Introduction

Welcome to the Oraimo Smart Blender with Grinder user manual. This guide provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

The Oraimo Smart Blender is designed to transform your kitchen experience, offering powerful blending and grinding capabilities. It features a 1.5L capacity jar, two speed settings, and a durable construction for reliable performance.

What's in the Box?

Upon unpacking, please ensure all components are present and in good condition. Refer to the image below for a visual guide.

- **Blender Base Unit:** The main power unit with control dial.
- **Blender Jar (1.5L):** Transparent jug for blending liquids and soft ingredients.
- **Grinding Cup:** Smaller attachment for grinding dry ingredients like coffee beans and spices.
- **Lid:** For the blender jar.
- **Welcome Guide:** This instruction manual.

Important Safety Information

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons.

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Do not immerse the motor base in water or other liquids.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning.
- Avoid contact with moving parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always operate the blender with the lid in place.
- Blades are sharp. Handle with care.

- This appliance is for household use only.
- Ensure the safety interlock device is correctly engaged before operation.

Setup

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Clean:** Before first use, wash the blender jar, grinding cup, and lid in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. The motor base should only be wiped with a damp cloth.
3. **Assemble Blender Jar:** Place the blender jar onto the motor base. Align the jar with the base and twist clockwise until it locks securely into place. The safety interlock device will prevent operation if not correctly assembled.
4. **Assemble Grinding Cup (if using):** For grinding, attach the grinding blade assembly to the grinding cup, then place the assembled cup onto the motor base and twist to lock.
5. **Position:** Place the assembled blender on a stable, flat, and dry surface. Ensure the non-slip feet are firmly in contact with the surface.

Operating Instructions

General Operation

1. Ensure the blender is unplugged before adding ingredients.
2. Add ingredients to the blender jar or grinding cup. Do not overfill. For blending, ensure liquids are added first, followed by softer ingredients, then harder ones.
3. Securely place the lid on the blender jar or grinding cup.
4. Plug the blender into a suitable power outlet (220 Volts).
5. Turn the rotary dial to select your desired speed setting.

Speed Settings

The Oramo Smart Blender features two speed settings and a pulse function for versatile blending and grinding.

- **"P" (Pulse):** Provides short bursts of power for chopping, quick blending, or breaking down tough ingredients. Release the dial to stop.
- **"1" (Low Speed):** Ideal for gentle blending of soft ingredients, mixing batters, or preparing sauces.
- **"2" (High Speed):** Suitable for efficient blending of hard ingredients, crushing ice, or making smoothies.

For optimal results, start with a lower speed and gradually increase if needed. Do not operate continuously for more than 1 minute to prevent overheating. Allow the appliance to cool down for at least 10 minutes between cycles.

Using the Grinding Attachment

The grinding attachment is perfect for dry ingredients such as coffee beans, nuts, and spices.

1. Ensure the grinding cup is clean and dry.
2. Add dry ingredients to the grinding cup. Do not fill above the MAX line.
3. Attach the grinding blade assembly to the cup by twisting it on securely.
4. Invert the assembled grinding cup and place it onto the motor base, twisting clockwise to lock.
5. Select speed "1" or "2" for grinding. Use short pulses for coarse grinding, or continuous operation for finer results.
6. Once finished, unplug the blender, carefully remove the grinding cup, and detach the blade assembly to empty the contents.

Cleaning and Maintenance

Proper cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Oraimo Smart Blender.

Quick Cleaning Function

For quick and easy cleaning of the blender jar:

1. After use, rinse the jar.
2. Fill the blender jar with warm water (approximately 700ml) and add a few drops of dish soap.
3. Secure the lid.
4. Place the jar on the motor base and run on speed "2" or use the "P" (Pulse) setting for 30 seconds.
5. Empty the soapy water, rinse the jar thoroughly with clean water, and dry.

Deep Cleaning

- **Motor Base:** Always unplug the blender before cleaning. Wipe the motor base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse it in water or any other liquid.
- **Blender Jar & Grinding Cup:** These parts are detachable. Wash them with warm, soapy water using a brush to reach all areas, especially around the blades. Rinse thoroughly and allow to air dry completely before storing.
- **Blades:** The stainless steel blades are sharp. Exercise extreme caution when cleaning them.
- **Storage:** Store the blender in a dry, clean place, away from direct sunlight and heat.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter any issues with your Oraimo Smart Blender, please refer to the following table before contacting customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Blender does not turn on.	Not plugged in; Jar not correctly assembled; Power outage.	Ensure plug is firmly in outlet; Twist jar clockwise until it locks securely; Check household circuit breaker.
Motor stops during operation.	Overheating due to continuous use or overloading; Ingredients too thick.	Unplug and let cool for 10-15 minutes; Reduce ingredients or add more liquid; Use pulse function.
Ingredients not blending smoothly.	Too little liquid; Jar overloaded; Ingredients too large.	Add more liquid; Reduce quantity of ingredients; Cut ingredients into smaller pieces.
Leakage from the bottom of the jar.	Lid not properly sealed; Jar not correctly seated on base; Damaged seal.	Ensure lid is firmly closed; Re-seat jar on base; Inspect seal for damage, contact support if damaged.
