SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety during assembly and use. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- Ensure all components are securely fastened during assembly.
- Do not allow children to climb on or play inside the coop unsupervised.
- Regularly inspect the coop for any signs of wear, damage, or loose components.
- Position the coop on a level, stable surface to prevent tipping.
- The PVC-coated hexagonal wire mesh is designed to deter predators. Ensure it is properly installed and free from gaps.
- The lockable door mechanism should be checked regularly to ensure it functions correctly, providing a secure enclosure for your animals.

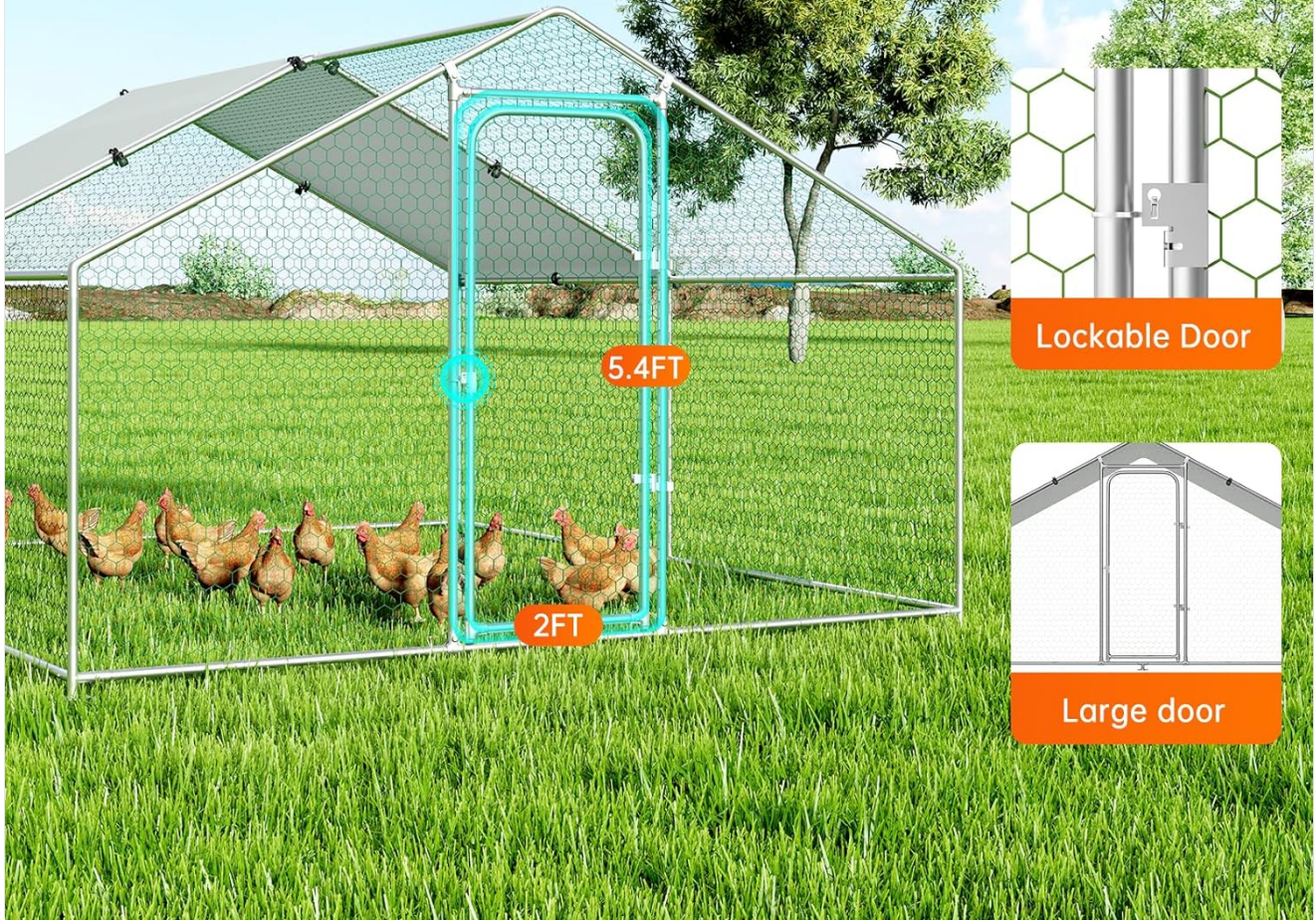


Image: Illustration of the lockable door and its dimensions (5.4ft height, 2ft width), highlighting the safety features.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, verify that all parts listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support.

- 1 x Chicken Coop Frame (Galvanized Steel Pipes)
- 1 x Oxford Cover (Waterproof & UV-Resistant)
- 1 x Roll of PVC-Coated Hexagonal Wire Mesh
- Assembly Hardware (Spring Buckles, Rubber Ropes, etc.)
- 1 x Instruction Manual

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the HIWOKK Chicken Coop is designed to be straightforward with a user-friendly spring buckle system, requiring no additional tools.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Verify against the package contents list.
2. **Assemble the Frame:** Connect the galvanized steel pipes using the spring buckle system. Ensure each connection is secure and fully engaged. The frame forms the basic structure of the coop.
3. **Attach Wire Mesh:** Unroll the PVC-coated hexagonal wire mesh and attach it to the assembled frame. Use the provided fasteners (e.g., rubber ropes or clips) to secure the mesh tightly around all sides, ensuring there are no gaps that could allow predators entry.
4. **Install the Door:** Integrate the door frame into the main structure, ensuring it swings freely and the lockable mechanism functions correctly.
5. **Install the Oxford Cover:** Drape the Oxford cover over the spire roof section of the coop. Secure it using the rubber ropes or clips to the frame. Ensure the cover is taut to allow for proper water and snow runoff.
6. **Final Inspection:** Once assembled, perform a thorough inspection to ensure all connections are tight, the mesh is secure, and the cover is properly installed.

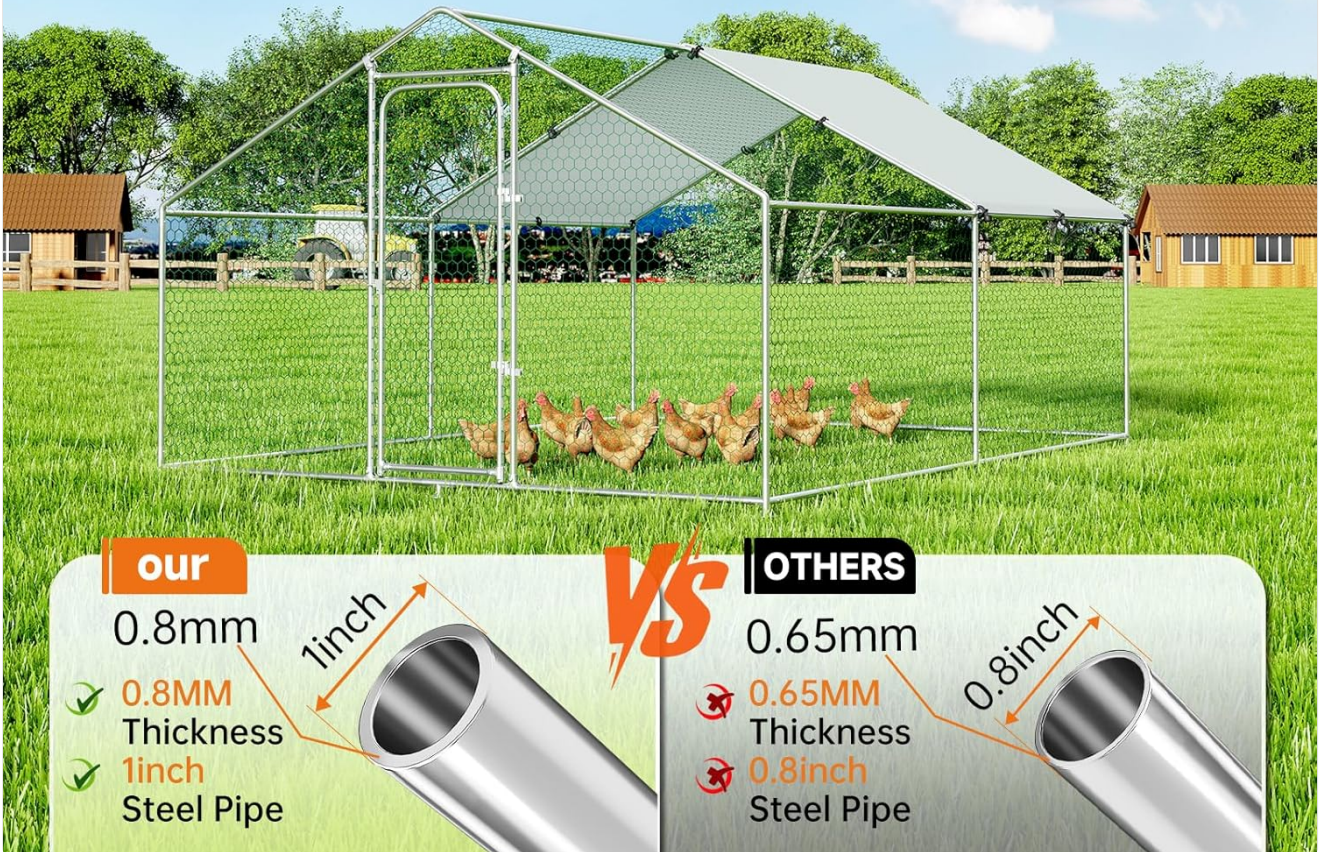
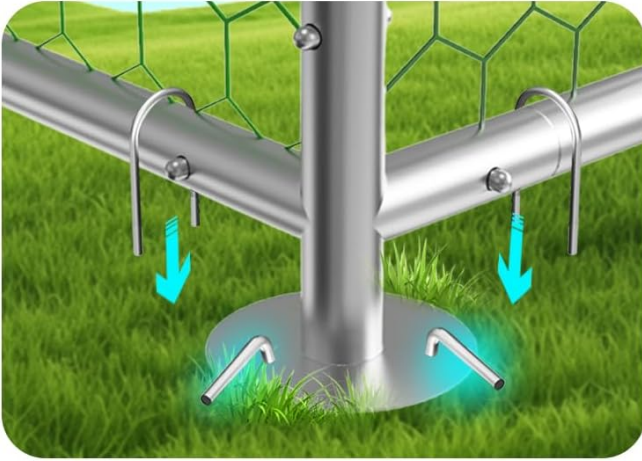
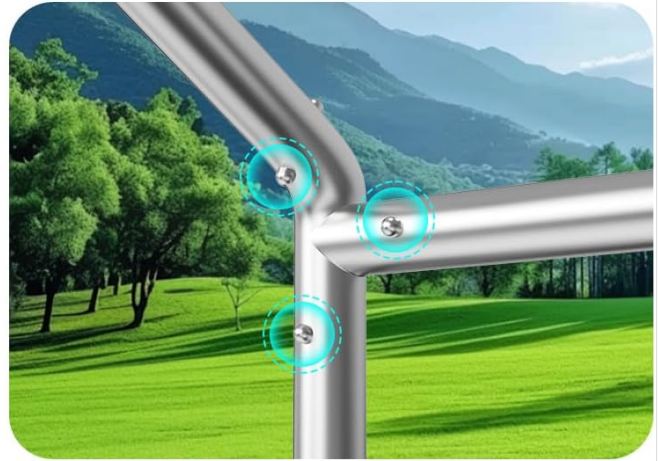


Image: Diagram comparing the 0.8mm thickness of the steel pipes used in this coop to a thinner alternative, highlighting structural integrity.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (USAGE)

The HIWOKK Chicken Coop provides a secure and spacious environment for various small animals.

- **Animal Placement:** This coop is suitable for chickens, rabbits, ducks, cats, dogs, geese, and quail. Ensure the number of animals housed is appropriate for the coop's dimensions to prevent overcrowding.
- **Daily Checks:** Regularly check the animals' food and water supply. Ensure the door is securely latched at all times to prevent escape and protect against predators.
- **Environmental Control:** The waterproof and UV-resistant Oxford cover provides protection from sun and rain. In extreme weather conditions, additional measures may be necessary to ensure animal comfort and safety.

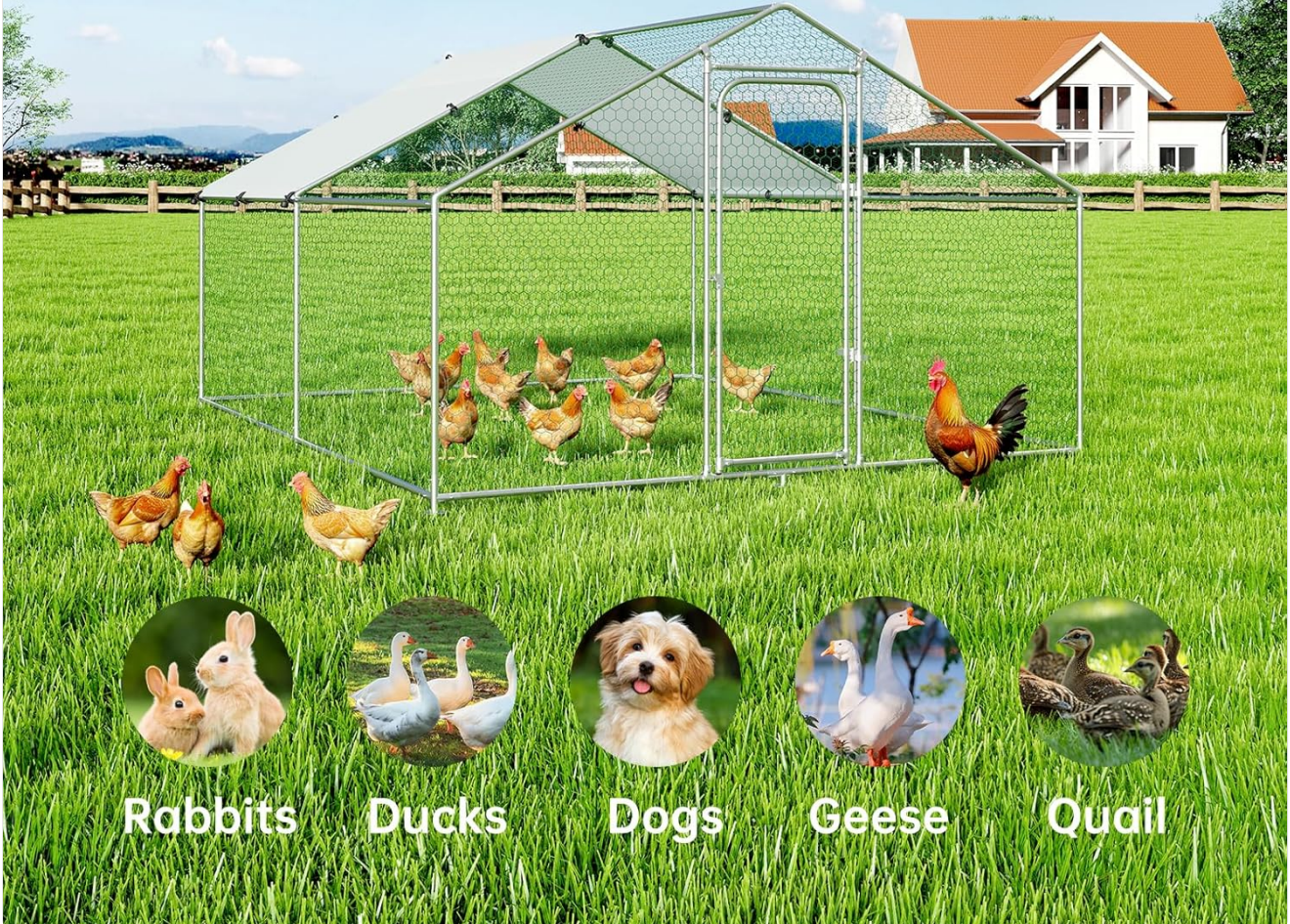

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the lifespan of your chicken coop and ensure a healthy environment for your animals.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically clean the interior and exterior of the coop. The galvanized steel frame and Oxford cover can be wiped down with a damp cloth.
- **Frame Inspection:** Check the steel frame for any signs of rust or damage. The rust-resistant coating helps prevent corrosion, but regular inspection is recommended, especially in humid environments.
- **Mesh Integrity:** Inspect the PVC-coated hexagonal wire mesh for any tears, holes, or loose sections. Repair or reinforce as needed to maintain predator protection.
- **Cover Condition:** Examine the Oxford cover for rips or excessive wear. Ensure it remains securely attached and continues to provide adequate waterproof and UV protection.

- **Door Mechanism:** Lubricate the door hinges and latch mechanism as necessary to ensure smooth operation and secure closure.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Coop feels unstable.	Uneven ground; loose frame connections.	Relocate to a level surface. Check and tighten all spring buckle connections. Ensure metal bottom anchors are properly secured.
Water pooling on the roof cover.	Cover not taut; improper installation.	Re-adjust and secure the Oxford cover using rubber ropes to ensure it is taut and allows water to run off the spire roof design.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Animals escaping or predators entering.	Gaps in mesh; unsecured door.	Inspect the entire mesh for any holes or loose sections and repair. Ensure the door is fully closed and the lockable latch is engaged.
Difficulty assembling frame pipes.	Misalignment; debris in connection points.	Ensure pipes are correctly oriented. Clear any debris from the spring buckle mechanisms. Apply slight pressure and wiggle to align.

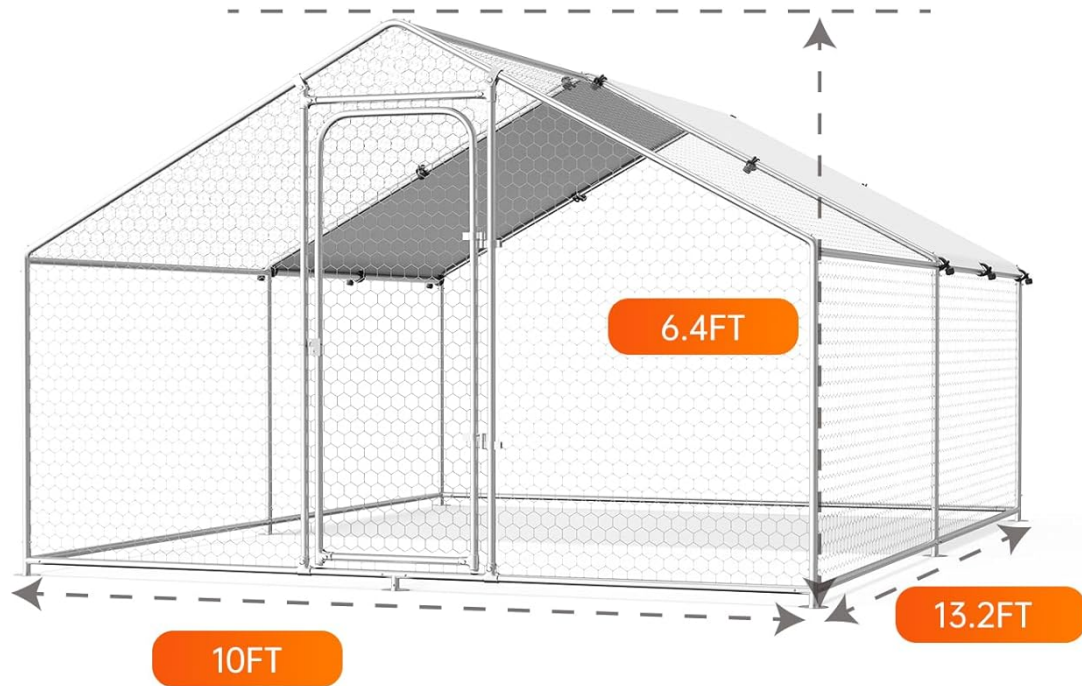
