This manual provides detailed instructions on how to set up, operate, and maintain your camera to ensure optimal performance.

SETUP

1. Inserting the Battery

1. Open the battery compartment cover located at the bottom of the camera.
2. Insert the Lithium-polymer battery, ensuring the correct polarity as indicated inside the compartment.
3. Close the battery compartment cover securely until it clicks.

2. Inserting the Memory Card

1. Locate the memory card slot, usually next to the battery compartment or on the side.
2. Insert the 32GB SD card with the metal contacts facing down (or as indicated by the diagram near the slot) until it

clicks into place.

3. To remove the card, gently push it in until it clicks, then release, and it will spring out.

3. Charging the Battery

The camera comes with two batteries and a dedicated charger.

1. Insert a battery into the external battery charger.
2. Connect the charger to the power adapter using the USB cable.
3. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet. The indicator light on the charger will show the charging status (e.g., red for charging, green for fully charged).
4. Alternatively, you can charge the battery inside the camera by connecting the camera directly to a power source via the USB cable.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Controls

Familiarize yourself with the main buttons and screen functions.

- **Power Button:** Turns the camera on/off.

- **Shutter Button:** Press halfway to focus, fully to take a photo.
- **Mode Dial/Button:** Switches between photo, video, playback, and other modes.
- **Zoom Lever:** Controls the 16x optical zoom.
- **Navigation Buttons (Up/Down/Left/Right/OK):** Navigate menus and select options.
- **Display Screen:** The 3-inch foldable LCD screen for framing shots, reviewing media, and accessing menus.

2. Turning On/Off

Press and hold the Power button for a few seconds to turn the camera on or off.

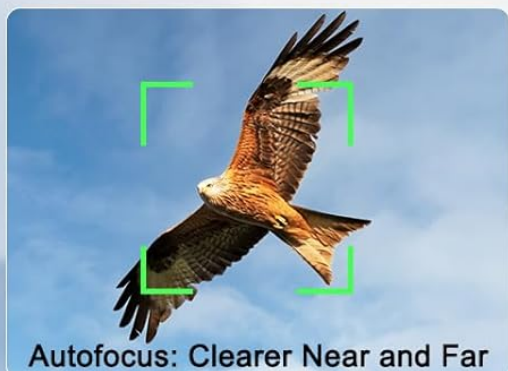
3. Photo Mode (48MP Autofocus)

To capture high-resolution still images:

1. Turn on the camera and ensure it is in Photo mode.
2. Frame your shot using the 3-inch foldable screen.
3. Press the shutter button halfway down to activate autofocus. The camera will automatically adjust focus for clear images.
4. Press the shutter button fully to capture the 48MP image.
5. **Flash:** The integrated flash can be activated for low-light conditions. Refer to the camera's on-screen menu for flash settings (Auto, On, Off, Red-eye reduction).

4. Video Mode (4K Ultra HD)

Record high-quality 4K videos with 6-axis stabilization.

1. Switch the camera to Video mode.
2. Press the Record button to start recording. Press again to stop.
3. The camera supports 4K HDR video recording with 6-axis stabilization to minimize shakes.

4. **Pause and Restart:** During recording, you can pause and restart the video without creating a new file.
5. **Slow Motion:** Access the menu to enable super slow-motion video recording for cinematic effects.

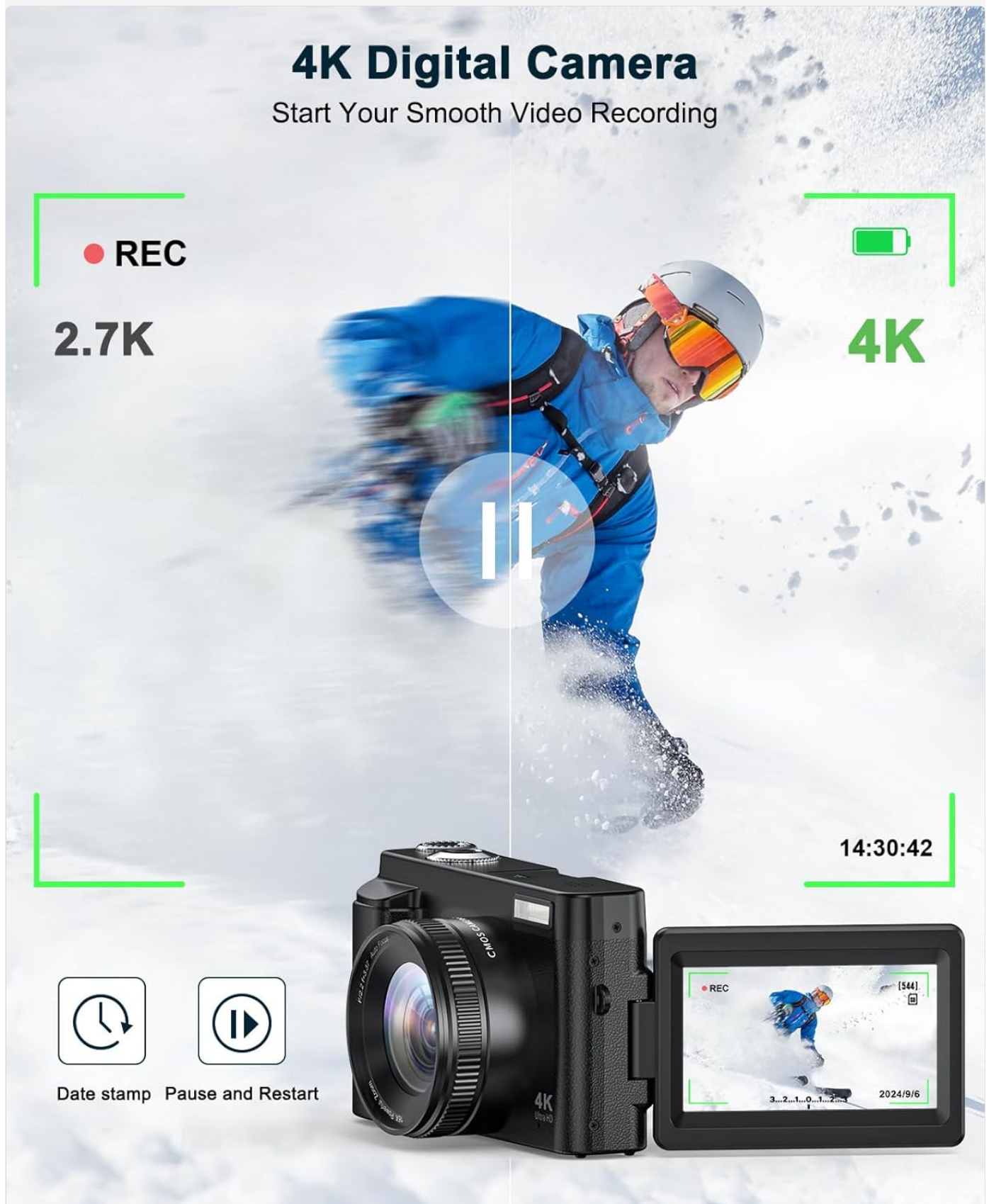


Image: Highlights the camera's 4K digital video recording capabilities, including features like date stamping and the ability to pause and restart recordings.

5. Selfie and Vlog Mode (Foldable Screen)

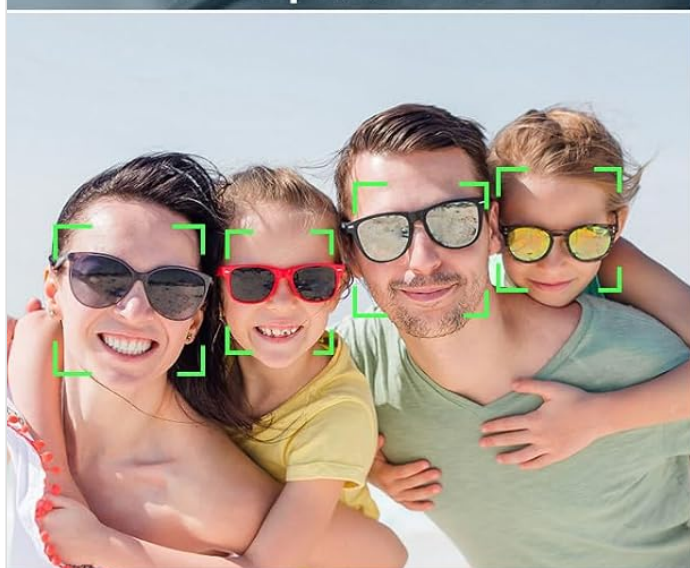
- **Continuous Shooting:** Capture a rapid sequence of photos by holding down the shutter button.

- **Timestamp:** Add a date and time stamp to your photos and videos.



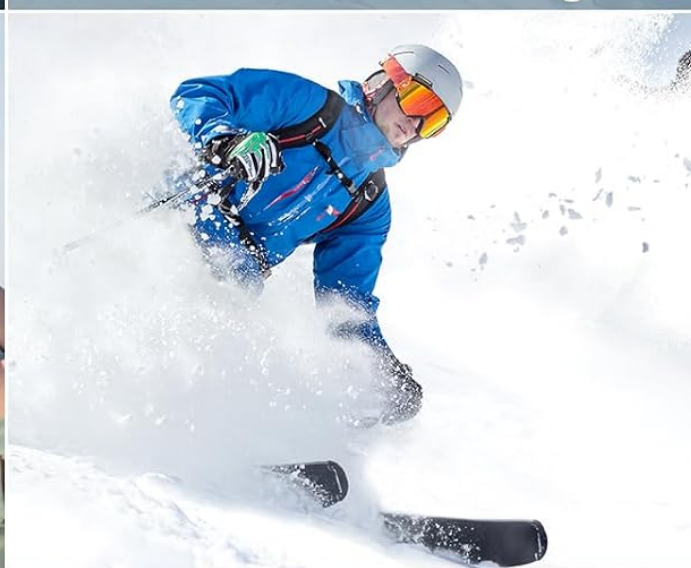

7. Live Streaming and File Transfer

- **Live Streaming:** Connect the camera to a computer via USB to use it as a webcam for live streaming on platforms like YouTube.
- **File Transfer:** Connect the camera to a computer using the USB cable to transfer photos and videos. The camera will appear as a removable disk drive.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning the Camera

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the camera body.
- For the lens, use a specialized lens cleaning cloth and lens cleaning solution. Do not use abrasive materials.
- Gently wipe the screen with a microfiber cloth.

2. Storage

- When not in use, store the camera in a cool, dry place, away from dust and direct sunlight.
- Use the provided camera bag for protection during travel or storage.
- Remove the battery if the camera will not be used for an extended period.

3. Battery Care

- Fully charge batteries before first use.
- Avoid completely draining the batteries regularly to prolong their lifespan.
- Store batteries in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera does not turn on.	Battery is dead or not inserted correctly.	Charge the battery or reinsert it correctly.
Cannot take photos/videos.	Memory card is full or not inserted.	Insert a memory card or delete some files to free up space.
Images are blurry.	Autofocus failed, camera shake, or dirty lens.	Ensure autofocus locks, use anti-shake feature, or clean the lens.
Flash not working.	Flash setting is off or battery is low.	Check flash settings in the menu; ensure battery is charged.
Camera freezes.	Software glitch.	Remove and reinsert the battery to reset the camera.
