INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Domi 12' x 20' Lean-to Gazebo. Designed to extend your outdoor living space, this gazebo features a durable aluminum frame, a galvanized steel sloping roof, and includes both mosquito netting and privacy curtains. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly or use.

Operating Your Gazebo

Curtains and Netting

The gazebo features a double-track design for both mosquito netting and privacy curtains. The netting can be used during warmer months to provide ventilation while protecting against insects. The privacy curtains offer shade and a secluded space, ideal for cooler weather or when privacy is desired. Both can be easily opened and secured when not in use.

Roof and Drainage System

The galvanized steel sloping roof is designed with slopes and flutes to facilitate rapid drainage of rainwater and snowmelt. Water flows along the integrated gutter system to the poles, ensuring that the area beneath the gazebo remains dry. The polycarbonate side panel offers partial sun blockage and protection from light rain while allowing natural light to filter through.

Maintenance

Regular maintenance will ensure the longevity and appearance of your gazebo.

Cleaning

- Clean the aluminum frame and steel roof with a mild soap and water solution. Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- For curtains and netting, follow care instructions on the fabric tags. Generally, spot clean with mild soap and water.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the materials.

Seasonal Care

The gazebo's aluminum frame and galvanized steel roof are designed for durability. For areas experiencing heavy snowfall, the two extra support poles can be installed to increase the weight-bearing capacity of the roof, providing additional stability during winter conditions. Ensure all connections remain tight and inspect for any signs of wear or damage periodically.

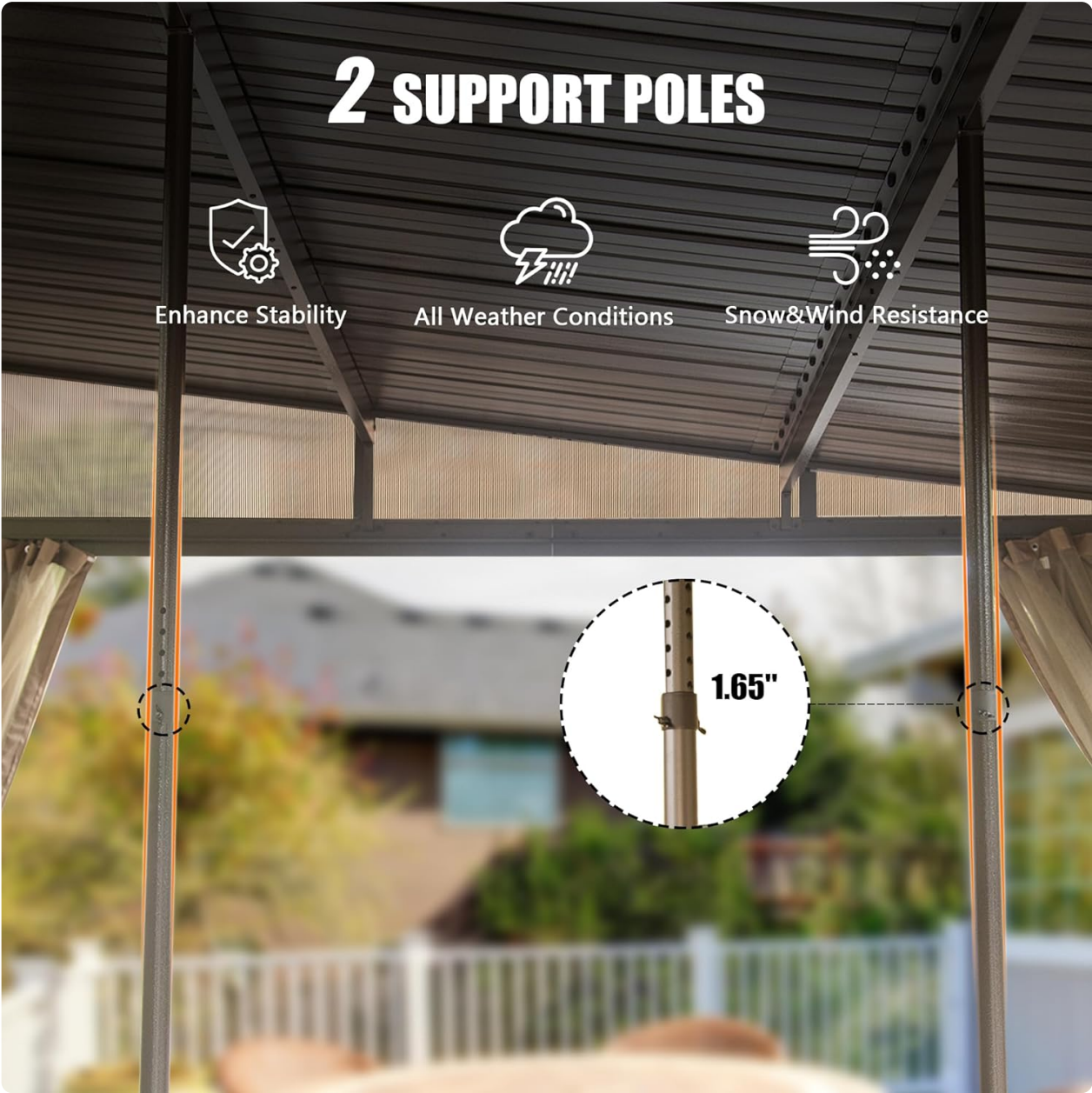


Image: A diagram illustrating the two adjustable support poles, emphasizing their role in enhancing stability and resistance to snow and wind.

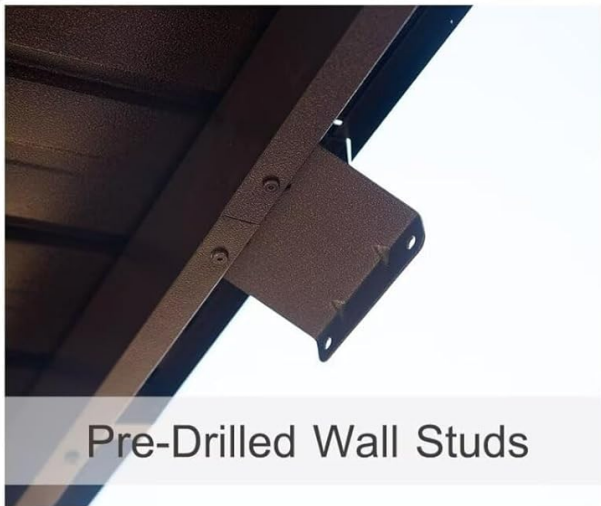

Troubleshooting

If you encounter any issues with your gazebo, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water Leakage	Improper sealing during assembly or damaged roof panels.	Inspect all roof panel seams and connections. Apply additional sealant if necessary. Ensure roof panels are correctly overlapped and secured.
Gazebo Instability	Loose fasteners or inadequate anchoring.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure the gazebo is properly anchored to the ground or wall as per assembly instructions. Verify the squareness of the four corner posts.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Curtains/Netting Not Moving Smoothly	Debris in tracks or damaged runners.	Clean tracks of any dirt or debris. Inspect runners for damage and replace if necessary.

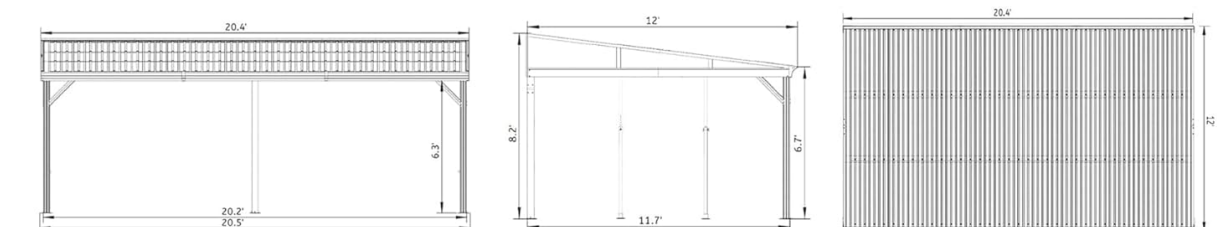
