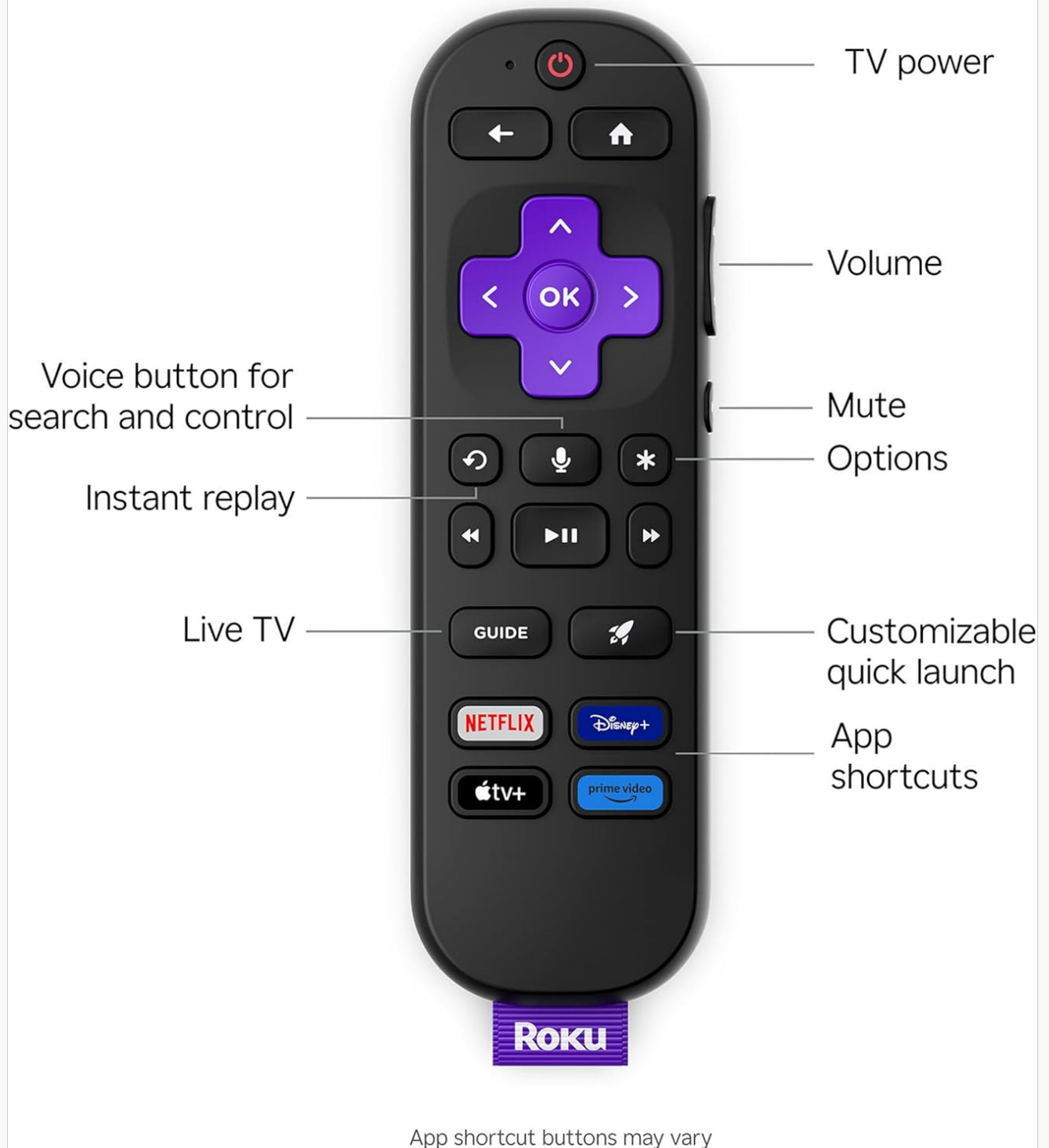

SETUP

1. Physical Setup

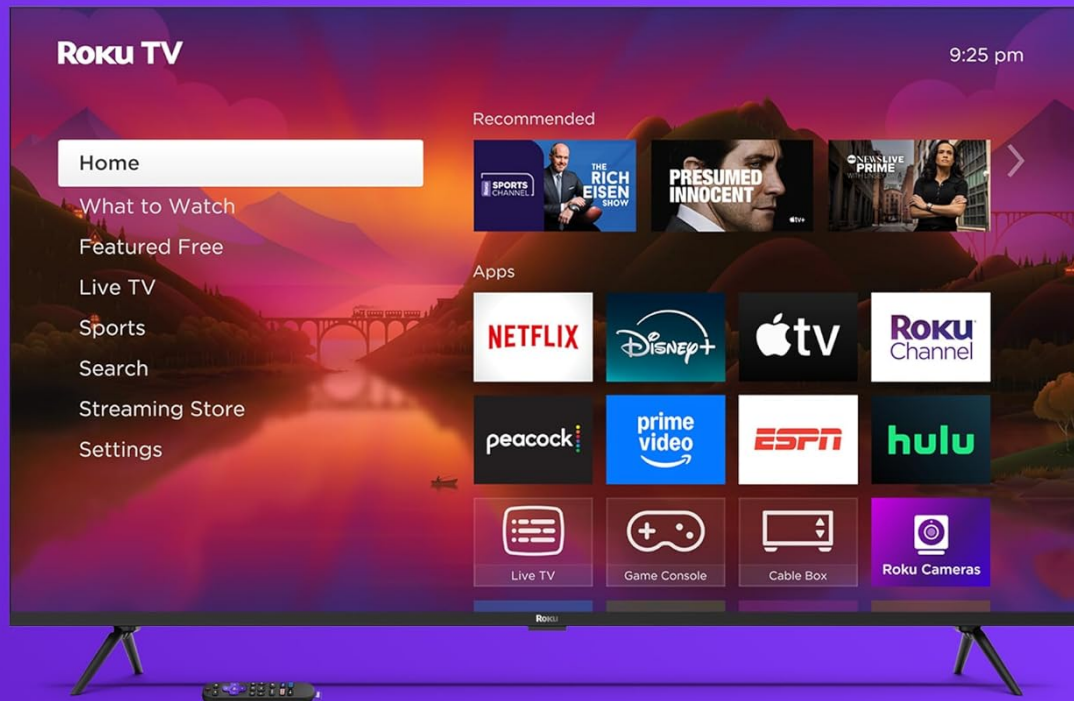

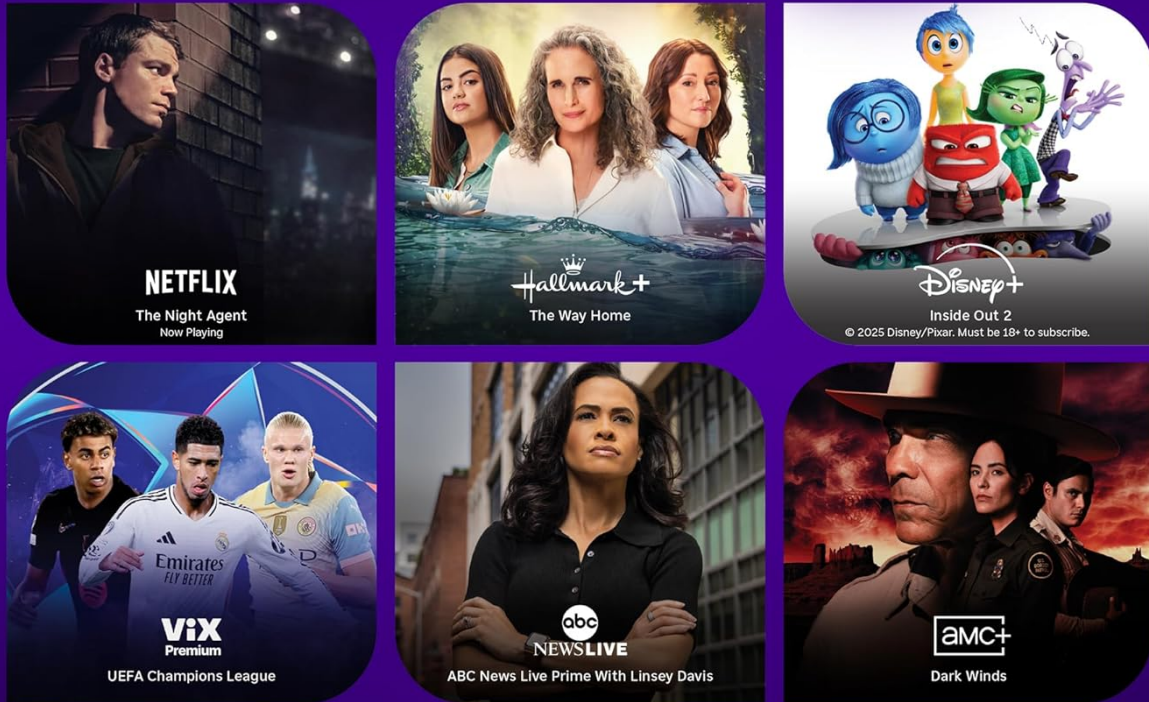

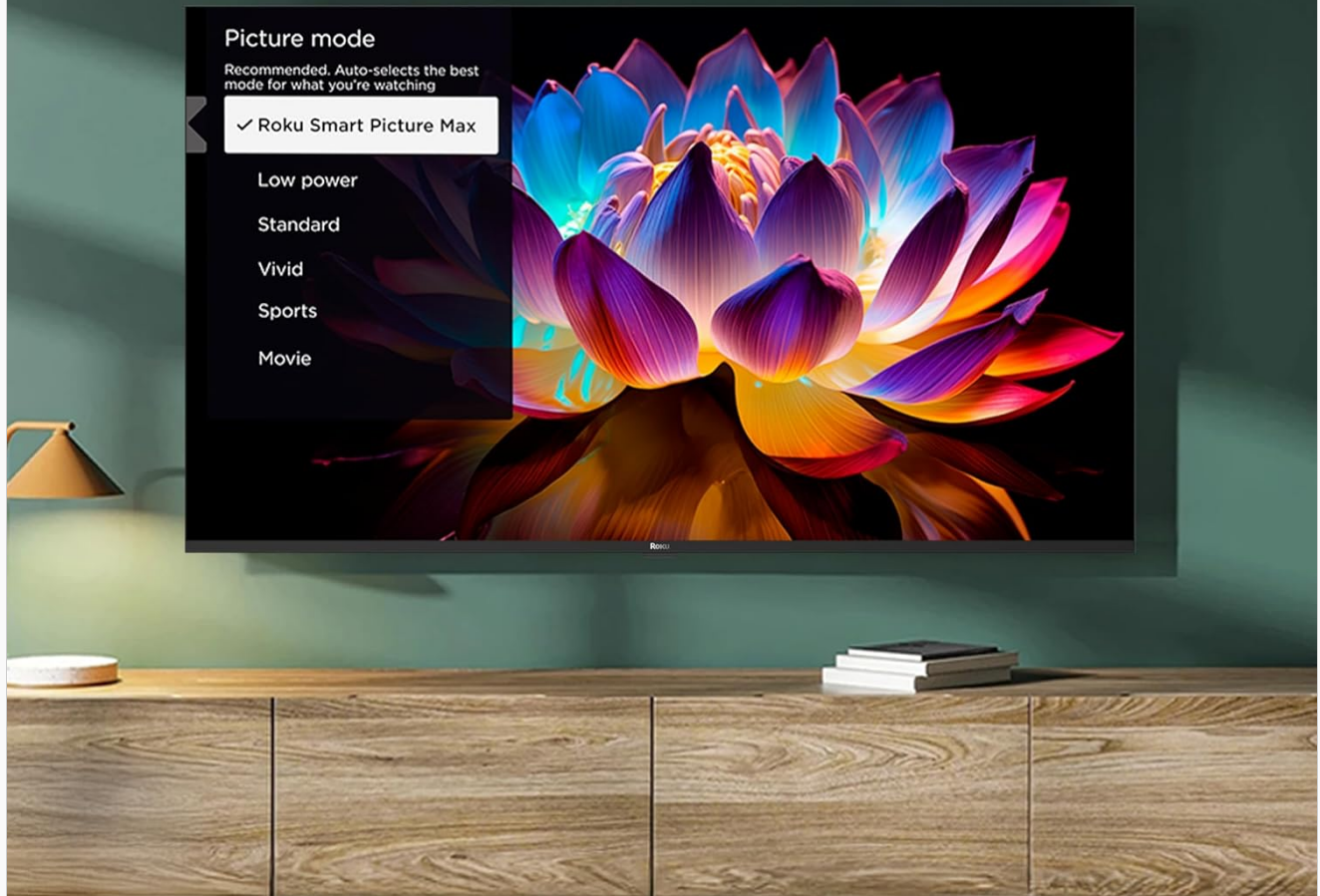

MAINTENANCE

2. Software Updates

Your Roku TV receives automatic software updates to ensure optimal performance and access to the latest features. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet for these updates to occur.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the TV and a working electrical outlet. Try a different outlet.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Check all cable connections (HDMI, audio). Ensure the correct input source is selected on the TV.
- **Remote Not Responding:** Replace the batteries in the remote. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV.
- **Lost Remote:** The Enhanced Voice Remote features a lost remote finder. Press the remote finder button on the side of the TV, or use the Roku Mobile app to locate it.
- **Network Connection Issues:** Restart your router and modem. Re-check your Wi-Fi password. If using Ethernet, ensure the cable is properly connected.
