1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the instruction manual for your Huffy Kids 12-inch Glimmer Bike. This bike is designed for first-time riders, typically aged 3 to 5 years old, with a rider height between 37 to 42 inches. It features a durable steel frame, a combination of rear coaster brake and front hand brake for developing control, and wide training wheels for stability. This manual will guide you through the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new bicycle, ensuring a safe and enjoyable experience.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always wear a properly fitted helmet that meets safety standards.
- Ensure all bolts, nuts, and quick-release levers are securely tightened before each ride.
- Check tire pressure regularly. Refer to the tire sidewall for recommended PSI.
- Inspect brakes for proper function before riding.
- Ride in well-lit areas and avoid riding at night.
- Supervise young riders at all times.
- Do not ride on public roads with heavy traffic.
- Keep fingers and clothing away from moving parts like the chain and wheels.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Huffy Kids 12-inch Glimmer Bike features EZ Build assembly for quick and easy setup. Follow the steps below to assemble your bicycle. For a visual guide, please refer to the official Huffy EZ Build Assembly Video provided below.

3.1 Unboxing and Part Identification

Carefully remove all components from the box and lay them out. Remove any protective packaging from the bike frame and

parts. Ensure all parts are present before beginning assembly.

3.2 Attach Training Wheels

Remove the plastic protective pieces from the rear wheel axle. Slide each training wheel onto the axle until it clicks securely into place. Ensure they are firmly attached and do not wobble.

3.3 Connect Fork and Handlebars

Remove any protective covers from the head tube of the bike frame. Insert the front wheel and fork assembly into the head tube. Ensure the handlebars are facing the correct direction (the sweep should go back towards the rider). Push down firmly until you hear a click, indicating it's fully engaged. Tighten the ring at the base of the handlebars by hand to secure them.

3.4 Extend Pedals

Locate the pedals. They may be folded for shipping. Simply rotate each pedal outward until it clicks into its extended position. Ensure both pedals are fully extended and secure.

3.5 Insert Seat Post

Insert the seat post into the seat tube on the bike frame. Use the quick-release lever to adjust the seat height. Ensure the seat post is inserted past the minimum insertion line marked on the post for safety and stability. Tighten the quick-release lever firmly.

3.6 Inflate Tires and Attach Streamers

Inflate both tires to the recommended PSI found on the tire sidewall. Finally, insert the decorative streamers into the ends of the handlebars, pushing them in firmly.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Riding Basics

For beginners, the training wheels provide stability. Encourage your child to pedal forward to gain momentum and steer by gently turning the handlebars. Practice in a safe, open area away from obstacles and traffic.

4.2 Braking System

This bike is equipped with a dual braking system:

- **Rear Coaster Brake:** To engage, pedal backward. This is an intuitive braking method for young riders.
- **Front Hand Brake:** Located on the handlebar, squeeze the lever to engage the front brake. Teach your child to apply this brake gently to avoid sudden stops.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safety of your Huffy bike.

- **Tire Pressure:** Check tires weekly and inflate to the recommended PSI (usually found on the tire sidewall).
- **Chain Lubrication:** Apply a light bicycle chain lubricant every few months, or more often if riding in wet or dusty conditions.
- **Brake Check:** Regularly inspect brake pads for wear and ensure brake levers are easy to squeeze and effectively stop the bike.
- **General Cleaning:** Wipe down the bike frame with a damp cloth after rides to remove dirt and debris. Avoid using harsh chemicals.
- **Bolt Tightness:** Periodically check all bolts and nuts, especially on the handlebars, seat post, and wheels, to ensure they remain tight.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wobbly Training Wheels	Not fully clicked into place or loose.	Ensure training wheels are pushed firmly onto the axle until they click. Check for any obstructions.
Loose Handlebars	Stem not fully inserted or ring not tightened.	Push handlebars down until they click. Hand-tighten the ring at the base of the handlebars.
Seat Slips Down	Quick-release lever not tight enough or seat post above minimum insertion line.	Tighten the quick-release lever. Ensure seat post is inserted past the minimum insertion line.
Brakes Not Effective	Brake pads worn or cable loose.	Inspect brake pads for wear and replace if necessary. Consult a bike mechanic if cable adjustment is needed.


