1. INTRODUCTION

Featuring two 15.6-inch Full HD 1080P displays, it offers an expanded workspace with vibrant colors and clear visuals. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal use of your device.






Image: Illustration of the rotatable support stand's flexibility.




Image: The extender being used while charging, ensuring continuous operation.

4. SETUP AND CONNECTION

4.1 Port & Button Overview

Familiarize yourself with the ports and buttons on your Maxfree S6 extender:

- **USB-C with DP:** For video and power input.
- **USB-C (Type-C1, Type-C2):** For video and power input.
- **Multi-function Button:** For menu navigation and settings.
- **Power Port:** For external power input.
- **Speaker:** Integrated audio output.

Option 1 Connect the laptop to two screens using two full-function USB-C cables.

4.2 Connection Options

The Maxfree S6 offers multiple ways to connect to your laptop:

1. Option 1: Two Full-Function USB-C Cables

Connect your laptop to both screens using two full-function USB-C cables. This option provides both video and power through a single cable per screen.

2. Option 2: One Full-Function USB-C and One HDMI + USB-A

Connect one screen using a full-function USB-C cable. For the second screen, use an HDMI cable for video and a USB-A to USB-C cable for power.

3. Option 3: H5-T Cable (for specific Mac models)

If your laptop is a Mac with M1/M2/M3 chips, you will need to connect the H5-T cable to the "DP" port of the second screen, and then connect a USB cable to the "Type C" port of this screen for power. Please contact Maxfree support to obtain an H5-T cable if needed.

Note: When using an HDMI cable, an additional USB-A to USB-C cable is required for power.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Display Modes and Flexibility

The Maxfree S6 offers 11 customizable display modes. The screens are detachable and can be rotated 90° vertically and 235° horizontally, allowing for various viewing angles and configurations to suit your workflow.

5.2 Adjusting Screen Position

The extender is compatible with 13"-17.3" laptops and features an adjustable length of up to 15.75 inches to fit various laptop sizes securely. The magnetic structure ensures a stable attachment.

- **Business Meetings:** Enhance collaboration and efficiency by sharing content on multiple screens.
- **Gaming:** Immerse yourself in games with an expanded field of view.

- **Professional Work:** Ideal for programming, financial analysis, and other tasks requiring multiple open applications.




Image: Examples of the extender's use in different environments.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Maxfree S6 Laptop Screen Extender, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Display / Black Screen:**

- Ensure all cables are securely connected to both the extender and your laptop.
- Verify that your laptop's display settings are configured to extend or duplicate the display.
- If using HDMI, confirm that the additional USB-A to USB-C power cable is connected.
- For Mac M1/M2/M3 chips, ensure you are using the correct H5-T cable and connection method as described in Section 4.2.

- **Flickering Screen:**

- Check cable connections for looseness.
- Ensure your laptop's graphics drivers are up to date.
- Try reducing the display resolution on the extended screens.

• Incorrect Color/Brightness:

- Use the multi-function button on the extender to access the OSD (On-Screen Display) menu and adjust color, brightness, and contrast settings.
- Ensure your laptop's display settings are not overriding the extender's settings.

• Audio Issues:

- Check your laptop's audio output settings to ensure the Maxfree S6 is selected as the playback device.
- Adjust the volume using the extender's controls or your laptop's system volume.
