1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Sikaic Shoe Cabinet, Model XG, is a versatile and stylish storage solution designed for entryways, hallways, and other living spaces. This cabinet features four doors and three adjustable internal shelves, providing ample and customizable storage for various types of footwear, including boots. An open bottom shelf offers convenient access for frequently worn items like slippers. Constructed from high-quality particleboard with a waterproof coating, it ensures durability and ease of maintenance. Its sleek, minimalist design with metal handles integrates seamlessly into modern home decor.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all safety instructions before assembly and use. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- Always follow assembly instructions carefully.
- Use appropriate safety gear when handling tools.
- Be aware of potential tipping hazards. This cabinet must be secured to a wall using the provided anti-tip devices to prevent accidental tipping, especially in households with children or pets.
- Do not overload shelves. Distribute weight evenly.
- Keep small parts and hardware away from children.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, ensure all parts are present and undamaged. Refer to the detailed parts list included in your product packaging. Typically, your package should contain:

- Cabinet panels (top, bottom, side, back)
- 4 Doors
- 3 Adjustable shelves
- Metal legs (4)
- Hardware pack (screws, dowels, hinges, handles, shelf clips, anti-tip devices)
- Assembly instructions manual

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the Sikaic Shoe Cabinet is designed to be straightforward with clear instructions and pre-numbered panels. Please follow the steps below carefully to ensure correct and stable installation.

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Lay out all components on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Match each part to the corresponding number in the assembly manual.
2. **Assemble the Main Frame:** Connect the side panels to the bottom and top panels using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are secure.
3. **Install Back Panel:** Secure the reinforced back panel to the frame. This enhances stability and keeps dust away from your shoes.
4. **Attach Metal Legs:** Screw the sturdy metal legs to the base of the cabinet. The legs are adjustable, allowing you to level the cabinet on uneven floors and protect your floors from scratches.
5. **Install Hinges and Doors:** Attach the hinges to the doors and then to the cabinet frame. Note that two hinges per door may be different; refer to the specific instructions for correct placement. Adjust the hinges as needed to ensure the doors align properly and close smoothly.
6. **Insert Adjustable Shelves:** Place the shelf clips into the desired holes inside the cabinet. The middle shelves are adjustable to 5 levels and can also be removed entirely to accommodate taller items like boots. Secure the shelves with the clips for added stability.
7. **Attach Handles:** Fasten the metal handles to the doors.

8. **Secure Anti-Tip Devices:** For safety, attach the anti-tip devices to the top rear of the cabinet and then to a wall stud using appropriate wall anchors (not always included, use suitable ones for your wall type).

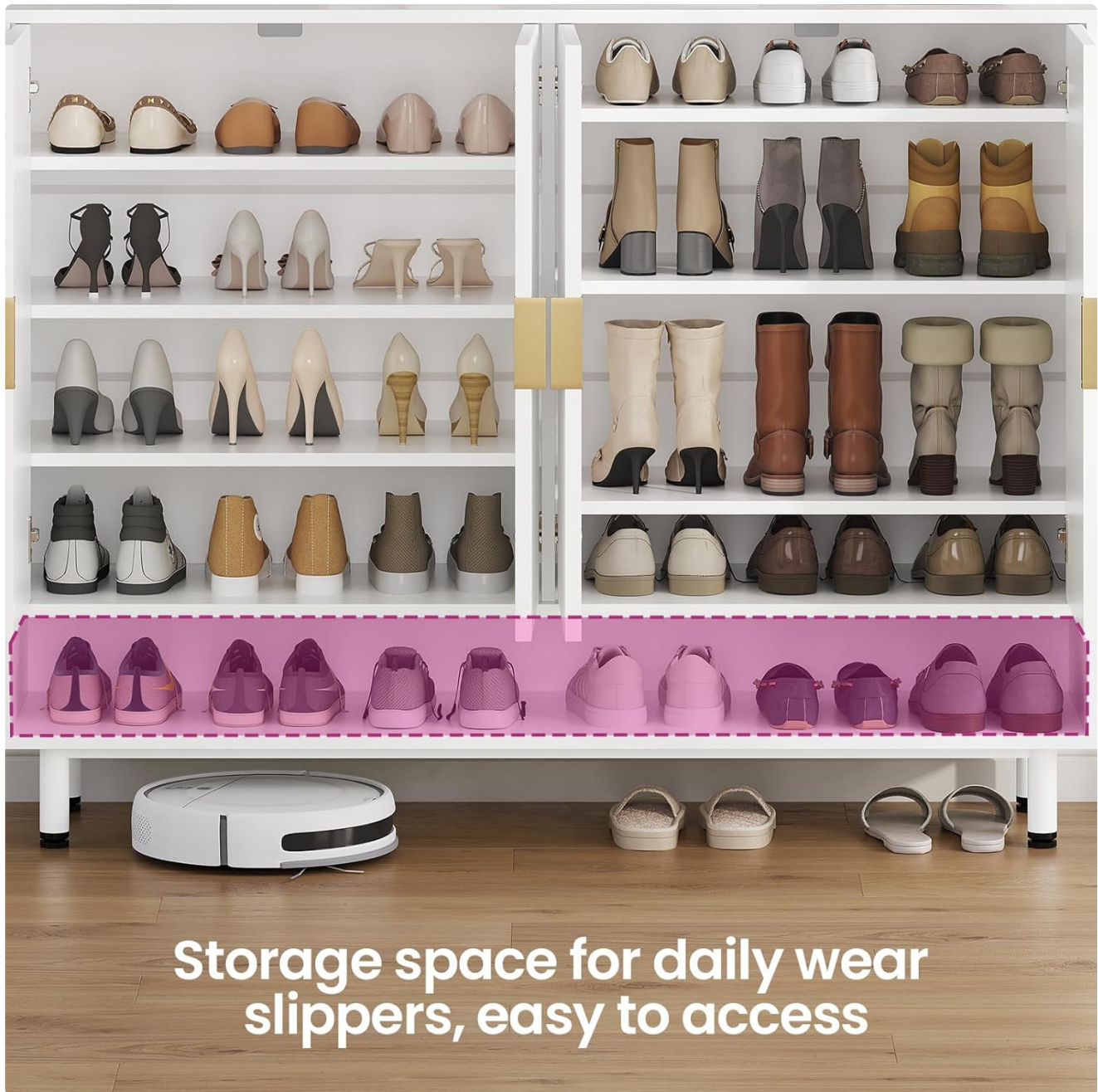


Image: Illustration demonstrating how the internal shelves can be adjusted to different heights or removed to accommodate various shoe sizes, including boots.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your Sikaic Shoe Cabinet is simple and intuitive:

- **Storing Shoes:** Open the cabinet doors using the metal handles. Arrange your shoes on the adjustable shelves. Utilize the open bottom shelf for frequently worn slippers or other quick-access items.
- **Adjusting Shelves:** To adjust a shelf, remove any items, then carefully lift the shelf to disengage it from the clips. Reposition the clips into the desired holes and place the shelf back onto them, ensuring it is level and secure.
- **Removing Shelves:** For storing taller boots or larger items, simply remove the shelf clips and lift the shelf out of the cabinet.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your Sikaic Shoe Cabinet, follow these simple care guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** The cabinet's high-quality particleboard with a waterproof coating makes it easy to clean. Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- **Dusting:** Regularly dust the cabinet with a dry, soft cloth to prevent dust buildup. The closed-back design helps keep shoes clean and protected from dust.
- **Spills:** Immediately wipe up any spills to prevent moisture damage, despite the waterproof coating.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten if necessary.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight to prevent fading or discoloration of the finish.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues during assembly or use, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Doors do not align or close properly.	Hinges are not correctly installed or adjusted.	Ensure hinges are installed according to the manual (note that some hinges may be different). Adjust the screws on the hinges to fine-tune door alignment.
Screw holes do not line up.	Incorrect panel orientation or manufacturing variance.	Double-check that all panels are oriented correctly (e.g., top/bottom, front/back). If issues persist, contact customer support.
Cabinet feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose connections or uneven floor.	Ensure all screws are tightened. Adjust the leveling feet on the metal legs to stabilize the cabinet. Verify the anti-tip devices are securely installed.
Missing or damaged parts.	Shipping damage or packaging error.	Do not proceed with assembly. Contact Sikaic customer service immediately for replacement parts.

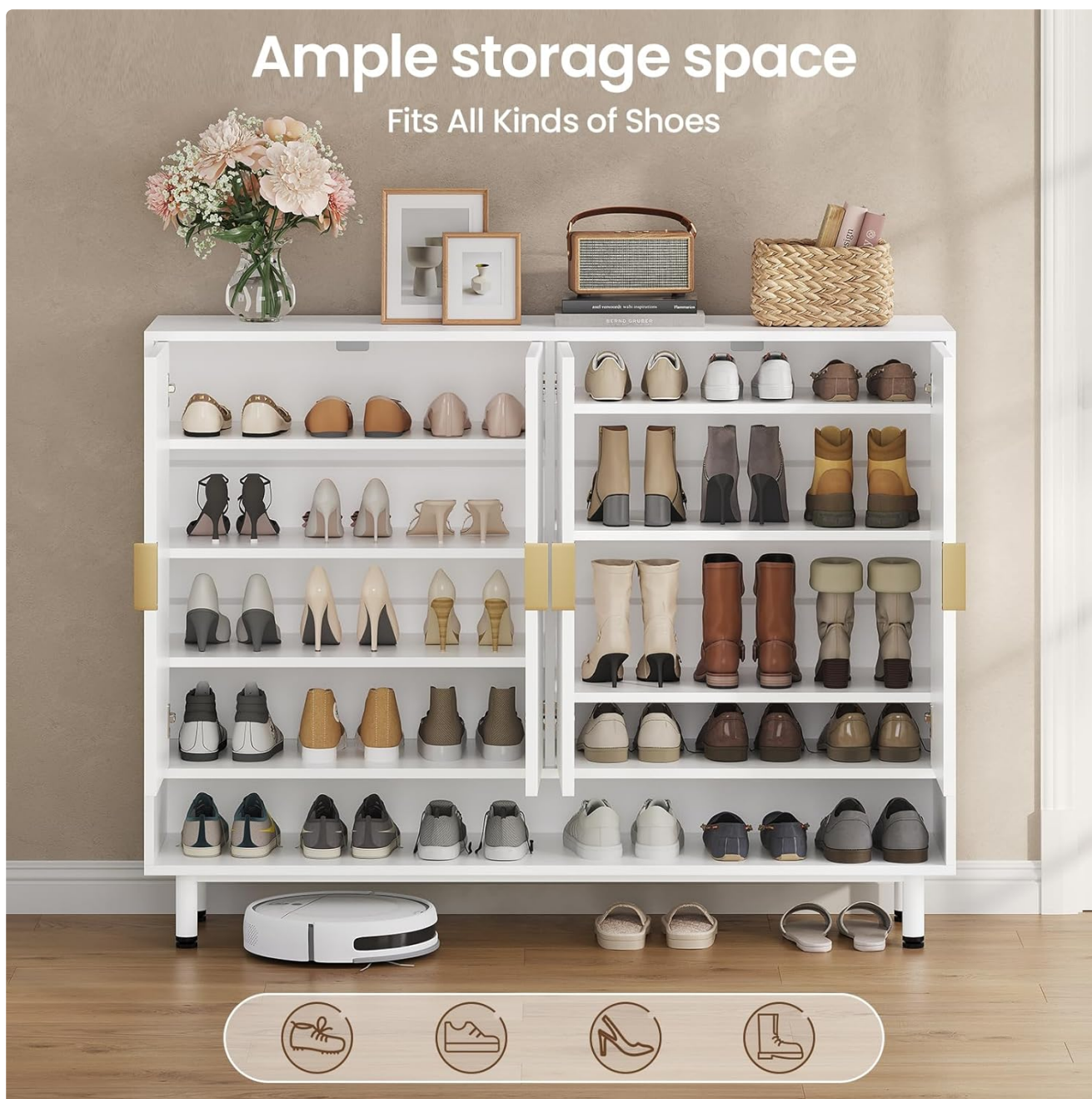


Image: Detailed diagram illustrating the overall dimensions of the shoe cabinet, including height, width, and depth, along with internal shelf spacing.

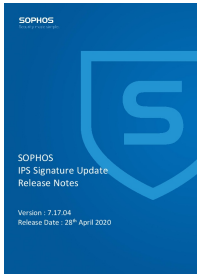
