### INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your RCA SRG32HQ1C 32-inch Google TV. Please read it thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and safety.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using this television to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury.

- Do not expose the TV to rain or moisture.
- Do not block ventilation openings.
- Ensure proper grounding for the power cord.
- Unplug the TV during lightning storms or when unused for long periods.
- · Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

- 1 x TV Table Stand (Middle Foot)

# **SETUP**

# 1. Attaching the Stand

- 1. Carefully place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- 2. Align the TV table stand (middle foot) with the mounting holes on the bottom of the TV.
- 3. Secure the stand using the provided screws. Do not overtighten.

# 2. Wall Mounting (Optional)

This TV supports VESA 100 x 100 mm wall mounts. Refer to your wall mount's instructions for installation. Ensure the wall mount can support the TV's weight (approximately 5.25 kg).

# 3. Connecting Devices

The TV offers various connectivity options:

- **HDMI:** Connect up to three HDMI devices (e.g., Blu-ray player, game console). Use HDMI-ARC for simplified audio connection to a soundbar.
- USB: Two USB ports for media playback or connecting USB devices.
- CI/CI+: One slot for a CI+ module with an HD+ card for pay-TV services.

- RF: Two RF inputs for antenna (DVB-T/T2) or cable (DVB-C) connections.
- LNB IN: One input for satellite (DVB-S/S2) connection.
- RJ45 (Ethernet): For a wired internet connection.
- AV: One AV input for older devices.
- Headphone Jack: One 3.5mm headphone output.

#### 4. Power Connection

Connect the power cord to the TV and then to a suitable power outlet (220 Volt). The TV will enter standby mode.

#### 5. Initial Setup

- 1. Press the power button on the remote control to turn on the TV.
- 2. Follow the on-screen instructions to select your language, country, and connect to a Wi-Fi network or use the Ethernet connection.
- Sign in with your Google account to access Google TV features, including the Google Play Store and Google
   Assistant
- 4. Perform a channel scan for DVB-T/T2, DVB-C, or DVB-S/S2 signals as prompted.

## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **Remote Control Functions**

The included remote control uses infrared technology. Ensure a clear line of sight to the TV's IR receiver.

- Power: Turns the TV on/off or to standby.
- Google Assistant: Activates voice control for searching content, controlling smart home devices, and more.
- Navigation Pad: Up, Down, Left, Right to navigate menus.
- OK/Enter: Confirms selections.
- Back: Returns to the previous screen.
- Home: Accesses the Google TV home screen.
- Volume +/-: Adjusts volume.
- Channel +/-: Changes channels.
- App Buttons: Dedicated buttons for popular streaming services (e.g., Netflix, Prime Video, Disney+).

# **Google TV Interface**

The Google TV interface organizes content from your apps and subscriptions. It features personalized recommendations and easy access to streaming services.

- For You: Personalized content recommendations.
- Live: Access to live TV channels (if configured).
- Apps: Access to all installed applications from the Google Play Store.
- Library: Your purchased or rented movies and shows.

### **Using Google Assistant**

Press the Google Assistant button on your remote and speak into the microphone to issue commands or ask questions. Examples:

• "Open Netflix"

- · "Find action movies"
- "What's the weather like?"
- "Turn off the lights" (if smart home devices are linked)

# **Casting Content (Chromecast Built-in)**

The TV has Chromecast built-in, allowing you to cast content from compatible apps on your smartphone, tablet, or computer directly to the TV screen.

- 1. Ensure your mobile device and TV are on the same Wi-Fi network.
- 2. Open a compatible app (e.g., YouTube, Netflix) on your device.
- 3. Tap the Cast icon ▶ (a rectangle with a Wi-Fi symbol in the corner) and select your RCA TV.

# **MAINTENANCE**

# Cleaning the TV

- · Always unplug the TV before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the screen and cabinet.
- For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive screen cleaner. Do not spray liquid directly onto the screen.
- · Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

## **Software Updates**

The TV may receive automatic software updates to improve performance and add new features. Ensure your TV is connected to the internet for these updates.

You can manually check for updates in the TV's settings menu:Settings > System > About > System update

### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

#### **Common Issues and Solutions**

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No power / TV won't turn on	<ul> <li>Check if the power cord is securely plugged into the TV and the wall outlet.</li> <li>Ensure the wall outlet is functioning (test with another device).</li> <li>Try pressing the power button on the TV itself, not just the remote.</li> </ul>
No picture, but sound is present	<ul> <li>Check the input source. Press the "Input" button on the remote to cycle through sources.</li> <li>Ensure external devices (e.g., cable box) are powered on and connected correctly.</li> <li>Adjust brightness/contrast settings.</li> </ul>

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No sound, but picture is present	<ul> <li>Increase the volume.</li> <li>Check if the TV is muted.</li> <li>Verify audio cables for external devices are connected properly.</li> <li>Check audio output settings in the TV menu.</li> </ul>
Remote control not working	<ul> <li>Replace the batteries.</li> <li>Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.</li> <li>Point the remote directly at the TV.</li> </ul>
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	<ul> <li>Ensure your Wi-Fi router is on and working.</li> <li>Check the Wi-Fi password.</li> <li>Move the TV closer to the router or use a wired Ethernet connection.</li> <li>Restart the TV and the router.</li> </ul>


