## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The Texciting Heated Blanket Electric Throw provides warmth and comfort with its ultra-soft material and integrated heating elements. Designed for versatility, it can be used on beds, couches, or in office settings. The blanket features multiple heat settings and an automatic shut-off timer for safe and convenient use.

## 2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

---

1. **Unpack the Blanket:** Carefully remove the heated blanket and its controller from the packaging.
2. **Connect the Controller:** Locate the connection port on the blanket. Firmly plug the controller cord into this port until it clicks into place. Ensure the connection is secure.
3. **Plug into Power:** Insert the power plug of the controller into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet.
4. **Position the Blanket:** Place the blanket on your bed, couch, or desired area. Ensure it is spread out evenly and not bunched or folded, which could lead to overheating.

### 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Power On/Off:** Press the power button on the controller to turn the blanket on or off.
- **Adjust Heat Settings:** The blanket offers 5 heat settings. Use the designated buttons on the controller to cycle through the heat levels (1 being the lowest, 5 being the highest). The maximum temperature can reach approximately 45°C.
- **Automatic Shut-Off:** For safety and energy conservation, the blanket is equipped with a 3-hour automatic shut-off timer. After 3 hours of continuous operation, the blanket will automatically turn off. This feature is ideal for falling asleep without worrying about leaving the blanket on.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

The Texciting Heated Blanket is designed for easy care and is machine washable.

1. **Disconnect Power:** Before cleaning, always ensure the blanket is unplugged from the wall outlet and the controller is disconnected from the blanket. Allow the controller to cool down completely.
2. **Machine Wash:** Machine wash the blanket in cold water on a gentle cycle.
3. **Tumble Dry:** Tumble dry on low heat.
4. **Do NOT:** Do not iron, bleach, or dry clean the blanket. These actions can damage the heating elements and fabric.

## 5. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **ETL Certified:** This heated blanket is ETL certified, ensuring it meets recognized safety standards.
- **Overheat Protection:** The blanket includes an intelligent safety system that constantly monitors its temperature. If the blanket reaches a potentially dangerous temperature, the system will automatically shut off the heating function.
- **Automatic Shut-Off:** The 3-hour auto-off timer prevents prolonged heating, reducing the risk of overheating and conserving energy.
- **Proper Use:** Do not use the blanket if it is wet or damaged. Avoid folding or bunching the blanket while in use, as this can concentrate heat and lead to overheating.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the blanket in a cool, dry place.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Blanket Not Heating:** Ensure the controller is securely plugged into the blanket and the power cord is firmly inserted into a working electrical outlet. Check if the outlet is receiving power.

- **Controller Display Not Working:** Verify all connections are secure and the blanket is plugged into a live power source. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
- **Uneven Heating:** Ensure the blanket is spread out flat and not folded or bunched. Uneven heating can occur if the heating wires are compressed.
