# Dytole DY106 Bluetooth 5.3 Wireless Headset User Manual

## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Dytole DY106 Bluetooth 5.3 Wireless Headset. Designed for clear communication and comfort, this headset features AI noise-cancelling technology, a mute function, and versatile connectivity options for various work environments.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The Dytole DY106 headset is designed for comfort and functionality. Familiarize yourself with its components:

- **Headband:** Adjustable for a comfortable fit.
- **Earmuffs:** Soft, breathable, and adjustable for comfort and easy storage.
- **Microphone Boom:** 135° adjustable for optimal voice pickup. Features AI noise-cancelling technology.
- **Control Buttons:** Located on the earcup for power, volume, mute, and call management.
- **USB Dongle:** For wireless connection to devices without built-in Bluetooth or for enhanced stability.
- **Type-C Charging Port:** For recharging the headset battery.

## SETUP

### 1. Charging the Headset

Before first use, fully charge the headset.

1. Connect the provided Type-C charging cable to the charging port on the headset.
2. Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter).
3. The indicator light will show charging status. A full charge takes approximately 2 hours.
4. Once fully charged, the headset provides up to 65 hours of use.

## 2. Powering On/Off

- **Power On:** Flip the power switch to the ON position. An audible prompt or indicator light will confirm power-on.
- **Power Off:** Flip the power switch to the OFF position.

## 3. Pairing with Devices

The Dytol DY106 headset offers two methods for wireless connection: Bluetooth and USB Dongle.

### a. Bluetooth Pairing (for smartphones, tablets, Bluetooth-enabled PCs)

1. Ensure the headset is powered off.
2. Press and hold the Multi-function button (usually the power button or a dedicated pairing button) until the indicator light flashes blue and red, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device, go to Bluetooth settings and enable Bluetooth.
4. Search for "Dytol DY106" (or similar name) in the list of available devices and select it.
5. Once connected, the indicator light will turn solid blue or flash blue slowly.

### b. USB Dongle Connection (for PCs, laptops)

1. Plug the USB dongle into an available USB port on your computer.
2. Power on the Dytol DY106 headset.
3. The headset and dongle should automatically pair. The indicator light on both the headset and dongle will turn solid blue once connected.
4. If connection is not automatic, ensure the headset is in pairing mode (refer to step 2 of Bluetooth pairing) and the dongle is properly inserted.
5. On your computer's sound settings, select "Dytol DY106" as the input and output device.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 1. Call Management

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Multi-function button for 2 seconds.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-press the Multi-function button.

### 2. Audio Control

- **Volume Up:** Press the Volume Up (+) button.
- **Volume Down:** Press the Volume Down (-) button.
- **Play/Pause Music:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Next Track:** Press and hold the Volume Up (+) button.
- **Previous Track:** Press and hold the Volume Down (-) button.

### 3. Microphone Mute Function

The headset features a dedicated mute button for privacy during calls.

- **Mute Microphone:** Press the Mute button once. An audible prompt or indicator light will confirm the microphone is muted.
- **Unmute Microphone:** Press the Mute button again.

### 4. AI Noise Cancelling

The AI noise-cancelling technology is automatically active when the microphone is in use, reducing background distractions for clearer communication.

## 5. Adjusting the Headset

- **Headband Adjustment:** Extend or retract the headband slides to achieve a comfortable and secure fit on your head.
- **Microphone Boom Adjustment:** Rotate the microphone boom up to 135° to position the microphone optimally near your mouth for best voice pickup.
- **Earmuff Adjustment:** The earmuffs can be rotated to lie flat for convenient storage or transport.

## 6. Activating Voice Assistant

Depending on your connected device, you can activate its voice assistant.

- **Activate Voice Assistant:** Triple-press the Multi-function button (or refer to your device's specific instructions for Bluetooth headset voice assistant activation).

## MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity of your Dytolo DY106 headset.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the headset. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the headset in water.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the headset in a cool, dry place. The earmuffs can be flattened for compact storage.
- **Battery Care:** Avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the headset regularly, even if not in constant use, to maintain battery health.
- **Avoid Extreme Temperatures:** Do not expose the headset to extreme heat or cold, as this can damage the battery and internal components.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your headset, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headset does not power on	Low battery	Charge the headset for at least 30 minutes.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth	Headset not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on device; too far from device	Ensure headset is in pairing mode (flashing blue/red). Turn on Bluetooth on your device. Move headset closer to device (within 10 meters).
No sound or poor sound quality	Volume too low; incorrect audio output selected; interference	Increase headset and device volume. Check device's audio settings to ensure "Dytolo DY106" is selected. Move away from other wireless devices.
Microphone not working	Microphone muted; incorrect audio input selected; microphone boom not positioned correctly	Unmute the microphone. Check device's audio settings to ensure "Dytolo DY106" is selected as input. Adjust microphone boom closer to your mouth.
USB dongle not connecting	Dongle not properly inserted; driver issue; headset not powered on	Ensure dongle is fully inserted. Try a different USB port. Restart your computer. Power on the headset.
