#### 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Beudsa ChargN AC Adapter. This power supply charger is designed to provide reliable and efficient power to your Motomaster Eliminator Powerbox 400, 600, or 800. Please read this manual carefully before use to ensure proper operation and longevity of the product.

#### 2. PRODUCT FEATURES

### 3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these simple steps to set up your AC adapter:

1. **Inspect the Adapter:** Before connecting, visually inspect the adapter and its cable for any signs of damage. Do not use if damaged.
2. **Connect to Device:** Insert the round plug connector of the AC adapter firmly into the power input port of your Motomaster Eliminator Powerbox (400, 600, or 800). Ensure a snug fit.
3. **Connect to Power Outlet:** Plug the 2-prong end of the AC adapter into a standard 100-240V AC wall outlet. Ensure the outlet is easily accessible.
4. **Verify Connection:** Once connected, the device should indicate that it is receiving power or charging, depending on its design.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Beudsa ChargN AC Adapter operates automatically once connected to a power source and your device. It is designed for continuous use within its specified voltage and current limits.

- **Powering Devices:** The adapter will supply power to your Motomaster Eliminator Powerbox as soon as it is plugged into a live electrical outlet and connected to the device.
- **Charging:** If your Powerbox has a charging function, the adapter will initiate charging when connected. Refer to your Powerbox's manual for specific charging indicators.
- **Safety Features:** The built-in protections will automatically activate in case of electrical anomalies (e.g., over-voltage, short-circuit) to prevent damage to the adapter and your connected device.

## 5. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your AC adapter, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Keep Dry:** Avoid exposing the adapter to water, moisture, or high humidity.
- **Clean Gently:** Disconnect the adapter from power before cleaning. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the surface. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosols.
- **Avoid Extreme Temperatures:** Do not operate or store the adapter in excessively hot or cold environments.
- **Handle Cables Carefully:** Do not bend, twist, or pull the cable excessively, especially near the connectors, to prevent internal wire damage.
- **Store Properly:** When not in use, store the adapter in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight. Avoid tightly coiling the cable.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your AC adapter, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Device not powering on/charging	No power from outlet; Loose connection; Damaged adapter/cable; Incompatible device.	Check if the outlet is live (test with another device). Ensure all connections are secure. Inspect adapter/cable for damage; replace if necessary. Verify compatibility with your device.
Adapter feels hot	Normal operation under load; Overload; Poor ventilation.	A slight warmth is normal. Ensure the adapter is not covered and has adequate ventilation. If excessively hot, disconnect immediately and check device power requirements.
Intermittent power	Loose connection; Damaged cable/connector.	Ensure connections are firm. Inspect cable and connector for fraying or bending. Replace if damaged.
