To ensure safety, secure the cabinet to the wall using the provided anti-tipping hardware to prevent accidental falls. Do not exceed the weight capacity of 55 lbs on the countertop. Handle the shelves carefully to avoid damage. Always assemble the unit on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Keep small parts away from children during assembly.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is required for this product. It is recommended to have two people for assembly. Please ensure all parts are present before beginning. A detailed assembly manual with step-by-step instructions and diagrams is included in

the product packaging. Follow the numbered steps carefully.

Key Assembly Considerations:

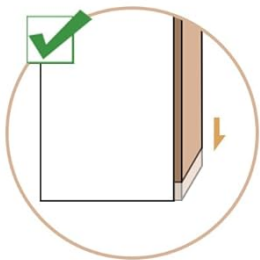
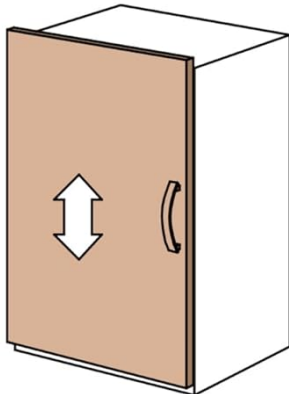
- **Unpacking:** Carefully unpack all components and hardware. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.
- **Hardware Identification:** Refer to the parts list in your assembly manual to identify all screws, dowels, and other hardware.
- **Panel Orientation:** Pay close attention to the orientation of panels as indicated in the diagrams.
- **Adjustable Shelves:** The shelves are designed to be adjustable. Insert the shelf pins into the desired holes before placing the shelves.
- **Door Hinge Adjustment:** After installing the doors, adjust the hinges to ensure proper alignment and flush closure.

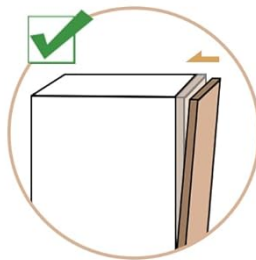
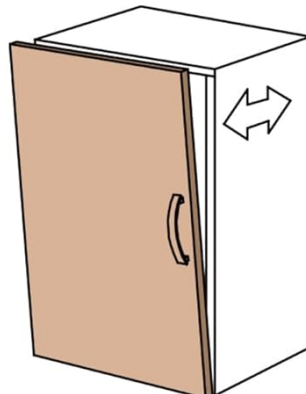

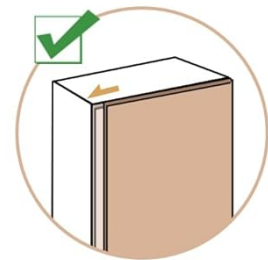
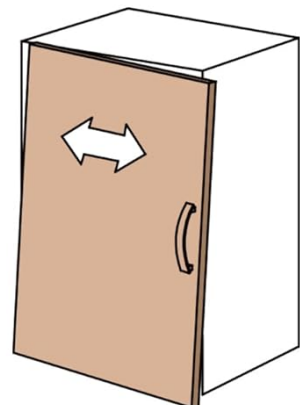
Up and Down Adjustment

OPERATING AND USAGE

Your HOMCOM pantry cabinet is designed for versatile use in various rooms, including the kitchen, living room, dining room, or entryway.

- **Storage:** Utilize the upper glass-fronted cabinets for display items or frequently accessed goods. The lower cabinets and drawers are suitable for larger items, cookware, or silverware.
- **Microwave Stand:** Place your microwave or other small kitchen appliances on the spacious countertop. Ensure the appliance's dimensions fit within the designated area (refer to Figure 4 for dimensions). Use the cable hole for neat wire management.
- **Weight Limits:** Adhere to the specified weight capacities for the countertop (55 lbs) and drawers (8.8 lbs) to prevent damage and ensure stability.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your pantry cabinet.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that can damage the finish. The melamine-coated shelves are particularly easy to clean.
- **Spills:** Clean up spills immediately to prevent staining or damage to the wood.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten if necessary to maintain structural integrity.
- **Sunlight Exposure:** Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight, which can cause fading or discoloration.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions:

Issue: Cabinet feels wobbly or unstable.

Solution: Ensure all assembly screws are fully tightened. Verify that the anti-tipping hardware is correctly installed and securely anchored to a wall stud or appropriate wall anchor. Ensure the cabinet is placed on a level surface.

Issue: Doors are not aligning or closing properly.

Solution: Adjust the door hinges using the adjustment screws (refer to Figure 5). There are typically screws for vertical, horizontal, and depth adjustments. Make small adjustments until the doors are flush and close smoothly.

Issue: Drawers are sticking or not sliding smoothly.

Solution: Check that the drawer slides are correctly installed and aligned. Ensure no debris is obstructing the slides. Lightly lubricate the slides with a silicone-based lubricant if needed.

Issue: Missing or damaged parts during assembly.

Solution: Do not proceed with assembly if parts are missing or damaged. Contact HOMCOM customer support immediately for replacement parts. Refer to the "Customer Support" section for contact information.
