AromaRoom AP102-A Air Purifier User Manual

Model: AP102-A

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read and save these instructions before operating your air purifier. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious injury.

- Always unplug the air purifier before moving it, opening the grille, changing filters, or performing any cleaning.
- Keep the power cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not operate the air purifier if the plug or cord is damaged, or if the connection to the wall outlet is loose.
- Do not use the air purifier in wet environments or near water.
- Do not insert fingers or foreign objects into the air inlets or outlets.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Use only genuine AromaRoom replacement filters.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The AromaRoom AP102-A Air Purifier is designed to improve indoor air quality through a multi-stage filtration system and offers an aromatherapy feature for enhanced comfort.

Product Components

- Main Unit (with control panel and air outlet)
- 3-in-1 HEPA Filter (Pre-installed, but sealed)
- Power Adapter (often stored inside the unit)
- Aromatherapy Pad (inside the aromatherapy slot)

- **Power Button:** Turns the unit on or off.
- **Mode Button:** Cycles through fan speeds (Low, Medium, High) and Sleep Mode.
- **Timer Button:** Sets the operating timer for 2, 4, or 8 hours.
- **Light/Reset Button:** Toggles the night light on/off. Press and hold for 3 seconds to reset the filter replacement indicator.

SETUP AND INITIAL USE

1. **Unpack the Unit:** Carefully remove the air purifier from its packaging.
2. **Remove Filter Packaging:** The 3-in-1 HEPA filter comes pre-installed but sealed in plastic. The AC power adapter is also stored inside the air purifier.
 - Rotate the bottom cover counter-clockwise to unlock and remove it.

- Take out the filter and remove all plastic packaging. Retrieve the power adapter.
- Place the unwrapped filter back into the unit.
- Secure the bottom cover by rotating it clockwise until it locks.

3. **Place the Air Purifier:** Position the unit on a flat, stable surface, ensuring at least 15 inches (38 cm) of clearance from walls or furniture for optimal airflow.
4. **Connect Power:** Plug the power adapter into the DC 12V port on the back of the unit, then plug the adapter into a standard electrical outlet.

OPERATION

- **Power On/Off:** Press the **Power** button to turn the unit on or off. The blue indicator light will illuminate when on.
- **Adjust Fan Speed/Mode:** Press the **Mode** button to cycle through fan speeds: Low (one wave icon), Medium (two wave icons), High (three wave icons), and Sleep Mode (moon icon).
 - In Sleep Mode, the fan operates at its lowest speed (22dB) and the display lights dim for minimal disturbance.
- **Set Timer:** Press the **Timer** button to set the operating time for 2, 4, or 8 hours. The unit will automatically turn off after the selected time.
- **Night Light & Filter Reset:** Press the **Light/Reset** button to turn the night light on or off.
 - When the filter replacement indicator (usually a red light) illuminates, it's time to replace the filter. After replacing the filter, press and hold the **Light/Reset** button for 3 seconds to reset the filter lifetime counter.
- **Aromatherapy Function:**
 - Locate the aromatherapy slot on the side of the unit.
 - Pull out the small tray containing the aroma pad.
 - Add a few drops of your preferred essential oil (not included) onto the aroma pad.
 - Slide the tray back into the slot. The air purifier will then diffuse the scent into the room.
 - *Note: Do not add essential oils directly into the air outlet or filter. Only use the designated aromatherapy pad. Avoid essential oils containing acetone or ether, as they may corrode plastic parts.*

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your AromaRoom AP102-A Air Purifier.

Filter Replacement

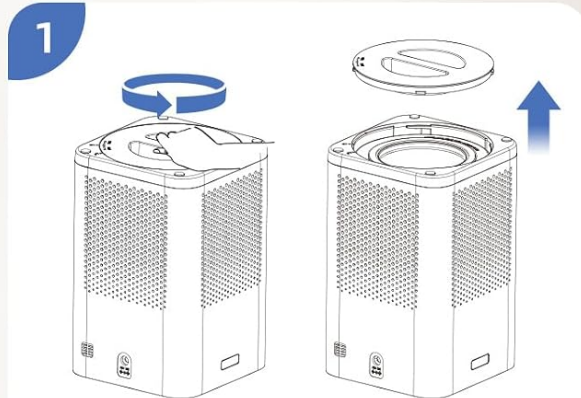
The 3-in-1 HEPA filter should be replaced every 3-6 months, depending on usage and air quality. The filter replacement indicator light will remind you when it's time.

1. **Power Off and Unplug:** Always turn off and unplug the air purifier before replacing the filter.
2. **Remove Bottom Cover:** Rotate the bottom cover counter-clockwise to unlock and remove it.
3. **Remove Old Filter:** Carefully pull out the used filter. Dispose of it properly.
4. **Install New Filter:** Remove all packaging from the new AromaRoom genuine filter. Insert the new filter into the unit.
5. **Replace Bottom Cover:** Place the bottom cover back onto the unit and rotate it clockwise until it locks securely.
6. **Reset Filter Indicator:** Plug in and power on the unit. Press and hold the **Light/Reset** button for 3 seconds until the

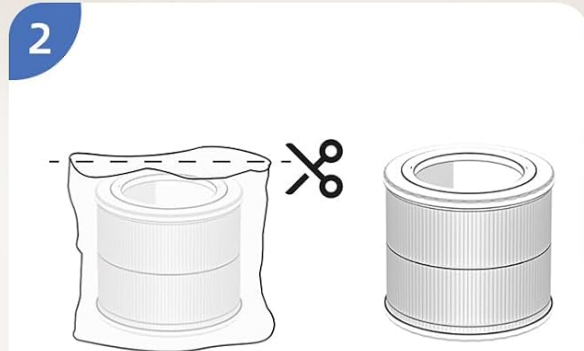
indicator light turns off.

Filter Replacement

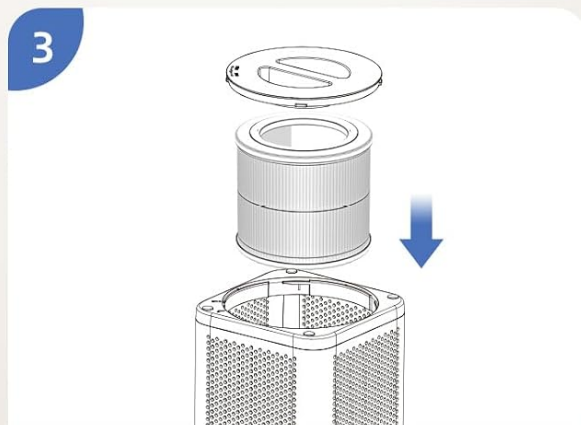
We recommend cleaning the pre-filter every 2-4 weeks and replacing the filter every 4-6 months. (The AC power adapter comes stored inside the air purifier)



Rotate the cover counterclockwise to unscrew it



Take off the plastic bag and install the new filter



Attach the filter back and secure the cover by turning it clockwise



Press and hold the "Reset" button for 3 seconds until the red light disappears

Compatible Replacement Filters:

- **AP100-RF:** Basic air purifying filter. (Search B0D9Q11D89)
- **AP100-RF-PA:** Pet-specific filter, designed to absorb odors and pet dander. (Search B0D72V2QG3)
- **AP100-RF-SR:** Multi-functional filter, captures hair/pollen, eliminates odors, and decomposes harmful gases. (Search B0DP2BYRFP)

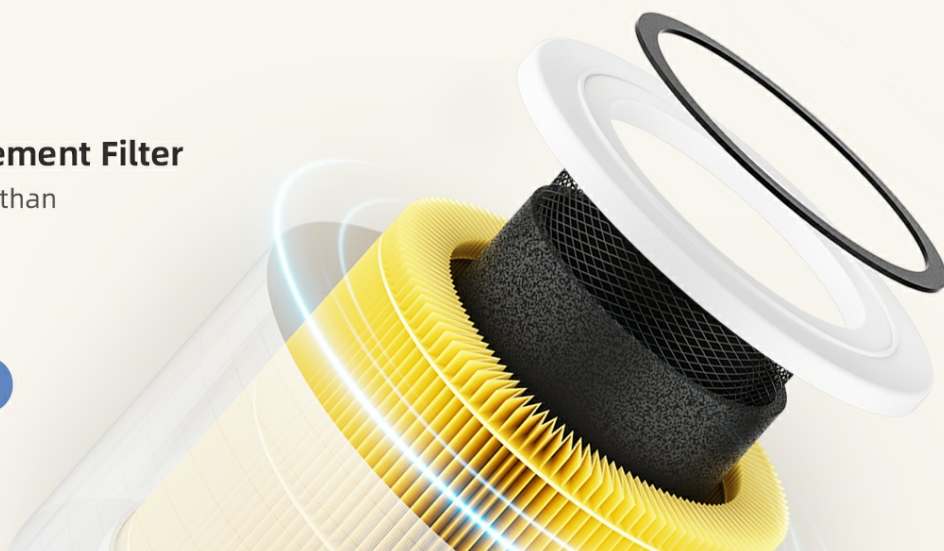

Cleaning the Unit

- Wipe the exterior of the air purifier with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- The pre-filter layer of the 3-in-1 filter can be gently cleaned with a soft brush or vacuum cleaner every 2-4 weeks to remove large particles. Do not wash the HEPA or activated carbon layers.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on.	Not plugged in. Power outlet malfunction. Filter not installed correctly or plastic packaging not removed.	Ensure the power adapter is securely plugged into the unit and a working outlet. Check the filter installation and remove all plastic packaging.
Airflow is weak or air quality not improving.	Filter is dirty or clogged. Air inlets/outlets are blocked. Unit is too close to walls/furniture.	Clean or replace the filter. Ensure nothing is blocking the air inlets or outlets. Relocate the unit to an area with adequate clearance.
Unusual noise.	Foreign object inside. Unit not on a stable surface.	Unplug and check for any obstructions. Place the unit on a flat, stable surface.
Filter replacement indicator remains on after filter change.	Filter reset not performed.	Press and hold the Light/Reset button for 3 seconds to reset the indicator.
