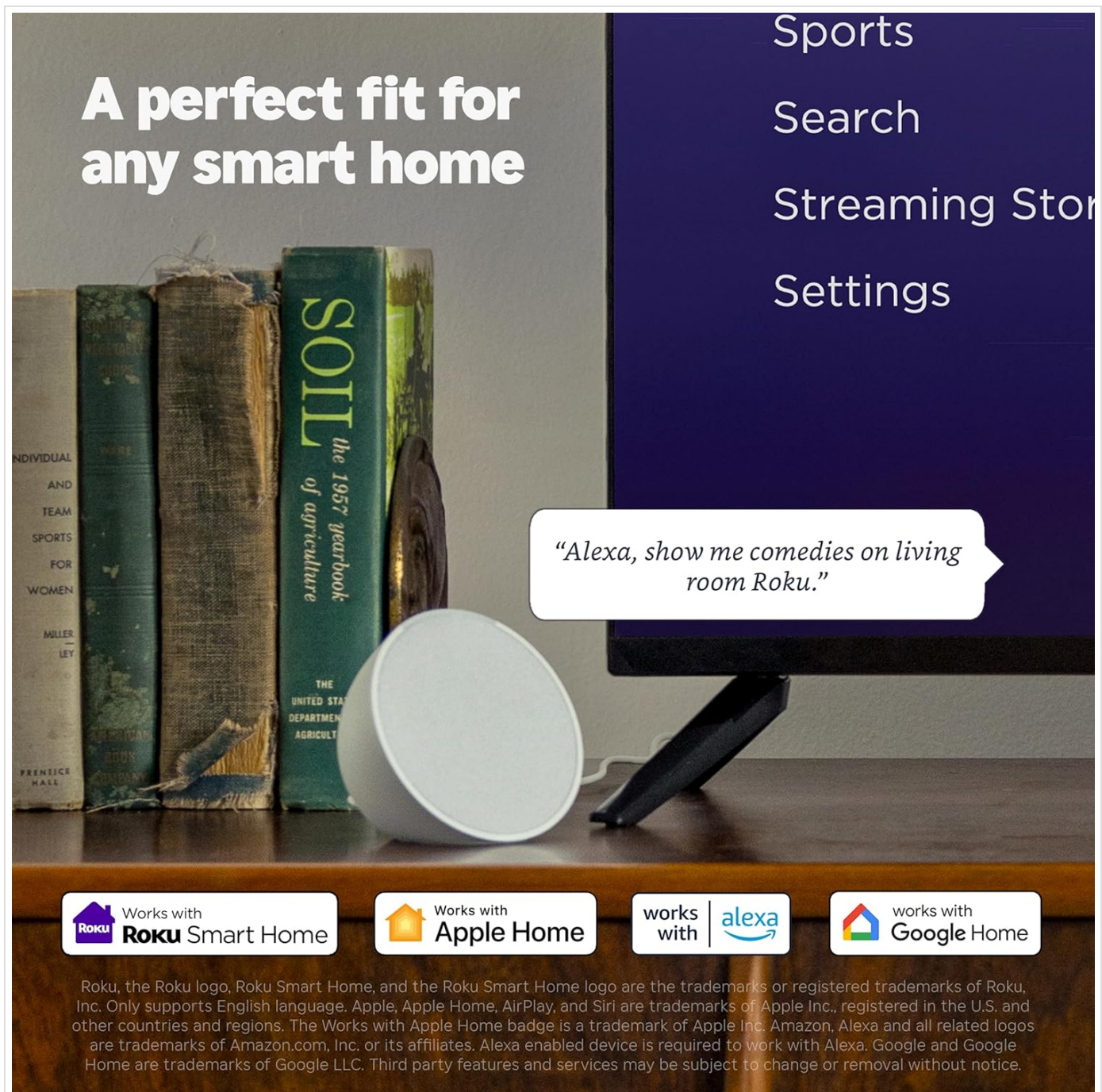

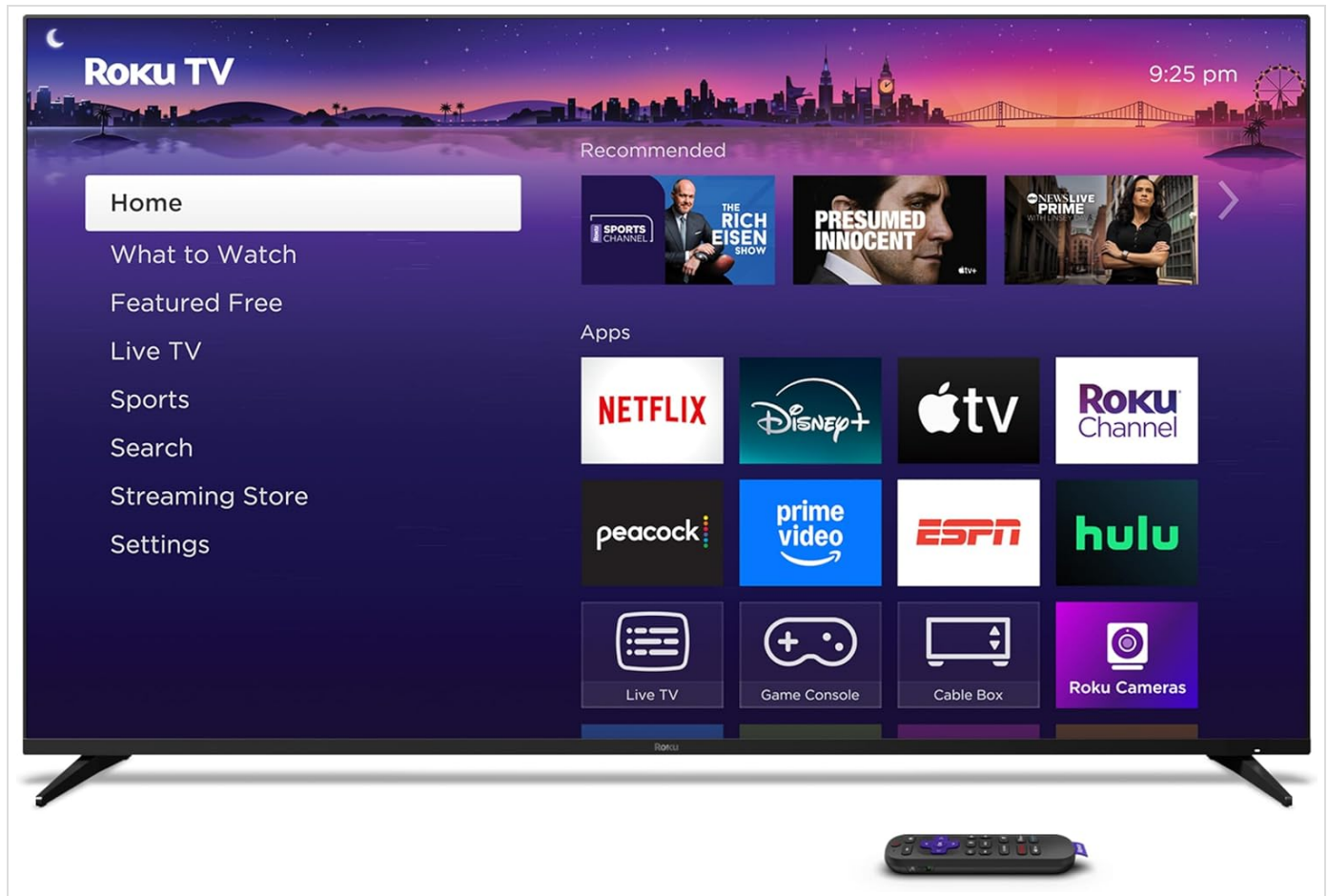

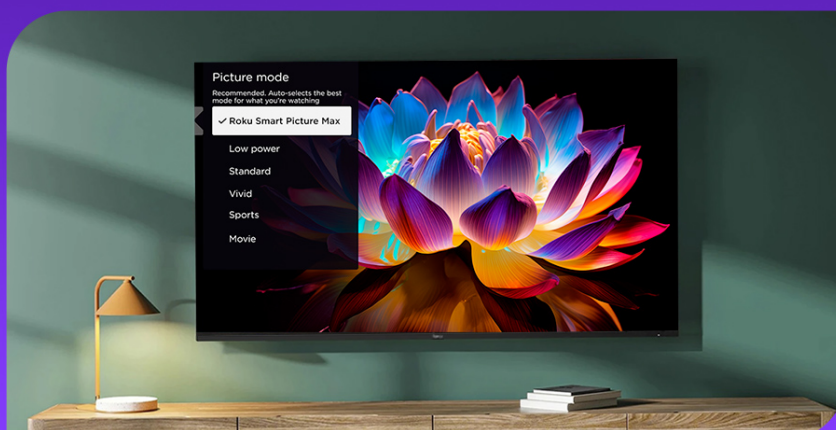

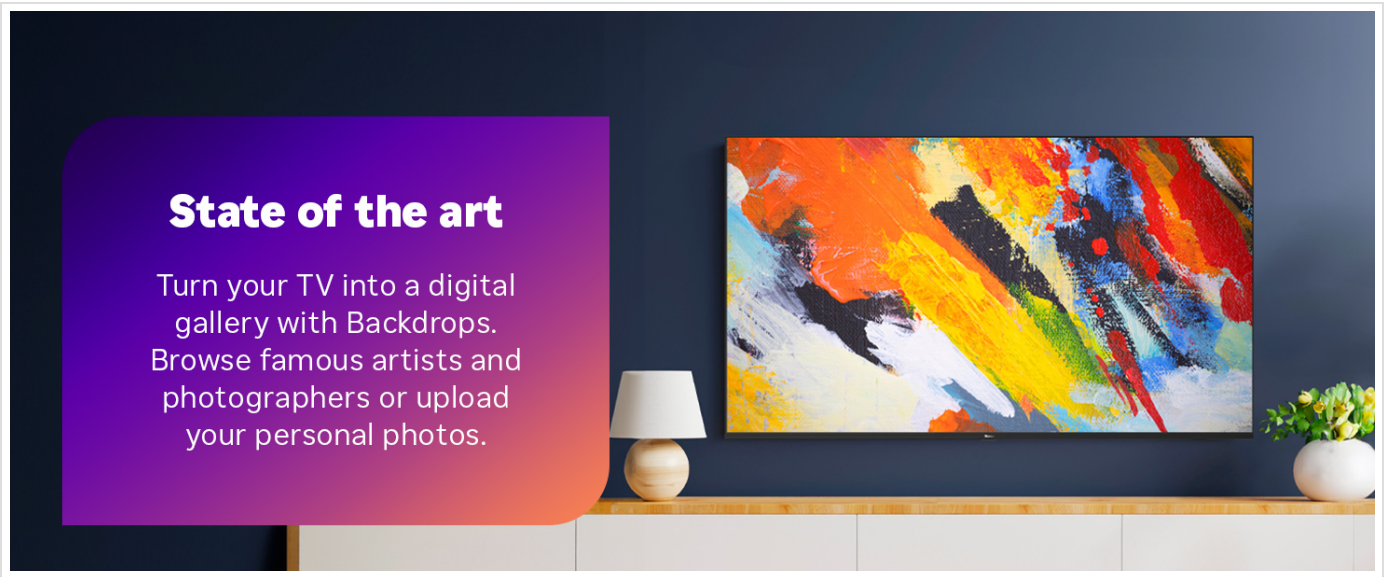
MAINTENANCE

- Wipe the TV frame and stand with a soft, dry cloth.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents as they can damage the finish.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord disconnected; Power outlet issue	Ensure power cord is securely plugged into TV and outlet. Test outlet with another device.
No picture/sound from connected device	Incorrect input selected; Loose HDMI cable; Device not powered on	Verify correct HDMI input is selected. Re-seat HDMI cable. Power on the connected device.
Remote not responding	Low battery; Obstruction; Remote out of range	Recharge the remote. Remove any obstructions between remote and TV. Ensure you are within operating range. Use the remote finder feature.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Incorrect password; Router issue; Signal interference	Double-check Wi-Fi password. Restart your router. Move TV closer to router or reduce interference.

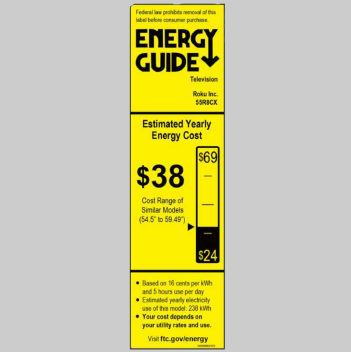
