INTRODUCTION

Featuring advanced active and passive noise cancellation technology, these headphones reduce ambient noise by up to 27dB, making them ideal for work, travel, or home use. With a durable, full-size over-ear design, long-lasting battery, and versatile connectivity options, the AudioShield headphones combine comfort with high performance.

- **Active Noise Cancellation (ANC):** Reduces ambient noise by up to 27dB for superior sound isolation.
- **Long Battery Life:** Up to 24 hours of playtime on a single charge.
- **Bluetooth Wireless Connectivity:** Enjoy a wireless range of up to 30 feet.
- **Wired Connectivity:** Includes an auxiliary cord for 3.5mm wired devices.
- **Comfort Design:** Full-size over-ear pads and a twist-able, durable headband for extended wear.
- **Built-in Microphone:** Clear voice microphone for hands-free calls.
- **Rotary Volume Control:** Smooth dial for easy volume adjustments.

SETUP GUIDE

1. Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge your SENTRY AudioShield headphones. Connect the provided charging cable to the charging port on the headphones and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). The charging indicator light will show the charging status and turn off or change color when fully charged.

2. Powering On/Off

- To power on: Press and hold the Power button until the indicator light illuminates.
- To power off: Press and hold the Power button until the indicator light turns off.

3. Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
2. Press and hold the Power button for approximately 5-7 seconds until the indicator light flashes rapidly (usually blue and red), indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, computer), enable Bluetooth and search for new devices.
4. Select "AudioShield" or "SENTRY AudioShield" from the list of available devices.
5. Once paired, the indicator light will stop flashing and remain solid blue.

Note: If prompted for a password, enter "0000".

4. Wired Connection (3.5mm Aux)

For devices without Bluetooth or when the battery is depleted, you can use the provided 3.5mm auxiliary cable. Simply plug one end into the headphone's aux port and the other end into your audio device's 3.5mm jack. The headphones will automatically switch to wired mode.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Volume Control

Adjust the listening volume using the smooth rotary volume control dial located on one of the earcups. Rotate clockwise to increase volume and counter-clockwise to decrease volume.

Active Noise Cancellation (ANC)

To activate or deactivate the Active Noise Cancellation feature, locate the ANC On/Off switch on the headphones. Flip the switch to the "On" position to engage noise cancellation and to the "Off" position to disengage it.

Making and Receiving Calls

When connected via Bluetooth, the built-in microphone allows for hands-free calling.

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Multi-function button for 2 seconds.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-press the Multi-function button.

Music Playback Controls

Control your music directly from the headphones when connected via Bluetooth.

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Next Track:** Press and hold the Volume Up button.
- **Previous Track:** Press and hold the Volume Down button.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** The headphones feature a wipe-clean surface. Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the earcups and headband. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the headphones in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Water Resistance:** The headphones are splash-resistant. Do not submerge them in water or expose them to heavy rain.
- **Durability:** While built with reinforced joints, avoid excessive twisting or bending of the headband to prevent damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones won't turn on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones fully.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	Headphones not in pairing mode; device Bluetooth off; too far from device.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing indicator). Turn on device Bluetooth. Move headphones closer to device (within 30 feet).
No sound from headphones.	Volume too low; incorrect audio source; headphones not connected.	Increase headphone and device volume. Ensure headphones are correctly paired/connected. Check if aux cable is fully inserted.
ANC not working effectively.	ANC switch off; very high-frequency noise.	Ensure ANC switch is in the "On" position. ANC is most effective on low-frequency ambient noise.
